The 4-Corners Health Department is currently being housed at 2101 North Lincoln Avenue. This property is owned by York General Health Care Services who is now putting the property up for sale. One of the options being discussed was that the County enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of York to purchase the property. This would allow for permanent housing for 4-Corners which Commissioner Bergen felt was necessary. Former Commissioner Bob Wolfe addressed the Board and stated that at the time the department was being formed each of the four counties wanted it to be located within their county and that he does not want to see it leave York. Leroy Vanicek of York also spoke with the Board and had concerns about the county purchase the property.

Commissioners Bergen and Brown agreed to being placed on a committee to look into this matter and report back to the Board.

Mike Atchity of Windstream came before the Board regarding a rate change which would save the county \$4,626.00 annually. This is available for large business accounts. Also available is a long distance rate of \$.04 a minute. This would be a five (5) year agreement which will lock in the rates for that term. The County could add or subtract lines during that period of time. They also have available an Ethernet access for internet service which the county may be interested in. This is a virtual private network – dedicated band width. Atchity provided copies of the proposed contract. The Board will review them and address it at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.

The County has been awarded funds through the Nebraska Department of Economic Development - Nebraska Affordable Housing Trust Fund Act. These funds will be used in a countywide downpayment assistance program which will include minor rehabilitation.

Under a previous program, the Southeast Nebraska Development District administered the program along with the aid of the York Housing and Development Corporation.

Moved by Bulgrin, seconded by Neujahr that the County Board authorize the Chairman to sign the contract for the Administrative Assistance on the 2009 Nebraska Affordable Housing Trust Fund with SENDD; roll call: yeas, Bulgrin, Neujahr, Bergen, Bredenkamp and Brown; nays, none; motion carried.

Don Workman, Principal Consultant with Maximus Inc. was present to review the process their company uses to recover child support costs for the County under a cost allocation plan. These costs are primarily through the offices of the Clerk of the District Court for Child Support Collection and the County Attorney for Child Support Enforcement. These indirect costs are compiled in a report to the Commissioners. After reviewing the report, a certification must be signed with the information being submitted to the State Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services for partial reimbursement.

Moved by Neujahr, seconded by Bergen to authorize the Chairman to sign the Certification of Cost Allocation Plan and pay the fee of \$2,700.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> half of 2008; roll call: yeas, Neujahr, Bergen, Bulgrin, Bredenkamp and Brown; nays, none; motion carried.

The Board conducted the quarterly visit to the County Jail.

Committee reports were given.

The Chairman declared the meeting adjourned at 11:20 a.m. The next regular meeting will be November 3, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. with Elected Officials/Department Heads; 9:20 a.m. with the General Assistance Administrator and 9:35 a.m. in the County Commissioners Room, lower level of the Courthouse for the regularly scheduled meeting.
