Her novels, *A Stranger in my Street* (2012) and *Taking a Chance* (2013), are murder mysteries set in wartime Perth. They were inspired by her mother's stories of life in the city during World War II, and by her father's exploits as a commando fighting in East Timor and New Guinea. As a historian, Deborah brought her research skills to the novels to ensure historical accuracy.
