### Fastbreak

- This is Dave Loos' 24th season as Austin Peay head coach and he is 380-345 at APSU—the winningest basketball coach in Ohio Valley Conference history—and 462-398 all-time in his 28th season as a college head coach.
- For the first time since the 1996 season Dave Loos is only the Austin Peay basketball coach. He stepped down as APSU Athletics Director last April.
- APSU was picked to finish third behind Southeast Missouri and Murray State in the OVC West Division in the preseason poll.
- Since 1993-94, Austin Peay has finished at .500 or above in the OVC for 19 of the last 20 seasons, that one season being 2012-13.
- In 2013, the Governors failed to reach the OVC tourney for the first time in Dave Loos' coaching career. They have appeared in 28 of the last 29 OVC tourneys.
- Senior guard Travis Betran and senior forward Will Triggs were named Preseason All-OVC as voted by the conference coaches and sports information directors.
- The Governors enter the contest 9-12 and 3-4 in the OVC after defeating Tennessee Tech, 83-69, Saturday.
- Senior forward Will Triggs (17 points, 13 rebounds) contributed his season's first double-double while guard Travis Betran recorded his season's fifth 20-point outing.
- Murray State comes in after sweeping Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State last weekend, beating Jacksonville State, 73-65 last Saturday.
- The Racers, who beat the Gobs 89-67 in Murray earlier this season, are led by freshman guard Cameron Payne (14.9 ppg) and transfer T.J. Sapp (13.9 ppg) while guard Jeffrey Moss (13.2 ppg) had seven threes against Tennessee Tech.

## DETAILING TONIGHT'S GAME

## What You Should Know...

**THE SERIES:** This is the 119th meeting between the two OVC rivals, Austin Peay and Murray State, with the Governors trailing, 78-41. The Racers won this season's earlier meeting, 89-67, Jan. 11 in Murray. Dexter Fields led six Racers in double figures with 20 points. Travis Betran and Will Triggs each had 17 for the Govs. The loss was the Govs sixth straight in the series.

## Deeper Meanings...

**WHAT A WIN WOULD MEAN:** It would make the Governors 10-12 heading into next Thursday's road contest at Tennessee State...it would make the Govs 4-4 in the OVC...it would make the Govs 4-4 in 2014...it would improve the Govs to 8-3 at home...they would go to 4-1 at home in OVC play...it would improve the Govs to 42-78 against Murray State... it would give Dave Loos a 20-33 record against Murray State...it would make Loos 1-5 all-time against Murray State coach Steve Prohm...it would be Dave Loos' 463rd career victory.

**WHAT A LOSS WOULD MEAN:** The Govs would drop to 9-13 overall...they would fall two games below the .500 mark in OVC play at 3-5...they would end January at 3-5...it would drop APSU's home mark to 7-4...it would be APSU's seventh straight loss in the series...Loos would drop to 462-399 overall and 380-346 as the Governors head coach.

## OVC DIVISIONAL PLAY

### OVC in second year of divisional play

For the second time this year the OVC will use divisional play for men's and women's basketball. The addition of Belmont, July 1, 2012, gave the OVC 12 member institutions, the largest the Conference has been since it was formed in 1948 (the OVC is currently the nation's eighth-oldest Division I conference). The East Division includes Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. The West Division includes Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin. Some of the factors in determining the divisions included geography and balance while also being mindful of matchups and rivalries (both current and future).



### OVC tourney begins fourth season of current format

After debuting a new format and home for the OVC Tournament in 2011, the tournament will once again return to Municipal Auditorium in Nashville this year. Once again the top eight men's and women's teams will qualify for the tournament and advance to play in Nashville (as opposed to playing first round games in campus sites) under a merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds will receive two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds will receive one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round will include the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. Now that divisional play is used, the winner of each division is guaranteed one of the top two seeds while seeds 3-8 will be based on overall conference record regardless of division.



## GOVERNORS STATE: (LAST SATURDAY REVIEW)

## What went right?

- Damarius Smith returned as point guard after missing the Jacksonville State game with ankle sprain. He finished with a career-high 18 points and nine assists in 40 minutes against Tennessee Tech.
- Will Triggs tallied his season's first double-double with 17 points and 13 rebounds against Tennessee Tech. The 13 rebounds were a career high.
- After going 3-of-13 from three-point territory against Jacksonville State, the Governors went 7-of-12 (58 percent) against Tennessee Tech.
- After scoring seven points against Jacksonville State, senior guard Travis Betran, a preseason All-OVC selection, scored a game-high 20 points, going 4-of-7 from three and a perfect 8-of-8 at the free-throw line.
- The Governors converted 25-of-37 (68 percent) from the field against Tennessee Tech, the second best field goal percentage they shot this season and the best against a Division I opponent.
- The Governors connected on 26 of 32 free throw attempts against Tennessee Tech, the 81.3 percentage a season best.

