And whereas it is expedient that the principal Order should be further amended in the

manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in this behalf by the Air Navigation Acts, 1920 and 1936, or otherwise in His Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order,

and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as "The Colonial Air Navigation (Application of Acts) (Amendment) Order, 1938," and the principal Order and this Order may be cited together as The Colonial Air Navigation (Application of
