Re: Texas Poll Results

Dresner, Wickers, Barber, Sanders fielded a statewide survey April 27-30, 2012 among 400 likely Republican primary voters in Texas. Two questions were asked on behalf of Conservative Republicans of Texas: the ballot test of the upcoming May 29th, 2012 GOP primary election for United States Senate, and the ballot test of the 2014 GOP primary election for Lieutenant Governor. Below are the overall results of these two questions.

I. Ballot Tests

U.S. Senate - 2012

II. Methodology

Respondents were selected using random digit dialing from voter sample, and the sample was stratified to reflect regional proportionate share of the electorate. A 52% female, 48% male quota was enforced for this study. The margin of error, at .95 confidence, is +/- 4.5%.