## What went wrong?

- The Governors permitted 18 offensive rebounds to Tennessee Tech, the 15th time they have permitted double-digit offensive rebounds this season.
- Chris Horton failed to lead the Governors in rebounding for the first time in 21 games this season as Will Triggs earned that honor with 13.
- The Governors turned it over 18 times, the 10th time this season they have committed 18 or more turnovers this season.

## GOVERNORS DECREE

**GUARANTEE GAMES:** In his 24th season as head coach, Dave Loos and his basketball program annually have helped supplement the APSU budget with "guarantee" games. In fact, with this season's three games (Memphis, Vanderbilt, Central Michigan), APSU has played 89 games for direct guarantee money or as part of tournaments where at least one game has not been at a neutral site.

**PRESEASON ALL-OVC SELECTIONS:** Senior guard Travis Betran (17.2 ppg) and senior forward Will Triggs (13.7 ppg) were named Preseason All-OVC in a vote of conference coaches and sports information directors. Last season the Governors failed to have a player named to the preseason team for the first time since 2006-07.

**51ST OVC SEASON:** Austin Peay began playing OVC basketball in the 1963-64 season, meaning 2013-14 is APSU's 51st as a member. Austin Peay ended the 2012-13 season with an 4-12 OVC record. The Governors are now 400-360 (.526) during their near five decades as an OVC competitor. Before APSU head coach Dave Loos took over in 1990-91, APSU owned a 165-207 OVC mark.

## ABOUT THE 2013-14 GOVS

- Senior forward **Will Triggs** was a prep teammate of former Gov forward and 1,000-point scorer Anthony Campbell as a sophomore. As a prep senior, Triggs recorded double-doubles in 28 games.
- Redshirt junior guard **Thomas Greer** played for his father, Mike, at West Carroll High School where he was a Class A Mr. Basketball nominee. His sister Addy, was a former walk-on player at UT Martin.
- Junior forward **Chris Freeman** played for his uncle, former Kentucky star Reggie Warford, two years ago at Muhlenberg County HS. His cousin, Derick Warford played football with New England. Another cousin, Bob Lanier, is a former Detroit Pistons star and is a member of NBA Hall of Fame.
- Senior guard **Travis Betran**, a Harlem, N.Y., native, didn't begin playing basketball until he was in fifth grade, but became a regular at Rucker Park, the most famous streetball court in the country.
- Sophomore forward **Preston Herring** was a second-team Alabama All-State selection as a 6-3 guard in 2009-10. A little more than a year later he earned All-State honors as a 6-7 forward/center, growing four inches in a little more than a year.
- Sophomore center/forward **Chris Horton** was a member of three straight high school state championships at Columbia High School in Decatur, Ga. Horton's father, Eddie, played for Austin Peay back in the mid-1970s.
- Sophomore guard **Cory Arentsen** played his AAU Basketball for the St. Louis Eagles, a program that produced former Govs' guard Colby Pierce and center Zac Schlader.
- Walk-on senior guard **Jeremy Purvis** was a teammate of prep All-American Alex Poythress, now at Kentucky, at Northeast High School.
- When redshirt sophomore **Zavion Williams** scored 28 points for Lipscomb against SIUE as a freshman it was the most points by a Bison since 2002. In earning A-Sun Freshman of the Week honor, he became the program's first to earn such distinction.
- Junior guard **Damarius (DeeDee) Smith's** brother, Amius Smith, was an All-OVC defensive back for the Governors football team. Smith also was a former teammate of Zavion Williams at Lipscomb before transferring to Vincennes Community College.
- Sophomore forward **Serigne Mboup** has a 6-10 older brother Alioune who plays for Division II Henderson State.
- Junior transfer guard **Fred Garmon** has a brother, Dontavis Jones, who played basketball for Mineral Area Community College and then later at Henderson State.
- The father of junior guard **Ed Dyson** serves as pastor of the Word of Life Pray Praise & Worship Center in Maryland.
- Walk-on forward **Josh Ledbetter**, who averaged 14.8 points and 8.8 rebounds per game as a prep senior in Michigan, is the stepson of APSU football coach Kirby Cannon.

