

What is a Saveaway?

Saveaways are cheap, one-day tickets that you can use for travel on buses, trains and ferries in Merseyside after 9.30am Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays. Saveaways can be great moneysavers compared with ordinary tickets.

There are Saveaway Tickets for adults and young people covering:

- Liverpool
- St Helens
- Wirral
- Southport/Formby
- All-Areas (Whole of Merseyside and as far as Chester, Ellesmere Port and Ormskirk by rail only).

Buying your Saveaway?

You can buy your Saveaways from:

 All staffed rail stations in Merseyside and as far as Ellesmere Port, Chester and Ormskirk.

These Saveaways look like regular rail tickets but can be used on buses in the chosen area as well. You can show them to station or ferries staff at the barriers or bus drivers as you board the bus.

 Merseytravel Centres, at some libraries and over 400 corner shops across Merseyside (there is a full list of addresses on our website or ring Traveline to find your nearest agent).

These tickets are 'scratch off' tickets so you can buy them in advance and have them ready for when you want to use them.





Traveling by Saveaway

Once you have your Saveaway, you can use it as often as you like after 9.30am Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays, throughout the area shown. The ticket is valid on:

- Merseyrail trains in Merseyside and as far as Chester, Ellesmere Port and Ormskirk. (you must have an "all areas" ticket to travel to and from stations outside the Merseyside boundary)
- The Mersey Ferries (All Area Saveaway Tickets only). When travelling by ferry, show your ticket at the ticket office and receive a free boarding pass. See terms and conditions.
- All bus services.* When you board a bus, just show the driver your ticket.

Note: Children travelling on a Young Person's All Areas Saveaway Ticket must be accompanied by an adult on crossriver buses and Mersey Ferries.

Remember, Saveaway Tickets are 'Not Transferable', which means they can only be used by one person.

*Except Night Bus Network.

How to date your scratchcard Saveaway

Your scratchcard Saveaway Ticket isn't valid until you have dated it for the day on which you are travelling.

Here's how to do it.



Lift the protective cover and use the edge of a coin to scratch off the date when you are travelling.



Peel the white backing-paper from the protective cover.



Carefully smooth down the clear plastic cover over the ticket.

These are the times when you can travel on Saveaways.

Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays – any time! Mondays to Fridays any time EXCEPT for journeys starting between 6.31am and 9.29am.

What better way to get out and about on Merseyside.

Conditions of use

Can be used off-peak only at the following times:- Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays – anytime. Mondays to Fridays – anytime EXCEPT journeys scheduled to start between 6:31am and 9:29am.

- Each time you board a bus or pass through a rail or ferry terminal barrier counts as a separate journey.
- Saveaways can be used on:
 - most local bus and rail services in Merseyside and beyond the Merseyside boundary, by rail only, to Chester, Ellesmere Port and Ormskirk (you must have an All Zones ticket to travel to stations outside Merseyside).
 - the Mersey Ferries.
- Saveaways cannot be used on:
 - River Cruises
 - Coach excursions
 - Special bus services (eg night buses) and excursions
 - Merseylink
- Tickets may only be used on the date and within the area shown on the ticket
- Tickets are not transferable. You may not pass your ticket on to another person once you have started using it.
- Young persons' tickets are only valid for use by persons under 16 years of age Proof of entitlement may be required.
- Tickets cannot be sold on once they have been purchased from Merseytravel or any of its
 officially appointed agents.
- Scratchcard tickets which have been dated incorrectly may be replaced provided the ticket is returned before the date marked to any Merseytravel Centre. (Merseytravel Centres are at Birkenhead, Bootle, Huyton, Liverpool One, Queen Square and St Helens).

Other ticket sales outlets cannot exchange tickets which have been dated incorrectly under any circumstances.

- Misuse may lead to prosecution.
- Refunds not allowed.
