## Trolley Station Closures & Detours



## Station Construction: Downtown San Diego

October 2012 through March 2013

### GREEN LINE GOES DOWNTOWN!

The Green Line now provides direct service between Santee and Downtown San Diego via SDSU, Mission Valley, Old Town, Little Italy, Seaport Village, and Gaslamp Quarter.

The Seaport Village Station is now open! The County Center/Little Italy Station reopens this weekend.

### CURRENT CONSTRUCTION

Some stations may require occasional night or weekend construction work. Access for pedestrians and businesses will be maintained at all stations throughout construction.

#### PARK & MARKET STATION (OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION)

- Construction is anticipated through late October 2012.

#### CITY COLLEGE STATION (RELOCATED DURING CONSTRUCTION)

- Construction is anticipated through mid-December 2012.
- Station has been temporarily relocated to C Street between 10th and 11th Avenues during closure.
- Nearby businesses will remain open during construction.

#### 5TH and 6TH AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS

- Construction is anticipated through October 2012.
- Work includes adjustments to sidewalks, curbs, parking spots and lane configurations on 5th and 6th Avenues adjacent to the 5th Avenue Station between Broadway and C Street.

#### COUNTY CENTER/LITTLE ITALY STATION (CLOSED DURING CONSTRUCTION)

- Construction is anticipated through mid-October 2012. Station is scheduled to reopen for Little Italy FESTA!
- Trolley access for riders at Santa Fe Depot or Middletown stations during closure. Work will occur in the public sidewalk and vehicle shoulder areas. There will be narrowed lanes and/or temporary road closures on Beech and Cedar Streets.

***Construction schedules may change with very little notice.***



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

## FUTURE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

### 5TH AVENUE STATION

- Construction schedule will be announced soon.
- Station will be closed during construction. Trolley access for riders at Civic Center or City College Interim station during closure.

### 12th & IMPERIAL TRANSIT CENTER

- Construction schedule will be announced soon.

### C STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Construction is anticipated from January through late March 2013.

## MINIMAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Major construction work is now completed and these stations have reopened. Some minor construction activities may continue during the next few months.

### The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
