Thank you for visiting the IECEE (Worldwide System for Conformity Testing and Certification of Electrical Equipment) Website. The IECEE is committed to protecting the privacy of its members, customers and other contacts. Any information you choose to provide on this Website will only be used to provide or improve the services we offer.

Revisions

The IECEE reserves the right to change or modify this Privacy Policy at any time. If we revise our policy, we will post the changes on the site to ensure transparency in informing you about what information we collect, how we use it and under which circumstances, if any, we disclose it.

Acceptance

The IECEE does not collect personally identifying data from this Website except when specifically and knowingly provided by you. By browsing this Website and communicating electronically with us and/or submitting your personal data to this Website, you acknowledge and agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy and to the processing of personal data by the IECEE as described below.

One of the purposes of the IECEE collecting personal information is to provide you with the best possible service.

Personal Information

We may collect information about you when you use this Website, or when you apply for or use other services offered by the IECEE, in the following ways:

- As you browse through the IECEE Website, we may automatically gather and store information about your visit via cookies. We may use session-specific cookies to collect data automatically about Website use when you visit this site, including e.g. your IP address, domain name, Internet service provider, protocol, browser type and operating system. This information is notably required when you use the IEC's <u>Webstore</u> to purchase IEC publications.
- When you use the IEC's <u>Webstore</u> to purchase IEC publications, or subscribe to the IEC online magazines (<u>iec e-tech</u> or <u>Just Published</u>), or subscribe to <u>MyIEC</u>, or request specific information or products, we will use the personal data that you provide only for such purposes as are described at the point of collection and at the time of data input, such as to send you information or ordered products, to update your membership record or to respond to your questions and comments.
- The IECEE will use such personally identifying data as (without restriction) full name, address, e-mail, phone and fax numbers only for business purposes within the IEC, which includes communication of the data to the <u>IECEE</u>

<u>members</u>. If you are a person who has been nominated to participate in IECEE work, your <u>IECEE Member Body</u> has access to your record and can modify it in accordance with your legal rights. This data may also be made available to the officers of the committee, working groups or CTL to permit them to contact you.

 Membership lists of <u>Member Bodies</u>, <u>NCBs and CBTLs</u> are available publicly on the IECEE Website. These lists include the name and country of each participant.

Surveys

From time to time, we may ask our site visitors to answer survey questions. Surveys generally deal with the site, our products or categories of products. They will not request any personal data.

Referrals

Some areas of the IECEE Website may provide you with the opportunity to e-mail a Web page to another person.