## OVC DN IN SECOND YEAR

The OVC launched the OVC Digital Network (OVC DN) in August 2012. The OVC DN is the exclusive home for live web streamed athletic contests involving OVC schools. Overall 2013-14 marks the eighth year the OVC has streamed live events. Starting with the re-branding of the streaming in 2012-13, events were offered free of charge and in an HD format and featured improved quality thanks to an investment in new equipment conference-wide. Fans also find it easier to log onto OVC Digital Network.com and access the streams and can do so without any registration. The events are available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

## TV/ONLINE VIEWING

Fans can catch APSU men and women's basketball games on the internet at the OVC Digital Network. Every APSU home game and OVC contest, including the OVC Basketball Tourney, will be available online in 2013-14. Austin Peay home games are produced by APSU's Mass Communications department—Peay Nation Broadcasting—and broadcast on cable access Channel 99, U-verse 99 and CDE Lightband Channel 9.

## BRACKETBUSTER ERA OVER

One obvious schedule change for the Govs this season is it no longer includes an ESPN BracketBusters game. The series started in 2003 and Austin Peay became the first Ohio Valley Conference team to participate in 2004. However, it was decided that last season's BracketBusters would be the last.

**FINDING THE RANGE:** In Austin Peay's previous three games, they shot a combined 10-of-42 (24 percent) from behind the arc. Against Tennessee Tech they shot 7-of-12 (58 percent).

**FREE THROW HIGH:** After going 2-of-11 at the free throw line in the first half against Jacksonville State and 14 of 27 for the game, the Govs shot a season best 81 percent (26 of 32) from the line against Tennessee Tech. Senior guard Travis Betran led the Govs in free-throw percentage, going 8-for-8.

**RETURN TO SENDER:** After blocking five shots against Jacksonville State, sophomore center Chris Horton's three blocks against Tennessee Tech moved him to 164 career blocks and into second on the all-time block list, passing Reggie Crenshaw (1994-98/163). Horton still has a ways to go to break the all-time record of 257 by Josh Lewis (2000-04).

### BREAKS

**SLUMP:** After scoring just seven points against Jacksonville State, Travis Betran led the Govs in scoring with 20 points versus Tennessee Tech, the fifth time his season the senior guard reached the 20-point threshold.

**CATCHING FIRE:** After starting the game 1-for-5 from the field against Tennessee Tech, the Govs went 24-of-33 (72.7 percent) the game's remainder. The 68 percent shooting effort was their second highest percentage this season and best during OVC play.

**STRANGE STAT:** Despite permitting 18 offensive rebounds, the Govs out-rebounded Tennessee Tech, 29-27, the seventh time in the last 10 games they have out-rebounded the opponent.

**SMASHING RETURN:** After missing Thursday's game with an ankle sprain, junior guard Damarius Smith had a season-high 18 points against Tennessee Tech, topping his previous high of 16 recorded against Montana State, Nov. 11. Smith also led the team with nine assists on the night, playing all 40 minutes.

**WILLFULLY:** Senior forward Will Triggs

recorded his season's first double-double and career's fifth against Tennessee Tech, scoring 17 points and pulling down 13 rebounds. The 13 rebounds represented a career best.

**INSIDER TRADING:** Chris Horton scored 12 points on 5-of-5 shooting against Tennessee Tech. The Govs' starting inside players Horton and Will Triggs shot a combined 10-of-14 (71 percent) from the field against the Golden Eagles.

**STREAK SNAPPED;** With this 13-rebound effort against Tennessee Tech, Triggs was APSU's rebound leader, snapping Chris Horton's streak of being the Govs rebound leader or co-leader in every

previous game (20) this season.

### TURNING THE

**PAGE:** Despite an 18-turnover outing, the Governors pulled off the victory against Tennessee Tech, making it the first time this season in nine games this season against Division I opponents they had won committing 18 or more turnovers.

### POINTED

**OUT:** Not one but two point guards missed the Jan. 23 game with Jacksonville State. Starting point guard Damarius Smith rolled

an ankle in the previous Wednesday's practice and was unable to play. In addition, his backup Fred Garmon, who was coming off playing 16 minutes—his most since the season opener—also missed the game with nagging knee issues. Sophomore Zavion Williams started in his place while junior Thomas Greer also got minutes at the position.

