## Station Construction: Downtown and Blue Line Stations

Spring 2013

### NEWS AND UPDATES!

- The **Fifth Avenue** Trolley Station is now open!
- Approximately 14 miles of Blue Line track will be upgraded. Construction is anticipated to begin in August 2013 at the **Barrio Logan, Harborside** and **Pacific Fleet** Trolley Stations on the Blue Line. This work will continue through Fall 2013.
- New low-floor cars are now operating on the Orange Line through downtown.
- Please note that according to federal regulations, train conductors are required by law to sound the horn when approaching and passing through an active construction site, even in a quiet zone, as a safety measure.

### CURRENT CONSTRUCTION

Some stations may require occasional night or weekend construction work. Access for pedestrians and businesses will be maintained at all stations throughout construction.

#### 12TH & IMPERIAL TRANSIT CENTER (OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION)

- Construction is anticipated through May 2013.
- Temporary lane closures on westbound and eastbound Imperial Avenue are anticipated during construction.
- All platforms at 12th & Imperial are now open. Work continues at the south end of the station until early June 2013.
- Bus stops have been temporarily relocated due to a repaving project that is unrelated to the Trolley Renewal project. Please use caution and see signage for bus stop locations.



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

### C STREET IMPROVEMENTS

- C Street traffic signal improvements work is anticipated from July through November 2013.

### TRACTION POWER SUBSTATIONS (INSTALLATION AND/OR DECOMMISSION)

- Construction has begun for the retrofit/replacement of over 20 traction power substations throughout the Blue and Orange Lines that convert power for Trolley operations.
- Substation installation and/or decommission at the intersections of Kettner Boulevard & A Street, 12th Avenue & Imperial Avenue, and Harbor Drive & Cesar E. Chavez Parkway, Palm Avenue & Hollister Street, 27th Street and Seward Avenue & Cypress Drive will be ongoing through June 2013.

***Construction schedules may change with very little notice.***

## MINIMAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Major construction work is now completed and these stations have reopened. Some minor construction activities may continue during the next few months.

- CITY COLLEGE STATION
- CIVIC CENTER STATION
- COUNTY CENTER/LITTLE ITALY STATION
- FIFTH AVENUE STATION
- PARK & MARKET STATION

### The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Funding for the project was provided by *TransNet*, the regional half-cent sales tax for transportation administered by SANDAG; California Proposition 1B; and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
