Management Structure: As host, Ransom Everglades (“RE” or the “Host”) created a structure of volunteer parents, alumni, and students to help prepare for and manage the event. Under the Chairman of the Regatta Ganzalo Crivello, three RE Parent Volunteers took several roles to complement the work of the actual racing: Registration and Administration, Hospitality, and Race Management. To support the entire event, approximately 40 volunteers worked in its preparation and race day support. These volunteers include RE parents, alumni, students, and some from the local sailing community. There were two organizational meetings with the key volunteers to ensure full communication and management of the regatta.

The Chairman would like to take a particular note to the fact that the event was held at Ransom Everglades School. RE is located directly on Biscayne Bay, and while it has an adequate facility to support a fleet of 16 C420’s, it is not a yacht club. Because it does not have facilities like a yacht club typically has, it takes a great deal of additional effort and volunteer support to run a successful event.

Notice of Race: Several weeks before the competition, Ransom Everglades sent all of the team representatives the Notice of Race. The Notice included all pertinent race information, dates, times, regatta format, procedures, recommended hotels, etc. The Notice also include the Registration and Waiver and Release Forms. In addition, as part of the hospitality of the event, the Notice included a tee shirt order form. The Notice is attached as Attachment 1.

Entry: In response to the Notice, sixteen teams entered the event: Academic Magnet High School, Antilles School, Bishop England High School, Charleston County School of the Arts, Lake Norman High School, Pine View School, Porter-Gaud School, Ransom Everglades School, Richmond Hill High School, Sarasota High School, Sarasota Military Academy, Shorecrest Preparatory School, St. Croix Country Day School, St. Thomas Aquinas, Tampa Jesuit High School, and Wando High School. However, on April 8, several days before the regatta, Porter-Gaud School withdrew from the competition, and Ashley Hall was able to replace this team, leaving a total of 16 teams.

The RE Parent Volunteer assisting with the registration checked to make sure all of the entered participants were eligible per the SAISA website and found no issues in this regard. Of the registrations, six teams did not complete their waiver forms when submitting the entry forms. The same RE Parent Volunteer emailed the representatives of the six teams encouraging that they scan and email the waiver forms before the event. By receiving the waivers beforehand, this would facilitate registration and also avoid the problem of having a sailor traveling a great distance and being denied the opportunity to sail because of a lack of parental or guardian signature.

Race Management and Sailor Safety: As host, RE places an emphasis on running a fair series of races and sailor safety. With that in mind, the RE Parent Volunteer managing the race, a former international champion sailor, worked closely with the race PRO Peter Commette to ensure enough motor boat coverage. The motorboat assistance

included boats for a Signal Boat, Pin Boat, Weather Mark Boat, Safety and Race Committee Boats, and a floater boat or two.

Fleet Preparation: On the Wednesday before the regatta, the Host inspected all boats and equipment and made any necessary adjustments. The boats were then race ready.

Friday Practice Session: As per the schedule, registration began on Friday, April 12 at 13:00. Teams were allowed to check in anytime after 13:00 with practice beginning at 14:30. Approximately eleven teams checked in on Friday, and after a brief skipper's meeting, a few practice races were held with all sailing completed by 18:00. Three volunteers ran the registration table for the duration of that afternoon as teams made their way to the venue. As part of Friday check in, RE tabulated each team's arrival and ensured that any missing waivers were collected. Pre-ordered tee shirts were also handed out at this time.

During this registration period, every team was also given a packet of information regarding the event. The packet included a copy of the Primary Race Courses, the Rotations, Sailing Instructions, and a reminder that this information, the Notice of Race and live video streaming of the event could be found on-line at saisamallory2013.org. In addition, instructions were included regarding the Practice Session, information regarding team lunches for Saturday and Sunday, and instructions on how to properly de-rig and store the boats. Extra copies of these items were also available at the registration desk.