**MILESTONE REACHED:** With a first-half free throw against Eastern Illinois, senior forward Will Triggs cracked the 1,000-point career milestone. The Edwardsville, Ill., native became the 33rd Governor in history to reach that coveted figure. He finished the game with 15 points.

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE:** With his 13 points and 11 rebounds against Eastern Illinois it made it back-to-back double-doubles for Horton and 10 for the season. He is now moved up to fifth in Division I for double-doubles this season.

**New Scoreboard, LED boards for DC**

A year after having a new state-of-the-art playing surface installed, the Dunn Center now has a new center-scoreboard assembly that is 21-feet wide and 14 ½-feet tall and weighs more than 9,000 pounds. It consists of four LED video screens that face each court side—the video screens are 9 feet, 5 inches tall and 16 feet, 2 inches wide.

**BOARD EDGE:** When the Governors gained a 27-25 rebounding edge against Eastern Illinois it was the third straight game the Govs held the rebound advantage.

**FREE-DOM:** APSU connected on 15 of 21 free throws against Eastern Illinois, with the 71.4 percent representing the first time the Govs shot 70 percent or better at the line in the previous seven games.

**BOUNCE BACK:** After being held to a season-low five points against Murray State, sophomore center Chris Horton bounced back 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting and 11 rebounds against SIUE. It was the fifth time this season Horton has scored 20 or more points. It also was his season's ninth double-double.

**BREAK OUT BROKEN:** After the Christmas break, senior guard Travis Betran scored in double figures the first four contests and shot 26 of 49 (53 percent) from the floor in four games, including 16 three pointers. But that hot streak ended in Illinois. Betran went a combined 6-of-20.

**DOUBLE-FIGURE REBOUNDS:** When Chris Horton grabbed 11 rebounds against Eastern Illinois, it was the 12th time in 19 games he reached double-figure rebounds and the 21st in his two-season career.

**NUMBERS TELL THE STORY:** When Eastern Illinois out-shot the Govs 53.1 percent to 48.9 percent, it left the Govs 0-7 when the opponent wins the field-goal shooting battle.

**RESERVE ENERGY:** Before making his first start against SIUE since the Central Michigan game in mid-November, sophomore guard Zavion Williams came off the bench to score double figures in four straight games. During the four-game streak Williams averaged 15.2 ppg, shooting 62.5 percent from the floor.

**DIME THROWER:** Junior guard Damarius Smith had 10 assists against Southeast Missouri, Jan. 4, his fourth double-digit assist outing

**MOVING UP ON:** Senior guard Travis Betran's 16 points against SEMO gave him 750 points in his Govs career.

**RECORD BREAKER:** Sophomore center Chris Horton set a school and Dunn Center record with eight blocked shots, Jan. 2, against UT Martin. It broke the record of seven that John Fraley established on March 3, 2011 and Horton had tied five times, including the SIU contest, Nov. 19.

**HORTON HEARS A WHO:** Sophomore center Chris Horton came two blocks short of recording his first career triple double against UT Martin, Jan. 2. He finished with 16 points, 12 rebounds and a school-record eight blocks. Horton's double-double was his seventh this season.

**FIVE ALIVE:** In the 81-68 win against UT Martin, the Govs finished with five players (Chris Horton 16, Zavion Williams 16, Travis Betran 15, Will Triggs 15, Damarius Smith 11) in double figures scoring-wise for the first time since turning the feat versus Lipscomb, Dec. 12.

**BENCHMADE:** Sophomore guard Zavion Williams came off the bench to scored 16 points, tying for the team high, and recorded seven assists, matching his career best, against UT Martin. Williams also collected three steals.

(74 percent) against Vanderbilt, Lipscomb and East Tennessee, sophomore center Chris Horton saw his shooting percentage rise to 62.5..

**CORY MEASURES:** Cory Arentsen's seven three pointers against East Tennessee not only were a career best but were the most by a Governor since TyShwan Edmondson had seven against Tennessee State, Jan. 15, 2011.

**CAREER HIGH:** Cory Arentsen's 21 points against ETSU not only was his first career 20-point contest but only his second career double-digit effort as well.

**BOOPA DOOP:** Sophomore forward Serigne Mboup came off the bench to score a career-high 10 points on 4-of-6 shooting against ETSU. He tied his career-best with six rebounds. After setting a personal mark for minutes played with 15 against Lipscomb, he bested it with 19 minutes at East Tennessee. For the pre-Christmas week, Mboup played 44 minutes off the bench, scoring 18 points while grabbing 16 rebounds.

