HERTS CHARITY CUP - 1ST ROUND

Playing their first competitive match of the season and looking to regain possession of the Charity Cup the Blues won this tie convincingly after a slow start with Kyle Vassell notching a hat-trick.

In a scrappy start Stortford created a few openings but it wasn 't until late in the first half that they began to dominate. Cliff Akurang was narrowly wide of the far post with a side-foot volley from a Johnny Herd cross from the left and then in the 39th minute KYLE VASSELL scored the first goal after robbing a defender and running through to beat keeper Dominic Russo (1 -0). The striker added a second shortly before the break when he again ran down the middle and this time chipped the visiting stopper (2-0).

The Blues were in control of the play for most of the second half and Matt Johnson was unlucky with a header that struck the inside of an upright. It came as a surprise when the visitors reduced the deficit in the 66th minute following substitute Spencer Knight 's free-kick to the far post. The ball came back across the box and LIAM FOSTER powerfully headed over keeper Sam Cowler and under the bar from 10 yards (2-1). The two goal margin, however, was restored two minutes later as good work and a fine pass from Steve Cawley set KYLE VASSELL through on goal to net his third goal (3-1).

Substitute KYLE ASANTE came on for Vassell in the 74th minute and within two minutes his name was on the score-sheet when he converted a cross from the left with a shot into the bottom corner of the net (4-1). The next goal came in the 78th minute with Sam Collins' fine cross-field ball found Asante on the right and the substitute's centre into the middle was headed into the net by ASHLEY MILLER (5-1).

The final goal of the night arrived with five minutes left when Johnny Herd 's free-kick from the left was forced home by CALLUM McNAUGHTON (6-1).
