

Katy Perry's 'Roar' claims an ARIA Singles Chart milestone this week,

Pearl Jam enjoy their eighth ARIA #1 Album as 'Lightning Bolt' makes its debut

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: Katy Perry 'Roar' – After becoming Katy Perry's longest-running #1 on the ARIA Charts last week, Roar stretches its run to eight weeks at the peak this week, to become equal longest running number of the year with Robin Thicke's 'Blurred Lines'.

#2: Avicii 'Hey Brother' – Up 12 spots from last week's top 50 debut spot. It becomes Avicii's third top five hit, joining I Could Be The One (#4 Mar. '13) and Wake Me Up (#1 Jul. '13).

#4: Nathaniel 'You' – Up five spots from last week's debut position.

#6: Pitbull Feat. Ke\$ha 'Timber' (debut) – Their joint tour may have been cancelled but that hasn't stopped Pitbull and Ke\$ha hitting the chart. It's Pitbull's second top ten of the year as a lead artist after Feel This Moment (6 Mar. '13).

#15: Justice Crew '**Everybody**' (debut) – The first chart appearance in 2013 for Justice Crew. Follows two top ten singles in 2012; Boom Boom (#1 Aug. '12) and Best Night (#7 Dec. '12).





#18: Eminem 'Survival' (debut) – One of two debuts this week for Eminem, giving him a total of three tracks in the top 50. The other track, Rap God, debuts at #40. Both come from Eminem's forthcoming album The Marshall Mathers LP 2.

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: Pearl Jam 'Lightning Bolt' (debut) – Eighth #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart for the American grunge veterans. Lightning Bolt's chart debut comes nearly 20 years to the week of the band's first visit to the top of the chart with VS (#1 Oct. '93). The band's tenth studio album comes four years on from Backspacer (#1 Sept. '09). They're one of the headliners of this year's Big Day Out tour.

#6: Havana Brown 'Flashing Lights' (debut) – Debut studio album for Melbourne singersongwriter/DJ. Includes the chart hits We Run The Night (#5 Jun. '11), Big Banana (#18 Apr. '13) and Warrior (#24 Oct. '13).

#7: John Newman 'Tribute' (debut) – Debut album from British soul-pop singer-songwriter. Features the top five single Love Me Again (#4 Sept. '13). The album's second single, Cheating, currently sits at #75 on the ARIA Singles Chart.

#8: Trivium 'Vengeance Falls' (debut) - Sixth studio album from the Florida heavy metal band and their third top ten locally. Follow up to 2011's In Waves (#9 Aug. '11).





#21: Stonefield 'Stonefield' (debut) – Debut studio album from Victorian sisters Amy, Hannah, Sarah and Holly Findlay. Prior to the album's release, the quartet picked up their first chart appearance with the six-track Bad Reality EP (#71 May '12).

#22: Paul McCartney 'New' (debut) – Sixteenth solo studio album from Paul McCartney. It's his first album of all originals since Memory Almost Full (#33 Jun. '07). Last year he released the standards album Kisses On The Bottom (#15 Feb. '12).
