**CARDS RING IN THE NEW YEAR BY OPENING SOUTHLAND PLAY**

Coming off one of the toughest non-conference schedules in school history, which included games on both coasts, in all four time zones and nearly than 15,000 miles on the road, the Lamar Cardinals (1-11) will look to right the ship as they open Southland Conference play at defending regular-season champion Stephen F. Austin and defending conference tournament champion Northwestern State. Lamar enters the conference opener against SFA looking to put an end to an eight-game skid, while the Lumberjacks (10-2) have won seven-straight after dropping an eight-point decision at East Tennessee State back in November. SFA will host Cal State Northridge Monday evening before facing Lamar. The game against the 'Jacks is set to tip off at 8 p.m. from the William R. Johnson Coliseum. The Cardinals will be back in action less than 48 hours later when they travel to Natchitoches, La., to face the Demons. Northwestern State has dropped two straight, and four of the last five games heading into their conference opener against Sam Houston State Thursday. The game against the Demons is slated to tip off at 3 p.m. from Prather Coliseum.

**LAMAR VS. THE LUMBERJACKS**

The Cardinals are 25-27 (.481) all-time against Stephen F. Austin, which includes an 8-16 (.333) record in Nacogdoches. Lamar enters Thursday's contest having lost consecutive games, four of the past five in the series, and four straight in the William R. Johnson Coliseum. LU's last victory in the series came during the 2012 Southland Conference tournament when the Cards recorded 55-44 decision.

**LAMAR VS. THE DEMONS**

Lamar is a game above .500, 24-23, all-time against Northwestern State but the Demons have closed the gap in recent years. LU has dropped consecutive games in the series, and six of the last eight overall. In similar fashion to the series against SFA, the Demons swept the 2012-13 season series, and Lamar's last victory came during the 2012 SLC Championship tournament, 76-69. The Cards have dropped four consecutive games in

Natchitoches, and are 5-17 (.227) all-time at Northwestern State. Lamar's last victory in Natchitoches came during the 2007-08 season.

### LAMAR IN SOUTHLAND OPENERS

The Cardinals are 39-23 (.629) all-time in conference openers, which includes a 25-14 (.641) record in Southland Conference openers. The Cardinals have won two of the past three conference openers but are coming off a 79-43 setback in the opener at Stephen F. Austin last season. Thursday's opener will be the second time in program history that Lamar has opened the conference schedule against the 'Jacks.

### LAMAR IN SOUTHLAND ROAD OPENERS

The Cardinals are 16-19 (.457) all-time in conference road openers, but two games above .500, 13-11 (.542), all-time in Southland Conference road-opening games. Lamar has split its last four conference road openers.

### LAMAR IN JANUARY

The Cardinals are 260-230 (.531) all-time in the month of January. Lamar has produced above .500 records in the month 30 times in program history, which includes three perfect records (1965-65, 1968-69 and 1987-88). The Cardinals have recorded a school record eight wins in the month in three separate seasons (1979-80, 1980-81 and 1987-88).

### ON THESE DATES IN HISTORY

Lamar is 19-9 (.679) all-time in games played on Jan. 2nd and Jan. 4th. The Cardinals are 6-1 (.857) all-time in games played on Jan. 2nd, and 13-8 (.619) all-time on the fourth day of the month. The Cards have played on both dates in the same season five other times in school history posting a 8-2 (.800) record in those games with three 2-0 marks. LU has played Stephen F. Austin one other time on Jan. 2nd, recording a victory during the 1980-81 season.

### SEEING DOUBLE

Junior Nimrod Hilliard has a streak of 12 games scoring in double-digit. The 6-0 junior from Madison, Wis., is the lone Cardinal to have scored in double-digits in every game this season. He currently leads the team, and is eighth in the league averaging 15.6 points per game. He has hit the 20-point plateau twice during the season, and has one double-double to his credit.

### LEAVING HIS IM-PRESTON ON THE GAME

Freshman Preston Mattingly left his impression on the game at Colorado State. One of only two freshmen on the team, the 6-2 Mattingly led the Cardinals in rebounding against CSU. In 16 minutes of action Mattingly came off the bench to score four points, pull down a team-high seven rebounds and dish out one assist.

## SHOOTING 50%

The second half against Colorado State marked the sixth time this season that Lamar has shot at least 50 percent in a half. The Cardinals finished just a shade under 50 percent for the game (30-of-64/.469). Lamar recorded a season-best 18-of-28 (.643) shooting in the second half against Arkansas State.

## SHARP SHOOTERS

The Cardinals offense has picked up the pace over the course of the past five games. Lamar is shooting 144-of-284 (.507), and is averaging nearly 75 points per game during that stretch.

## SEASON LOWS

Lamar recorded its best game of the season in terms of holding on to the basketball at Colorado State. The Cardinals turned the ball over a season-low nine times against the Rams. Unfortunately, Lamar was only able to force CSU into eight miscues, which is the second-lowest number of turnovers forced by the Cardinals this season.

