The Gashi Children from Albania

AGAIN and again we have witnessed the wonders of our Aleppo Children's Transportation Fund. Remember the Chinese brother and sister from a village near Beijing, and others from Canada and Texas? At the Alba Restaurant in Quincy on May 20, a group of Greek Shriners met the owner of two restaurants there, **Leonard (Leo) Keka** and heard a remarkable continuing saga. Five children: **Ardit, Arian, Ariola, Milot, and Gonxhe**, from the village of Verboc, Albania, had arrived in Boston on April 30. They had suffered various burns to their faces and bodies in a domestic accident. The following week the same group of diners attended a fundraiser at the Restaurant. The children are now in the hands of specialist surgeons and therapists in our Boston Shriners Burns Hospital.

Leo described all the great helpers and fundraisers that have from the beginning insured the future of the little ones and their parents. The response was endless!

First, in arranging the travel from Albania was the U.S. Military, Sergeant **Edward Vowell**, who prepared this past year for everything necessary for the children and families to reach Boston Shriners Hospital: travel documents from the U.S. Embassy in Skopje, Macedonia, and promises of support from Albanian/American organizations (MAAS/BESA).

Next came the Ministry of Health in Kosovo, which covered the travel costs of the airline tickets to Boston for the children and parents.

Casa Monte in Boston's North End has agreed to house the families for a reasonable price. The facilities are clean, furnished, and are within walking distance of the Hospital, public transportation, and downtown Boston.


In addition to the funders already cited, there are many, many more! The Albanian-American Woman's Organization/Motrat Qiriazi in New York; Children's Chance in Connecticut; Holy Trinity Albanian Orthodox Church, and St. George's Cathedral.

Suela Lika, who is in the Bone Marrow Transplant Department of Massachusetts General Hospital will coordinate and oversee the visits of the Gashi family in Boston and will liaise with Shriners Hospital.

We know that the Boston Shriners Hospital has agreed to accept the care of the injured children *pro bono*. Hospital specialists have scheduled the various treatments for each child, including laser surgery, Z-plasty, and continuing follow-up treatments and surgeries for years to come.

We Shriners stand ready to add our donations to the Children's Transportation Fund. In addition, we urge our Aleppo News readers to direct their contributions to Leonard Keka at the Alba Restaurant in Quincy.

What started for your reporter and fellow Greeks as diners in a posh restaurant became a miracle. We will play a major role as funders and helpers for young ones from a continent away!
