



Knit Toboggan Hat

Directions are for Small; changes for Large are in parentheses.

RedHeart® “Designer Sport™”: 1 ball 3290 Brick.

Knitting Needles: 5mm [US 8].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4”; 26 rows = 4” in Rib Pattern (slightly stretched). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

Hat Circumference: 20 (22)”.

RIB PATTERN: (Multiple of 12 sts + 2 extra)
Row 1 (Right Side): K2 *p2, k6, p2, k2; repeat from * to end.
Rows 2: P2, *k2, p6, k2, p2; repeat from * to end.
Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for Rib Pattern.

HAT
Cast on 98 (110) sts.
Next Row (Right Side): K2, *p2, k2; repeat from * to end.
Next Row: P2, *k2, p2; repeat from * to end.
Repeat last 2 rows for 2”, end with Row 2.

Beginning with Row 1, work Rib pattern until piece measures 7 (8)” from beginning, end with a WS row.

Decrease Row (Right Side): *K2, p2, ssk, k2, k2tog, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 – 82 (92) sts.
Next Row: *P2, k2, p4, k2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p2.
Decrease Row: *K2, p2, ssk, k2tog, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 – 66 (74) sts.
Next Row: [P2, k2] to last 2 sts, p2.
Decrease Row: *K2, p2, k2tog, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2 – 58 (65) sts.
Next Row: *P2, k2, p1, k2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p2.
Decrease Row: *K2tog, p2, k1, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2tog – 49 (55) sts.
Next Row: [P1, k2] to last st, p1.
Decrease Row: *K1, p1, k2tog, p2; repeat from * to last st, k1 – 41 (46) sts.
Next Row: *P1, k2, p1, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1.
Decrease Row: K1, *p1, k1, p1, k2tog; repeat from * to end – 33 (37) sts.
Next Row: [P1, k1] to last st, p1.
Decrease Row: *K1, k2tog, p1; repeat from * to last st, k1 – 25 (28) sts.
Next Row: P1, [k1, p1] to end.
Decrease Row: K1, [k1, k2tog] to end – 17 (19) sts.
Next Row: Purl.

Decrease Row: [K2tog] to last st, k1 – 8 (10) sts.

FINISHING: Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close. Knot to secure. Sew back seam of hat. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: K = knit; **K2tog** = knit next two sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch (es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.

Special Abbreviations:
Ssk = Slip next 2 sts, one at a time, to right needle; insert point of left needle into the fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together from this position – dec made.
