Trolley Station Closures & Detours



Station Construction: County Center/Little Italy Trolley Station

Late July through September 2012

The County Center/Little Italy Trolley Station is anticipated to be **CLOSED FOR RENOVATION** from late July through September 2012. Trolley access will be available at the Santa Fe Depot and Middletown Stations during the closure. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the Trolley system.

STATION/RIDER INFORMATION:

- The County Center/Little Italy Station will be closed for construction beginning late July through September 2012. The construction will include improvements to the station shelters, platform pavers, wiring and signaling.
- All construction is anticipated for completion before the Little Italy FESTA! on Oct. 14.
- During construction, riders will be able to access the trolley from Santa Fe Depot station. Signage at the stations and rider information on the Trolley will be in place to alert patrons of the closure.

STREET/BUSINESS:

- This work will take place adjacent to many residences and local businesses from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Noise and dust is anticipated during construction. Limited nighttime work anticipated.
- During construction, work will occur in the public sidewalk and vehicle shoulder areas, facilitating narrowed lanes on Beech and Cedar Streets. There is potential for temporary road closures on Beech and Cedar Streets to allow for construction deliveries or construction activities.
- Access for pedestrians and local businesses around the station will be maintained during construction.

THE TROLLEY RENEWAL PROJECT:

This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. Beginning in September, the Green Line will be extended through Old Town to downtown and terminate at 12th & Imperial via bayside stations (Seaport Village, Convention Center and Petco Park). This will provide one-seat service from Santee through Mission Valley to Petco Park, including service to the County Center/Little Italy Station. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride and an enhanced transit experience.