## FREQUENT FLYER MILES

The Cardinals will be racking up the frequent-flyer miles this season. Lamar's 2013-14 schedule consists of games on both coasts, and in each time zone. So far, Lamar has traveled 14,943.17 miles.

## A HISTORICAL LOOK AT LAMAR

Lamar has been one of the Southland's more dominant teams. The Cardinals have recorded 265 wins, second to only McNeese State's 305 - among active league members, and the Cards have the highest winning percentage among those teams. Lamar has won more than 55 percent of its Southland games. The Cardinals also have the most NCAA tournament appearances of any current Southland school (6), and their five NIT berths are second to only Oral Roberts (7). The Cards have had 76 All-Southland Conference players, including 29 first-team selections. Five players have been named league newcomer of the year, four have earned MVP honors and there has been one freshman of the year selection. Five former Cardinals have also been named SLC Tourney MVP.

## INTERNATIONAL LOOK

The Lamar roster consists of players from four countries, and seven different states. Among the 13 players, only one hails from the Lone Star State. The lone Texan is senior Amos Wilson.

## CHASING HISTORY

A milestone for the longterm success of the Lamar men's basketball program is on the horizon. The Cardinals have recorded 919 all time victories, only 81 wins shy of 1,000. The Cardinals have recorded 12 20-win seasons during their history, won nine Southland Conference regular-season titles, made six NCAA Championship appearances, four post-season NIT appearances and had three All-Americans. In addition to program victories, Lamar is close to reaching other win milestones as well. LU is only 18 wins shy of 300 victories in the Montagne Center, and 35 wins shy of 300 Southland Conference victories.

## A LOOK AHEAD

The Cardinals will be back in the Montagne Center for the first time since Dec. 15th when they host Nicholls State Thursday, Jan. 9, at 7:30 p.m. Lamar will close out the brief two-game homestand Saturday, Jan. 11 against McNeese State. The game against the Cowboys is slated to tip off at 6 p.m.

## PAT KNIGHT

Third Season

77-112 (.407)/Seventh Season

27-51 (.346)/Third Season at Lamar

Pat Knight was named the university's 10th head coach, since Lamar became a four-year institution, prior to the 2011-12 season. The Pat Knight era got started in thrilling fashion as Knight guided the Cardinals to a

six-game win streak to close out the season taking the 2012 Southland Conference tournament title, and advance to the NCAA Championships. It was Lamar's sixth NCAA Tournament appearance and first since the 1999-2000 season.

Knight, who became the third Lamar coach to take the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season, also led the Cardinals to their first 20-win season since 1987-88. Lamar's 23 wins tied for the third highest single season total in school history.

Thanks to the outstanding season, Lamar had three players recognized as All-Southland Conference. Mike James was a first-team all-conference selection, while Devon Lamb and Anthony Miles were both named to the second-team. Brandon Davis was also honored by the league as he was named to the all-academic first-team.

Knight came to Lamar after 10 seasons at Texas Tech, including the final three-plus years as head coach. Named head coach designate at Tech prior to the 2005-06 season, Knight took over for his Hall-of-Fame father Bob Knight toward the end of the 2007-08 season.

In three-plus seasons as head coach of the Red Raiders, Knight compiled a 50-61 record. His 2009-10 squad posted a 19-16 overall record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the postseason National Invitation Tournament before falling at Mississippi in double overtime.

Knight, who is the 10th person to coach Lamar since the university became a four-year institution in 1951, guided the Red Raiders to an 83-80 win over fifth-ranked Texas in just his eighth game as a head coach, while his first victory on the college level came against No. 18 Kansas State five games earlier. The Red Raiders were a solid 40-20 (.667) at United Spirit Arena under Knight.

Knight served for nearly seven years as an assistant at Tech under his father which included four trips to the NCAA Tournament and a run to the Sweet 16 in 2005. Texas Tech enjoyed five 20-win seasons during Knight's tenure as an assistant.

Knight's professional career began as a scout and administrative assistant with the NBA's Phoenix Suns after his four-year playing career at Indiana. In 1997, Knight became an assistant coach with the Connecticut Pride of the Continental Basketball Association.

In 1998, Knight became a head coach for the first time, guiding the Wisconsin Blast of the International Basketball Association to a 19-15 record.

Knight began his college coaching career at his alma mater as an assistant for two seasons from 1998-2000. The Hoosiers were 43-20 during that time and played in the NCAA Tournament both years. In his second season at Indiana, senior guard A.J. Guyton earned AP First-Team All-America honors before becoming a second-round draft choice of the Chicago Bulls.

Knight then spent one season as an assistant at Akron before moving to Texas Tech.

A four-year letterwinner for the Hoosiers from 1991-95, Knight graduated in 1995 with a degree in sports management. During his playing days, Indiana appeared in the NCAA Tournament every season and advanced to the "Elite Eight" in 1993.

Knight and the former Amanda Shaw were married on May 10, 2002.
