

Our Barn is a Victorian Era building, originally the stables connected to Faversham House built in 1849 by Mr John Monger.

Faversham House remained in Mr. Monger's family until WW II when it was handed over to the Commonwealth Government and used by the Red Cross as a convalescent home for the armed services.

Our Barn was converted into a dormitory by the Girl Guides of Western Australia in the 1970's with materials and labour donated and raised by the good people of York and Western Australia. Our Barn was officially opened on Sunday May 1st 1977 by His Excellency Governor Sir Wallace Kyle.

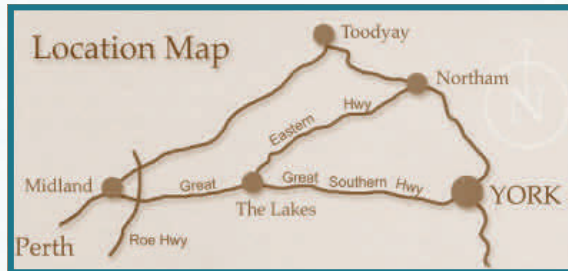
OUR BARN YORK

FACILITIES / TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Our Barn sleeps 35 in an enchanting old-fashioned bunk room plus two twin rooms. Each bed equipped with a pillow, two blankets and a patchwork quilt made and donated by the Guides and Leaders of Western Australia. You will need to supply your own sheets, even when using a sleeping bag.

The bathroom is equipped with four showers and five toilets with a smaller bathroom with one shower and toilet.

Also available is an activity room as well as charming conference facilities suitable for group training and team building activities, a dining room with seating for 48 people and a fully equipped kitchen and outdoor BBQ with china, cutlery, kitchen tools and cleaning equipment.

The conference room can also be used for activities such as quilting and art as there are sufficient power points and table space.

The dining room, dormitory and conference room are all fitted with reverse cycle air conditioning.

Please remember that there are to be no campfires at Our Barn as there are strict yearly bans in place.

No pets or smoking are permitted at Our Barn.
