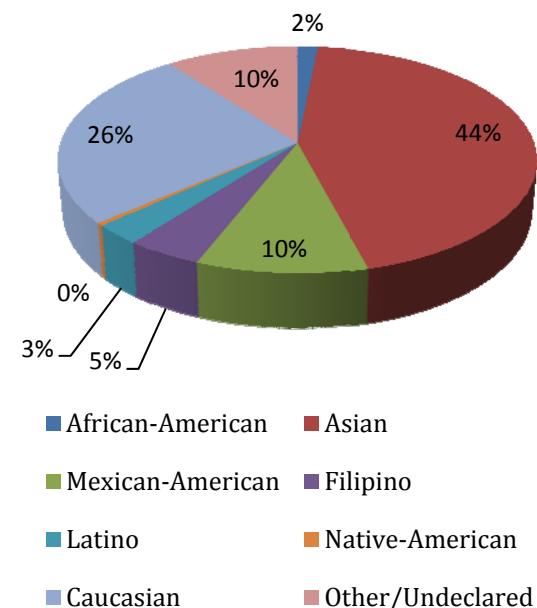

Undergraduates by Ethnicity, Fall 2009

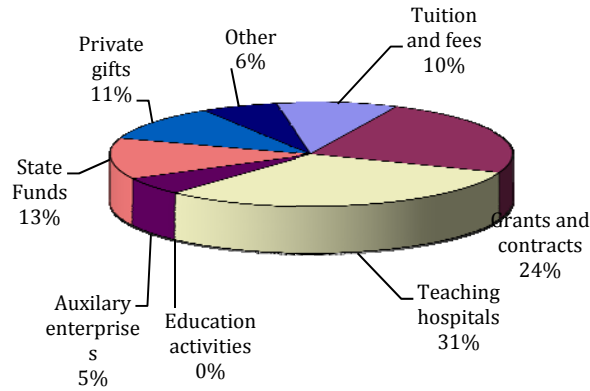

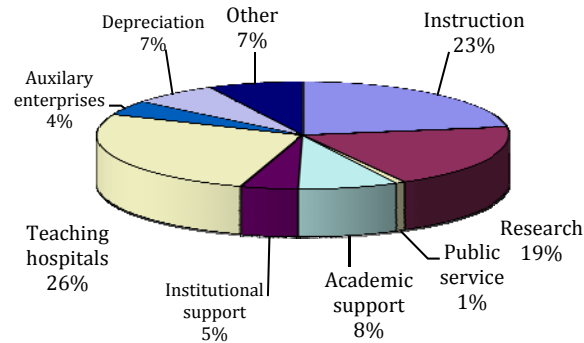
