- The site is comprised of Commons, North and South wings and Pilot Plant, comprised of approximately 800,000 square feet of office and laboratory space under one roof.
- The campus grounds, shared with Pfizer, include a conference center, heliport, fitness center and recreation facilities.
- Dow began operations in early 2013 and is transitioning employees from our Spring House location to Collegeville by the end of 2014.

This site serves as the Northeast Technology Center for Dow – it is one of Dow's largest research and development facilities globally and serves several businesses within Dow.
