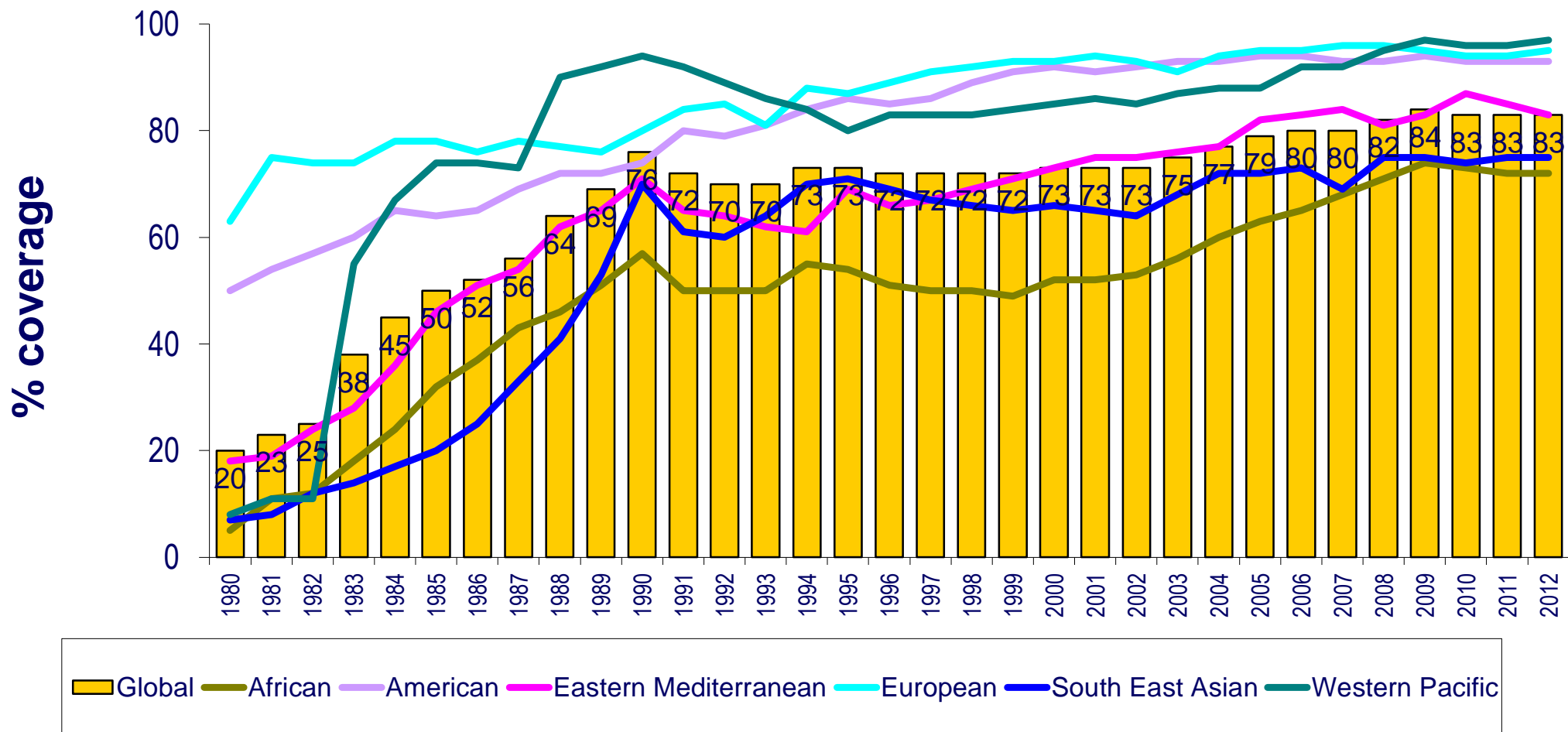

global coverage at 83% in 2012

