Justine wins Zurich title, ascends to No. 1

Belgian leads season with eighth title

ZURICH, Switzerland – Belgium's Justine Henin-Hardenne took over the No. 1 ranking by defeating Jelena Dokic 6-0, 6-4 in only 50 minutes in the Swisscom Challenge final.

The two-time Grand Slam champion capped a stellar last 12 months when she overtook compatriot Kim Clijsters as the world's No. 1 on publication of the new WTA Tour rankings on Monday. Henin-Hardenne is the second Belgian in the last 11 weeks to ascend to the top of the rankings.

"All my life I have dreamed about winning Grand Slams and being No. 1 in the world. This is a very special day for me and one I will remember forever. It's taking a while to sink in now, and I think it will take a few days to truly realize what has happened here," said Henin-Hardenne.

Praise from her countrywoman Clijsters quickly followed, "I'm happy for her. I've always said that if the top ranking had to change, then it should go to another Belgian. She's had a great year and she's probably the most improved player on the Tour this season."

The 21-year-old's amazing run began with a superior fitness program under the guidance of the WTA Tour Sport Sciences and Medicine Team, who work very closely with the new No. 1, as well as Pat Etcheberry, whom she started working with last December. She started her 2003 Grand Slam campaign with her best Australian Open showing (semifinals), where she scored her first career win in six meetings over Lindsay Davenport 7-5, 5-7, 9-7 en route. In February, Henin-Hardenne outlasted Monica Seles in a thrilling three-set encounter, saving two match points, to win the title in Dubai. In April, the Belgian ended then-world No. 1 Serena Williams' 21-match unbeaten run

in the Family Circle Cup final. Another breakthrough win followed in Berlin, where she saved two match points to defeat Clijsters for only the third time in 10 professional meetings.

All of this culminated in defeats of the world's top two players, first Williams, then Clijsters at Roland Garros en route to her first Grand Slam title. Williams gained revenge in the Wimbledon semifinals, but after that, Henin-Hardenne was virtually unstoppable, claiming her first title on U.S. hardcourts in San Diego, then the Canadian Open and her second Grand Slam title at the US Open, defeating then-No. 1 Clijsters in the final. Her 22-match win streak (longest for almost two years) was snapped by Anastasia Myskina in the final of Leipzig three weeks ago.

In Filderstadt, she had a chance to take over the No. 1 ranking in another all-Belgian final, but Clijsters prevailed and retained the top spot for another week. In Zurich though, Henin-Hardenne would not be stopped from being No. 1. She overcame Dokic, who has playing in her first Tier I final since Zurich [cont. page 2]

in 2001, in straight sets to claim victory, the top ranking and \$189,000 in prize money.

"I knew if I won this match that I would be part of history and become on the 13th player to be No. 1 on the WTA Tour, but I learned from my experience in Filderstadt last week," said the newly crowned No. 1.

She added, "My next focus is not on keeping No. 1 but my first match at the Championships in L.A. I want to be fresh and ready for that in two weeks time."

Henin-Hardenne also leads in the WTA Tour Porsche Race to the Championships with 6,418 points, 282 points ahead of Clijsters. This season, Henin-Hardenne has won more singles titles (eight) and prize money (US\$ 3,277,264) than any other player, male or female.

Henin-Hardenne becomes the 13th woman to ascend to the No. 1 spot since computer rankings were first introduced on November 3, 1975, joining the likes of former greats Chris Evert, Martina Navratilova, Steffi Graf, Monica Seles, Martina Hingis, and most recently the Williams sisters.

WTA TOUR MENTOR APPRECIATION AWARD

Former player Katerina Maleeva was honoured for participating in the WTA Tour's mentor program, Partners for Success, at the Swisscom Challenge in Zurich, Switzerland.

It was a family affair in Zurich, where Maleeva from Bulgaria, three-time quarterfinalist at the Swisscom Challenge, was presented with her award on-court, in front of an appreciative Swiss crowd. Former Zurich singles champion and older sister Manuela Maleeva were also on hand for the ceremony.

Katerina was touched and surprised by letters of tribute read to her on-court. Her protégé, Anastasia Myskina of Russia, expressed her thanks and admiration of Katerina's help. Youngest sister, Magdalena Maleeva, currently ranked No. 18 on the Tour, also wrote a tribute that thanked her sister for her mentoring skills.

WEEKS AT No.1

Henin-Hardenne takes over top ranking

Twenty-one-year-old Belgian Justine Henin-Hardenne spends her first week as the world No. 1 after defeating Jelena Dokic in Zurich on Sunday.

She took over the top spot from compatriot Kim Clijsters who reigned for 10 weeks. Both players are the only Belgians to hold the No. 1 ranking in WTA Tour history. In addition to being No. 1, Henin-Hardenne also holds eight 2003 singles titles, the most for any player this season.

All numbers date from 3 November 1975, when WTA computer rankings began, through the week of 20 October 2003:

DOUBLES WRAP

ZURICH, Switzerland - Top seeds Kim Clijsters of Belgium and Ai Sugiyama of Japan collected their seventh WTA Tour doubles title this year, the most of any players for 2003. They defeated No. 2 seeds Virginia Ruano Pascual of Spain and Paola Suarez of Argentina 7-6(3), 6-2.

Clijsters claimed her 11th career doubles title and Sugiyama clinched her 27th. They won their first Tour doubles title as a team at the start of this year in Sydney.

