

INTRODUCTION

In the long history of New York City's Borough of The Bronx, many distinguished individuals were elected by its people to represent them on the local, state, and federal levels. This book will acquaint a new generation with these public servants by describing when they were elected, what years they served, and to which political party they belonged.

Of course, several of the early elected officials did serve the people in elected capacities before the borough was created. What is now The Bronx was originally part of Westchester County. In 1874, the area west of the Bronx River was annexed to New York City, and the populace in that district then took part in city elections. In 1895, the remainder of The Bronx was annexed and three years later, in 1898, the Borough of The Bronx was created as part of the City of Greater New York. The office of Borough President, in fact, had its origin in the elected Commissioner of Street Improvements of the Twenty-third and Twenty-fourth Wards (now The Bronx) in 1890. The last commissioner was Louis F. Haffen.

It was not until 1914 that the state legislature made The Bronx the sixty-second and last county of the state, thus permitting its citizens to choose their own District Attorney, Sheriff, and other county officials. Through the years, the adoption of successive city charters changed the function of local officials, the most drastic of which, effective in 1938, abolished some county officials within New York City, lodging their former responsibilities in city-wide offices, or made certain positions appointed rather than elected.

This book, chronicling those elected officials who have served the people of The Bronx since the creation of the borough in 1898, will prove to be a helpful reference. We hope that it will spur others to discover more information about them and the contributions they made to improve and develop The Bronx during their tenures.

1. The "Dates in Office" column only indicates the years the officeholder represented a particular numbered district at any one time. Sometimes they held offices for different terms. In order to ascertain how many years that individual was in office, please consult the index and individual years.
2. The research for this work was primarily derived from *The Green Book Official Directory of the City of New York*, *The New York Red Book*, *The Manual for the Use of the Legislature of the State of New York*, *The New York Times Index*, *Biographical Directory of the United States Congress 1774-2011*, *The New York City Council Minutes Book*, and numerous newspaper and magazine clippings. By its nature, such a work is never complete. Errors and omissions that have been in the directories over the years, for example, will be carried on until that time when an observant reader picks them up and clarifies a point or two.