For the Practice Session, each team practiced in one boat and was assigned the boat number that it would be starting with on Saturday morning. This system was used so that when the boats were returned to the dock on Friday, each team would check to ensure proper use and operation of all equipment. After the practice session, all boats were returned, de-rigged and stored properly for the event.

Saturday and Sunday Sessions: Each race day began with 7:30am check in, followed by boat rigging, a competitor's meeting and sailing. The Saturday and Sunday check in was a simple procedure. On Friday, 5 teams had not arrived and checked in, so full registration for them was completed on Saturday. Once all teams had registered and submitted all forms, the Host simply had all of the teams initial a check list on Saturday and Sunday indicating their presence.

As per the schedule, boat rigging began on Saturday at 9:00am with the competitor's meeting about 9:30am. Ganzalo Crivello addressed the competitors regarding boat maintenance and safety, and PRO Peter Commette introduced the rules committee and discussed the various course layouts. Sailors left the docks at 10:00am. Sunday was similar but did not include a competitors' meeting. Both days ran on schedule per the schedule of the Notice of Race except for a weather delay on Saturday (see Weather below).

Before the fleet returned in the afternoon, all of the Race Participation Forms for each team were taped to the registration desk for completion by each team at the end of each day's racing. Per the suggestion of the SAISA representative Tom Monkus, each team was required to complete a Participation Form for each day of racing. At the end of each day of racing, the forms were collected and noted.

As part of the morning check in, 2-3 volunteers worked the registration table to facilitate check in and to answer any questions. Extra copies of Primary Race Courses and the Rotations and other documents were kept on hand. In addition, the scoring and race administration were managed by two student volunteers throughout all three days.

As for the racing and rotation, RE used a floating dock system. All non-participating sailors were ferried to the floating dock that was near the race course. This enabled for quick rotation and sailor substitutions and maximized the number of races. The dock had adequately supplies of water and sports drinks, and each team was able to place its own cooler for their teams on the dock.

Weather Conditions: The race was held about half a mile off the Host's dock and basin in Biscayne Bay. The weather for Saturday was generally partly cloudy with temperatures in the low 80's. Low Tides were in the early mornings around 4:15am with High Tides around 10:00pm. The wind was moderate for the Friday Practice Session (about a steady 11 knots, gusting to 15 knots).

Saturday morning also started with a steady breeze of 11-12 knots. During the late morning, a series of two storm fronts moved through South Florida. For safety reasons, spectators and non-sailing sailors were brought back to the school from the floating dock around 12:30. At about 13:00, the Fleet returned as did all motorboats except the PRO's boat who elected to stay out in the Bay to monitor the weather. A few minutes after the boats were docked, the storm front passed through the area. There were no reports of injuries or safety concerns, and the weather delay lasted approximately an hour forty-five minutes. The front brought a reported two inches of rain as well as sporadic lightning. After monitoring the weather system and seeing that it had passed completely, competitors returned to the course at about 15:15 when racing re-commenced.

After the storm front passed through, the wind for Saturday lightened up to under 10 knots. However, Sunday was mostly sunny with moderate winds, a steady 11-12 knots providing for good sailing conditions. The winds were generally from the Southeast.

Race Committee Report: The Race Committee consisted of PRO Peter Commette. The Head Judge was Mike Posey, and other judges and officials included Bob Megher, Mike Dawson, and Jack Loving. Two RE students also helped with the scoring of the regatta. The Race Committee certified all scores. Plus, the real-time reporting of scores and periodic posting served as a secondary source to identify any issues with scoring. One small discrepancy was detected on the final day which the Race Committee sorted

through and did not affect the outcome of the event. The official Race Committee Actions is included as Attachment 2.

Results: A total of 15 races in both Fleets A and B were completed per the Race Rotation for a total of 30 races (Attachment 3). Results for each race were tabulated in real time using the DOS ISSA program. The race results were sent from the Race Committee Boat to the shore operator. The results were posted on-line at saisamallory2013.org in real time throughout the day. Many of the spectators were able to monitor the results using smart phones. Guests commented that they really enjoyed being able to monitor the results on their phones or other devices throughout the day. A live video feed of the racing was also available as were still photographs of the competition. In addition, results were also printed and posted manually throughout the day and after each day's racing.

