Once the so called modernity is over (or maybe not?), we have the possibility to review the actual and future needs of the house, and further of the home concept. This International week has the aim to look forward on these aspects from three different approaches:

- Architecture, the house and the domestic space.
- The Interior Design, furniture and new ways of living.
- The equipment, technology and software applications for the actual and future home.

To reach that objective the International Week will gather students and professors of the three disciplines, involving all the structure of the Superior Technical School of the CEU Cardenal Herrera University on the event.

The exchange of teaching approaches and the transmission of different strategies can be the key to understanding what aspects are intrinsic to our disciplines and which in turn permit or require a higher degree of adaptability.

The objectives of this encounter are:

To share teaching strategies and methodological disciplines around practical or theoretical disciplines linked to the studies of Design, Architecture and Tics.

To discover different specific realities of the European context in our disciplines, emphasizing those approaches more specifically linked to each local culture. The overlapping of realities should reflect both the wide range of existing and potential synergies and also the contact points between the participants.

To look forward on the concepts of intelligent houses, of the new social and spatial conditions of the future home and also to work about concepts like prefabrication and industrialization in architecture.

Dates: From February 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> 2014.

Activities:

- A. Lectures and conferences.
- B. Thematic workshops and special classes.
- C. Exhibition of results and discussions in public sessions.
- D. Site visits to Valencia for foreign teachers.

The program is open to all the scholars interested in the subject coming from any European institution, and will be based in the ERASMUS Staff Mobility grants.
