Construction Scheduled to Start this Summer on New Classroom Building

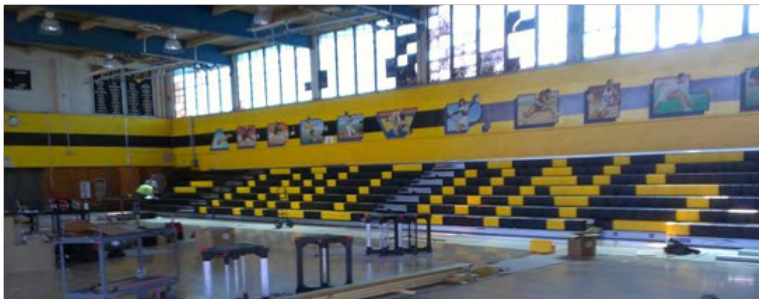
Over the next few months, portable classrooms will be placed by the outdoor basketball courts to temporarily house students next year during the construction of the new classroom building.

Building 100 and the 2 adjacent portables will be demolished and replaced with an 11 classroom multidisciplinary building. The new facility will contain 6 visual/digital arts classrooms, 2 chemistry labs and 3 general education classrooms.

The plans for the new building are currently being reviewed by the Division of the State Architect (DSA), which is a state agency that governs school construction. Once the project is approved by DSA, the District will bid the project and the Board will have to approve the award. Construction is tentatively planned for this summer.

Students are enjoying the new gym bleachers that were replaced last summer and the multi-purpose practice fields which were recently renovated to make them safer.

Other site improvement projects scheduled for Andrew Hill over the next 2 years include: electrical and HVAC system upgrades, new roofs for several buildings, door replacements in a number of areas and resurfacing of the track.

Completed Measure E Projects:

Other projects completed through Measure E include the modernization of our locker rooms and the addition of dugouts and fencing to the softball field. These projects were initiated to put Andrew Hill in compliance with Title IX and ADA requirements.