A summary of the results follow on the next page, but the complete final results are included as Attachment 4 and a summary of participants with Participation Forms are included as Attachment 5. As for the results in Attachment 4, they are in two formats: a spreadsheet and the format using the recommended software which misaligns the results page when printed.

Antilles High School won the competition by virtue of the second tie-break.

Closing of the Regatta: On Sunday afternoon, the last boat to dock occurred at 15:02. At 15:50, the award ceremony began. Tom Monkus was present to provide the awards and congratulations to all competitors. The Awards for the top 3 teams included medals for the sailors, the perpetual trophy for the winner Antilles High School, and invitations to the National Competition for the top three teams. In addition, the season's North Points winners Academic Magnet and South Point winners St. Thomas Aquinas were also recognizes. The event officially closed at 16:00.

Hospitality: As all of the teams were traveling to the Regatta, the Host made special efforts to extend hospitality to all participants in several ways. First, the Host provided

some breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Breakfast included an assortment of bagels and coffee. As part of the registration fee, there was a dinner provided after the Saturday racing. Dinner was catered from a local Miami institution – a barbecue restaurant called Shorty's. The meal included chicken, cole slaw, potato salad, baked beans, corn on the cob, drinks, and cookies. The catering covered 200 people. The uneaten meals were donated to a local homeless shelter. As Sunday was the travel day, the Host provided a quicker, simpler pizza meal for the teams.

Before the event, the Host also tried to create a host hotel at the Sonesta Hotel. The Sonesta is the closest hotel to Ransom Everglades and would have served as an ideal host hotel as it is within walking distance to the venue. One of the RE Parent Volunteers worked directly with the school and hotel to negotiate a reasonable rate. Unfortunately, the Sonesta required a room rate of \$189 plus required the school to guarantee payment of unused rooms in the block. The Host did not believe this price point would work for most teams so opted to list other hotels on the Notice as an alternative.

Second, hospitality included the tee shirts as mentioned above. The tee shirts included the names of all of the participating teams. Third, during race days, one Parent Volunteer served as the official photographer. This particular parent has a great deal of experience photographing sailing events. The photos have been placed in a folder at the saisamallory2013.org site.

Fourth, eight RE volunteers also served as a Welcome Committee. Each volunteer was assigned two teams to serve as a local contact. About a week before the event, each volunteer phoned their respective teams to offer up any logistical help over their weekend in Miami. The idea was to have each team have a local contact to answer non-racing related questions such as restaurant advice, directions, pharmacies, etc. The purpose of the Welcome Committee was to obviously to extend hospitality but also comfort those teams traveling from great distances. The local contacts also serve to remove logistical questions from the Race Chairman.

Fifth, the venue was cleaned of trash throughout the day. After sailors left in the morning for sailing, and after the day was completed, several volunteers and RE staff cleaned up trash and removed trash from the venue. All bathrooms and other facilities were monitored to ensure cleanliness and adequate supplies.

From the feedback received, the teams seem to appreciate the efforts made by the Host in regards to hospitality. Several fellow parents from guest schools made a point of stopping by the registration desk to thank the Host volunteers for all of the efforts to make them feel welcome and run a well-organized event. Also, several guests appreciated the on-line information, video streams, and real-time results.

At the end of the competition, several guests, including a couple of coaches, commented that they believed the event was one of the best-run events they had ever attended.

What the Host could have done better: Of course, while the Host believes that it organized and ran a great event, the Host thought of ways that it could have improved things. First, during the registration process, it might have been a good idea to have the teams indicate the number of people that were planning on attending the dinner. While it is easy to estimate the numbers of sailors and coaches, what is a bit more difficult is the number of parents or others associated with the team. In this case, the Host estimated about 150 dinners for sailors and coaches, but then estimated an extra 50 dinners for other guests. However, it might have been better to get a tighter number for this portion of the event.

