Track Stitch Cowl by Sarah Freeman

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Difficulty Rating : Suitable for the crocheter with a little experience.

Materials required:

Large cowl: 150g Rico Design Essentials Merino Wool DK. 4.5mm hook.

Abbreviations

Size:

110cm x 16cm

Tension:

Tension isn't critical

Rows: 4 (and a bit) pattern repeats to 10cm. 19 sts to 10cm

Pattern notes:

Stitch counts are all in {}.

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Pattern

Ch 201.

Miss 1st ch from hook, 1 dc into each ch {200 dc}.

Ensuring that the work isn't twisted, ss first and last dc together, joining into a round. PM so you know where the start of the round is.

Working in continuous rounds, moving the marker every round, 1 dc in each st, work a further 2 rounds of dc {200sts}.

Round 1: SS into next st to give a smooth join, 4 ch (counts as 1dtr and 1 ch), *miss 1 dc, 1 dtr into next st, 1 ch. Repeat from * all round the cowl. Join with a SS to the 3rd ch of the 4ch at the beginning of the round.

Round 2: 1 ch, *miss dtr on previous rd, 2 dc into ch sp. Repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 3 and 4: work continuously 1 dc into each st.

Repeat rounds 1 to 4 a further 6 times.

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
