- Initially, students may submit their stories in Hindi or English.

- All students may access the submitted stories/translations on the website and cast their vote online.

STAGE -2: REGIONAL WRITING WORKSHOPS October-November 2013

- About 300-400 selected semi-finalists and their accompanying teachers will be invited to a Regional Writing Workshop.
- The semi-finalists will be given an opportunity to further develop and revise their submitted stories/translation under the guidance of professional writers, poets, and translators.
- At the conclusion of the Regional Writing Workshop, students will submit their stories for the FINAL ROUND.

STAGE -3: KATHA UTSAV December 2013

- The submissions will be screened by experts who will select about 200 of the best entries for the