Second, the Host simply ordered the number of teeshirts each team indicated on their order forms. In retrospect, the Host should have ordered a dozen more in various sizes for people to swap out for sizing or simply to purchase.

Third, the Host should have provided lunches for all sailors and simply charged more in the registration fee. During the organization of the event, the Host was very concerned about the amount of the registration fee but should have simply charged for lunches and supplied them. This would have made the operations more smooth.

Credits: Of course, a Regatta such as the District Championship cannot be done without the help of many people. First, the support of Ransom Everglades Head of School and Athletic Department was critical to the success of the Regatta. Second, the 40 volunteers were essential in its preparation and execution. Third, the Host would also like to thank the hard work and dedication of the PRO Peter Commette as well as SAISA President Tom Monkus for his suggestions, encouragement, and support.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The current ISSA Procedural Rules and SAISA Supplemental Rules will apply. In the event of a conflict between the governing ISSA documents and the Sailing Instructions (SIs), the SIs shall take preference.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42 is in effect as modified per ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c). However, the US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not be in effect.
- 1.4 Attached Expedited Protest Procedure for Fleet Racing may be used.
- 1.5 Decisions of the protest committee will be final with no appeal as provided in rule 70.5(a).

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The top 16 current member schools of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) who qualified through the North/South Points district elimination series (7 schools from the North division plus 7 schools from the South division) plus 2 Caribbean School who qualified in their elimination series. If unable to attend, subsequent placement may default to the next high school in line. All schools must be members in good standing with ISSA and SAISA, and must be recognized by ISSA.
- 2.2 An eligible team is composed of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 sailors who must be full time students, in the 9-12th grade, of the school they represent, and subject to the academic and disciplinary requirements of that school.
- 2.3 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult Team Leader Chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent and must be recognized by the school. This person must be responsible for conduct & have full authority for making medical decisions. Competitors without a responsible adult on site may not be scored for races on days for which that adult is absent or may not be allowed to go on the water. It is the competitors designated adult's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The designated adult will accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

3. FEES & REGISTRATION

The entry fee shall be \$135 and a \$100 damage deposit (separate check) per school team with forms completed by the Advisor/Coach on record & paid in advance by using the Registration, Roster and Waiver forms and T-shirt order form attached.

4. BOATS

The regatta will be sailed in 16 Collegiate 420's. While on the rotation dock and on the water, competitors shall wear clothing appropriate for water, wind, sun & temperature conditions. This includes a PFD & can include a dry suit, wet suit or a thermal polyester layer covered by a windproof shell, head cover/protection, etc. Inherently buoyant Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) including US Coast Guard Type III or V PFDs must be furnished by the competitors. PFDs shall be worn outside of all clothing and foul weather gear, except for a thin athletic (synthetic) T-shirt or team pinny, which may be worn over a lifejacket to prevent snagging of lines or equipment. Inflatable type PFDs are not permitted. Each sailor must have suitable safety gear for weather and temperature conditions.

5. FORMAT

This will be a two division fleet racing regatta; teams will rotate through the boats per rotation posted on the day of the event. Competitors should expect numerous short college style races of 15-20 minutes in duration with boat rotation as set forth at the Competitor's Meeting. Based upon conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses. It shall be the goal of the race committee to complete one full round-robin rotation of boats. Schools should be prepared to race on Sunday until completion of racing; however, no race will start after 1500. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be outlined at the Competitor's Meeting.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in.

7. RACING AREA

The regatta will be held on Biscayne Bay south and east of the entrance to Dinner Key Channel.

8. SCHEDULE OF RACES

	0900	Rigging of Boats

Note: The R/C reserves the right to start any race if it feels teams have been given ample time to transit to the starting area from the rigging area or rotation location.

9. COURSES

Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

10. SCORING

The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules. Protests hearings will be on shore in between each division sets or held on the water per ISSA Rule 16(d). If insufficient time is available, they will be held at the end of the day or during on shore postponements.