**SOPHOMORE RUSH:** APSU's top three scorers (Chris Horton 23, Cory Arentsen 21, Serigne Mboup 10) against East Tennessee were sophomores.

**OVC AWARD:** Sophomore Chris Horton put together his season's sixth double-double with 16 points, going 8-of-11 from the floor, and 10 rebounds against Vanderbilt. It backed up his OVC Player of the Week effort of 21 points, and 11 rebounds against Liberty. Horton also blocked four shots. It was Horton's first career OVC Player of the Week honor after earning OVC Freshman of the Week nine times a year ago.

**DIME DELIVERY:** For the second time this

season, junior guard Damarius Smith posted a double-digit assist total, with a career-high 12 against Liberty. It was the highest total posted by a Gov since Derek Wright had 12 assists at UT Martin, Jan. 3, 2008.

**20-20:** Travis Betran's 23 points and Chris Horton's 21 against Liberty marked the first time two Govs scored 20 since Will Triggs and Travis Betran had 20 each against Morehead State, Jan. 9, 2013.

**THIEVERY:** With 12 thefts against Samford, Dec. 7, it was the second time this season the Govs reached double-digit steals. They had 14 steals in their loss at Memphis in mid-November.

**MOVING UP:** Senior guard Travis Betran hit four three-point field goals versus ETSU giving him 101 total in his career. He became the 19th Gov to record at least 100 career threes.

**COACHING MILESTONE:** The Governors' 88-86 win against Youngstown State was the 375th Austin Peay win for head coach Dave Loos.

**DEALING DIMES:** Damarius Smith's 10 assists against YSU were the most by a Gov since Caleb Brown had 10 against Chattanooga, Jan. 3, 2011.

**HORTON EARNS HONOR:** Sophomore center Chris Horton was named to Central Michigan all-tourney team. In three games, he averaged 15.3 points and 8.7 rebounds. He shot 68 percent from the floor and 73 percent from the free throw line. He also had eight blocks.

**CAREER NIGHT:** Horton capped his strong week by stepping to the forefront against Montana State, scoring a career-high 23 points.

**BOUNCE BACK EFFORT:** Redshirt sopho-

more guard Zavion Williams, bouncing back from a costly late-game turnover in the Govs' loss to Cal State Northridge, scored an APSU career-best 21 points off the bench. His college career high is 28 points against SIU Edwardsville when playing for Lipscomb in 2011-12.

**MAKING A POINT:** A night after scoring 11 points and dishing out four assists against Cal State Northridge in his first point-guard start, Damarius Smith was even better against Montana State. He finished with 16 points, nine rebounds and a team-best six assists.

**RECORD BREAKER:** With Chris Horton blocking seven shots and fellow sophomore Preston Herring batting away three more, the Govs finished the contest with 13 blocks against SIU. It not only was the Dunn Center record for blocks but also the program mark. The previous mark was 11, originally set in 2003 against UT Martin and tied in 2010 against Brescia.

**GOVS ADD HIGH SCORING PREP GUARD:** Guard Josh Robinson, who was the second-leading 2012-13 scorer in the St. Louis Metro area, signed a national letter of intent to play basketball at APSU. The 6-3, 180-pound Robinson averaged 25.4 ppg as a junior for St. Mary's High School, shooting 49 percent from the floor (234 of 477) and 33 percent (49 of 150) from three-point range. He also got to the free throw line 185 times (average of 7.1 per game), connecting on 78 percent of those free tosses. In fact, he went from being a 64.5 percent free-throw shooter as a sophomore to nearly 80 percent a year later.

# Dave Loos

## Head Coach

24th APSU Season, Memphis

Dave Loos is in his 24th APSU season, the longest coaching tenure in APSU basketball history. The dean of Ohio Valley Conference coaches owns a 380-345 Gavs record and 462-398 overall mark in his 27th season. His 454 wins entering the season ranked 28th among all active Division I coaches. It also includes Loos' 82-53 mark at Christian Brothers (Memphis).

Loos' 320th APSU win, Dec. 9, 2009, moved him past former Murray State and UT Martin coach Cal Luther (319 wins) as the OVC's all-time wins leader. In 2008-09, he moved past legendary Western Kentucky coach E.A. Diddle into second place.

