The 28th Annual Saturn Awards were held at the prestigious St. Regis Hotel in Century City on June 10, 2002 and the event was the biggest ever for the Academy of Science Fiction, Fantasy & Horror Films. Turn to the left and you could see Nicolas Cage in attendance with his father to present a special award to his idol, Marvel Comic Book editor, Stan Lee. Turn to the right and you may be bombarded with costumed Storm Troopers from the world of Star Wars.

Entering the ballroom several hundred industry dignitaries settled in for a night of magic. Beginning the affair was the organization's first presentation of a new award, The Dr. Donald A. Reed

Award, named after the beloved Founder of the 30 year old Academy. The first to receive this award was industry leader, Sherry Lansing, who knew Dr. Reed and his devotion to filmmakers. Sherry's

remarks were deeply heartfelt: "This award is very special to me. The reason is because it has