11. AWARDS & TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to schools placing 1st through 3rd as soon as possible after the last race to be sailed in the regatta. In addition, SAISA will issue invitations to three high school teams to represent SAISA at the ISSA National High School Double-handed Fleet Racing Championship for the Mallory Trophy at the Chicago Yacht Club – Belmont Station Lake Michigan – May 11-12, 2013. If any qualifying high school team cannot attend the ISSA National Championship, the next place competitor (alternate) will be invited.

12. QUALIFICATIONS FOR SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

- 12.1 The event's purpose is to also assist the South Atlantic district of ISSA in issuing invitations to 3 school teams to represent their school and SAISA in the ISSA National High School Double-handed Championship for the Mallory Trophy.
- 12.2 If confirmation is not received by SAISA on or before 25 April by the qualifying team, the next place qualified team will be invited. Penalties will be assessed to the non-responsive team.
- 12.3 Following notification to SAISA, the qualifying teams must submit check and all registration forms to the venue, per the NOR, or the berth will be lost to another district.

13. FOOD

The entry fee includes a cookout for all sailors Saturday after racing and pizza following racing Sunday. An informal dinner Saturday is included following racing.

The Use of disposable plastic water bottles is HIGHLY DISCOURAGED. Large Igloo containers of ice water will be available to all competitors, coaches, and spectators for refilling your re-usable canister (e.g. Nalgene).

14. DAMAGE

A damage deposit of \$100.00 must be submitted with each entry. This is refundable if the boats and gear are returned

undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams. Damage caused by collisions that require more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Regatta Chairman determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

15. DIRECTIONS & LODGING

Ransom Everglades Upper School is approximately 20 minutes from Miami International Airport and lies on the waterfront of Coconut Grove just south of Dinner Key. Detailed directions to Ransom Everglades Upper School are available from the contacts below.

17. OFFICIAL NOTICE

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chap 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during 12-14 April, 2013 may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.

18. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I understand that any damage or loss to the boats and or equipment, which the jury finds was caused by this school's team, will be the financial responsibility of the team. Failure of any team to meet this obligation may be grounds for suspension of membership in SAISA and may result in the disqualification of the team from SAISA sanctioned events in the future. Any damage or loss, which is not capable of being assessed against a particular team, will be deducted from the damage deposit pool. If unused, checks will be voided. EXPEDITED PROTEST PROCEDURE FOR FLEET RACING

On the Water Hearing Procedure

This appendix represents the recommended protest procedure for on the water judging for fleet racing per ISSA PR 16(d). It is addressed primarily to judges but may be helpful to others connected with protest, redress and breakdown hearings. Protesting boats and those boats that have been notified that they have been protested shall stay in the vicinity of the finish line. When using this procedure no protest forms needs to be filed this changes RRS 61.2 and 62.2.

1. The jury for all protests and redress hearings initiated afloat may use an expedited hearing between races. All other hearings shall follow the procedural rules including filing of a protest/redress form. Expedited hearings shall be held using the following procedure, and may be held onboard a Judge boat:

- a. The on the water hearing will begin as soon as all parties are assembled.
- b. If no one raises an objection the protest will be determined to be valid. This changes RRS 63.5.
- c. Each party will be given about 1 minute to state their case.
- d. The judge(s) may question the parties and/or call witnesses.
- e. Each party will be given about 1 minute to question the other party.
- f. The parties are excused. The Judge(s) will determine the facts and make their decision.
- g. The Judge(s) shall inform the parties of the decision orally.

2. The Judge boat shall be equipped with the current RRS and ISSA PR for use by the jury and the parties to the protest.

3. Expedited hearings may be used to consider requests for redress involving breakdowns. Competitors are urged to use this procedure in lieu of written protests. The requesting competitor must notify the Race Committee of the intention to use this procedure immediately after finishing or as soon as reasonably possible if unable to finish.