Ruano Pascual and Suarez were playing in their 31st doubles final together, the ninth of 2003. They have 19 career titles as a team, including four Grand Slams titles (two Roland Garros, two US Open).

Ruano Pascual and Suarez are still the leaders in the Porsche Race to the Championships with 4,077 points, 149 points ahead of the No. 2 team Clijsters and Sugiyama.

NEWS BRIEFS

Qualifiers Announced: Capriati and Navratilova



St. Petersburg, FL - Three-time Grand Slam champion Jennifer Capriati and tennis legend Martina Navratilova have qualified for the season-ending Bank of America WTA Tour Championships presented by Porsche, November 5-10, the WTA Tour announced.

Capriati joins World No. 1 Kim Clijsters and World No. 2 Justine Henin-Hardenne as singles qualifiers for the coveted event at STAPLES Center in Los Angeles. World No. 3 Serena Williams and No. 4 Lindsay Davenport have also qualified but are not expected to play in order to recover from surgeries this year.

Capriati, who is currently fourth in the Porsche Race to the Championships standings with 2,471 points, clinched a spot in the eight-player singles field because of her outstanding results so far this season. She has been solid virtually all season, reaching at least the quarterfinals in 11 of her 17 tournaments in 2003. Also, her three-set US Open semifinal duel against Henin-Hardenne last month is being considered as one of the greatest matches of all-time.

Navratilova and partner Svetlana Kuznetsova earned a spot in the four-team doubles field, along with Virginia Ruano Pascual/Paola Suarez and Clijsters/Ai Sugiyama. Ruano Pascual/Suarez lead the current Porsche Race to the Championships doubles standings with 3,851 points, followed by Clijsters/Sugiyama with 3,581 points and Navratilova/Kuznetsova with 2,695 points.

With three weeks remaining in the Porsche Race to the Championships, there is a tight battle for the final four singles spots. There are at least nine players – Amelie Mauresmo, Elena Dementieva, Venus Williams, Anastasia Myskina, Chanda Rubin, Ai Sugiyama, Vera Zvonareva, Nadia Petrova and Paola Suarez – within reach of those four spots.

In the doubles race, Davenport/Lisa Raymond (2,329 points) are currently fourth in the standings, but Davenport's withdrawal means Cara Black and Elena Likhovtsova, who are currently fifth with 1,962 points, will have to fend off all challengers for the final spot in the field.

Player of the Month Awards

St. Petersburg, FL - The WTA Tour announced Player of the Month Awards for July, August, and September. Three different winners were proclaimed for each of these months—Serena Williams, Kim Clijsters and Justine Henin-Hardenne.

Williams earned the honor for July. The then-world No. 1 clinched her second Grand Slam of the 2003 season at Wimbledon. Williams defended her Wimbledon title and notched her sixth career Grand Slam title, winning the last five of six Grand Slams. She defeated her sister Venus in the final, 4-6 6-4 6-2, and improved her win-loss record to 38-3 for the season.

Belgium's Clijsters was selected as August's Player of the Month. After winning the title at the JP Morgan Chase Open in Los Angeles, Clijsters became No.1 in the world. She was the 12th woman and first Belgian in the Open Era to hold the top spot, overtaking Serena Williams' 57-week run as the world No. 1. Clijsters' win in Los Angeles was her sixth title and 11th final appearance of the year. Clijsters also continued her amazing run of reaching the semifinals or better in all 14 tournaments that she had competed in up to that point.

Henin-Hardenne earned Player of the Month honors for September. She won her second Grand Slam at the US Open, becoming the first Belgian to hoist a US Open trophy. She was forced to take intravenous fluids less than 24 hours before her final match as she did not allow herself to succumb to leg cramps in her epic semifinal battle against Jennifer Capriati. Henin-Hardenne was down 5-3 in both the second and third sets but rallied to defeat Capriati before toppling Clijsters in the championship match 7-5, 6-1. She claimed her 13th Tour singles titles, more than half these in 2003. Following the win, Henin-Hardenne climbed to career-high world No. 2 and topped the chart with the most singles titles won in 2003 at seven.

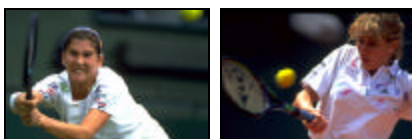
16 GREATEST MATCHES IN PROFESSIONAL TENNIS

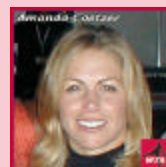

The score line may not impress, but the outcome certainly made an impact. By defeating Dokic, Henin-Hardenne secured another place in WTA Tour history as the 13th player to ascend to the No. 1 ranking. She displaced her compatriot Kim Clijsters from the top spot, which Clijsters held for 10 weeks.

OTHER NOTABLE WINS

Jelena Dokic (YUG #25) d. (1) Kim Clijsters (BEL #1), Zurich Semifinals: The twenty-year-old had not beaten a top ten player in over a year. In Zurich, she knocked out not only No. 10 Chanda Rubin but the No. 1 player in the world in 1 hour, 19 minutes to reach her first Tier I final since Zurich in 2001.

Nadia Petrova (RUS #14) d. (4) Elena Dementieva (RUS #8), Zurich Second Round: The Russian pulled off her second career-best win by beating top Russian Dementieva. This win is second after her upset of No. 7 Capriati at this year's Roland Garros.

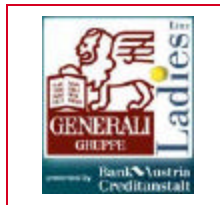