Loos also owns 238 OVC victories during his impressive tenure and is 81 games (238-157) above .500 during his 23 seasons, even after an inauspicious 16-26 mark in the first three seasons.

Under Loos, the Gavs have had 13 winning seasons in the last 18 years, including the 2007-08 team's 24-11 mark.

His 2006-07 OVC Coach of the Year honor was his fifth such honor. He is the only coach in APSU history to earn more than one OVC "Coach of the Year" honor and is the only coach in OVC history to win five such honors. He also was named the 2002-03 Tennessee Sports Writers Association "Coach of the Year."

When the Governors played at Tennessee State, Jan. 30, 2012, it was Loos' 800th game as a college head coach.

He has coached such notables as Charles "Bubba" Wells, APSU's all-time scoring leader and former NBA player who now is a Governors assistant, and Trenton Hassell, who played nine NBA seasons. Loos, in fact, has coached Austin Peay's top three career scoring leaders—Wells, guard Nick Stapleton and forward Drake Reed, the three-time first-team All-OVC player who now is playing in Libya.

Loos stepped down as APSU athletics director last April after serving 16 seasons in the position.

## LOOS-LEAF NOTEBOOK

**MEMBER OF FOUR HALLS OF FAME:** APSU head coach Dave Loos was inducted into the Austin Peay Athletics Hall of Fame, Feb. 16, 2008. It was the fourth athletics-related Hall of Fame to honor him. In Spring 1997, Loos was inducted into the St. Louis Amateur Baseball Hall of Fame; Loos was a former prep and amateur baseball star in Missouri during the 1960s and later coached American Legion baseball in the city. A former two-sport star (baseball and basketball) in college, he was inducted into the Memphis (M-Club) Athletic Hall of Fame in Fall 2002. In June 2007, Loos was inducted into the Missouri Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame.

**RECORD SURPASSED:** APSU head coach Dave Loos, who surpassed the career Austin Peay wins mark in 2007, now owns the record for wins coaching in the OVC. Loos now has 371 wins. In 2008-09, Loos became only the second coach in league history to accumulate 300 wins as an OVC coach. He entered 2009-10 with 314 wins, needing six victories to surpass Cal Luther, who recorded 319 wins while coaching at both Murray State (1958-74) and UT Martin (1992-99). Loos surpassed the mark, Dec. 9, at Ohio. Loos also owns the record for wins while at a single league school.

**LOOS TENURE ENDS AS NCAA COMMITTEE MEMBER:** In December, 2008, Dave Loos was appointed to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Issues Committee. His appointment ended Sept. 1, 2012. The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Issues Committee is charged with oversight of all issues pertaining to NCAA Division I men's basketball. The committee works closely with the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) on legislation and other issues, as well as the National Basketball Association and USA Basketball. The committee's primary duties are to ensure the appropriate oversight of the sport, with an emphasis on recruiting activities and to enhance the development and public perception of the sport. The committee also makes policy recommendations per topics unrelated to legislative and playing rules issues.



Dave Loos became the program's all-time winningest coach in Winter 2007, surpassing the legendary Dave Aaron (258 wins, 1946-62). As a result of his accomplishment, outgoing president, Dr. Sherry Hoppe, at the behest of several boosters, had the playing floor named Dave Loos Court.

**LOOS STEPS DOWN AS APSU ATHLETICS DIRECTOR:** For the first time since 1997, Dave Loos will have just one title beside his name... basketball coach. In April, Loos stepped down as APSU's athletics director after serving 16

years as the department's athletics director. Since 2006, he was the only Division I basketball coach who also served in the department's top athletics administrator's position. He was at the forefront of APSU return to scholarship football just five years ago after spending more than a decade in non-scholarship status. Yet, perhaps one of his greatest sources of pride as Athletics Director came in both 2002-03 and 2008-09 when APSU's Athletic Department was awarded the OVC Academic Achievement Banner as the league's top academic program. The Governors/Lady Gobs captured 33 OVC championships with Loos as the program's athletics director.

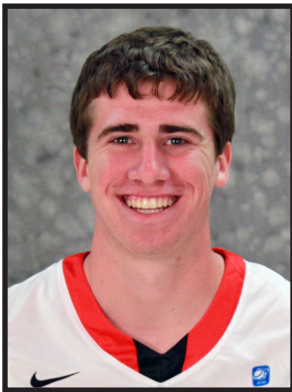