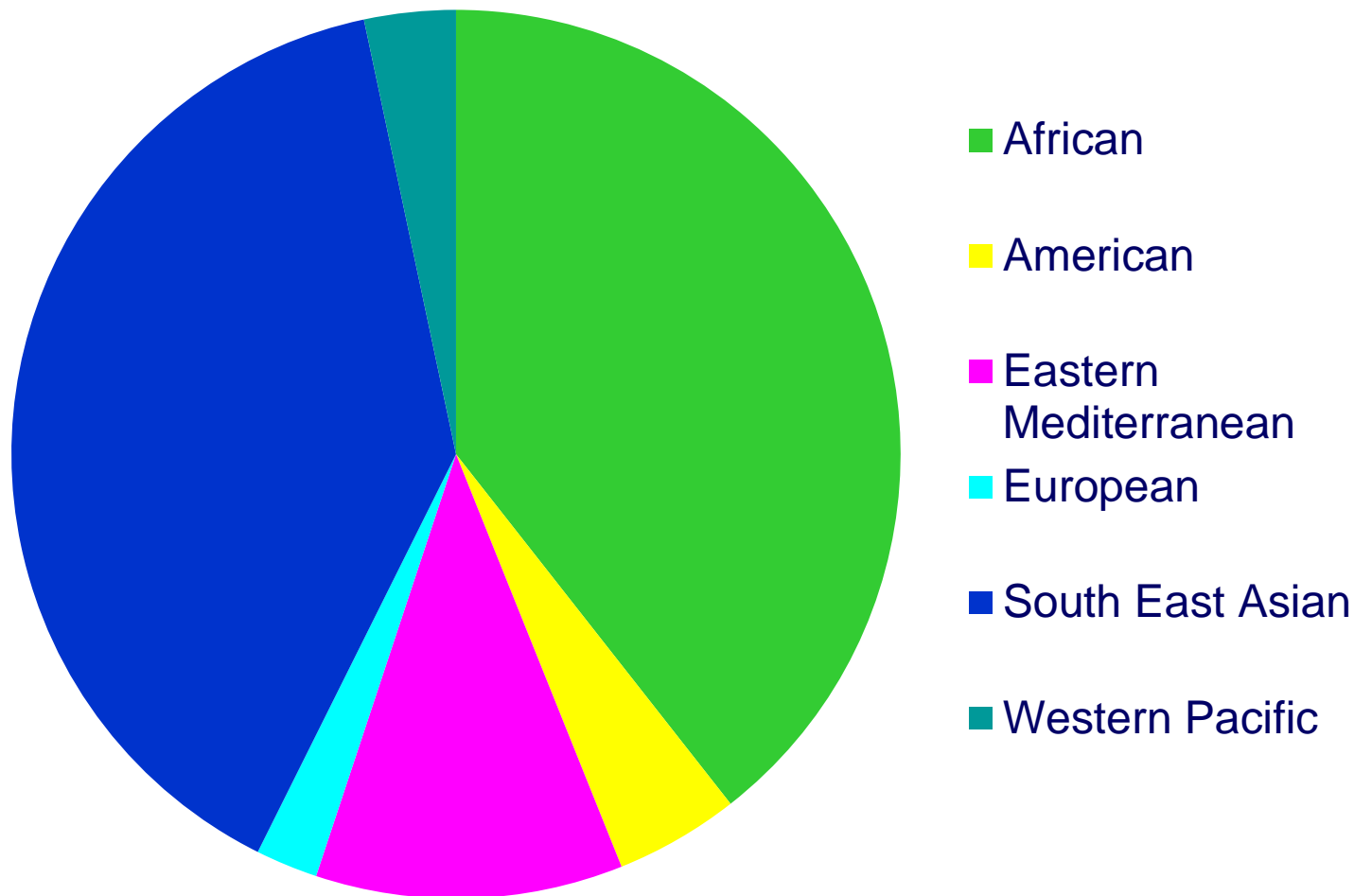

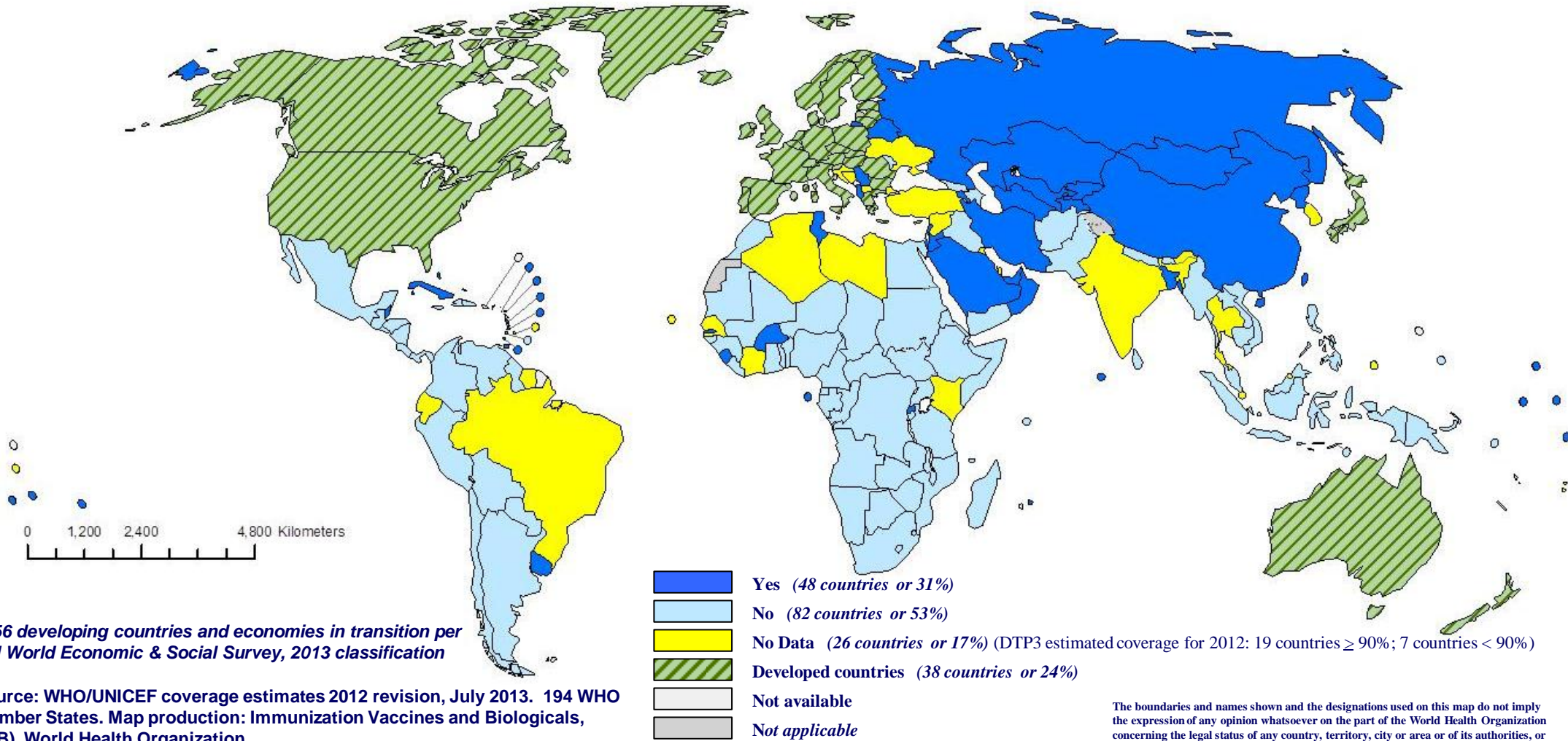

“Developing”* countries with all districts achieving at least 80% DTP3 coverage, 2012

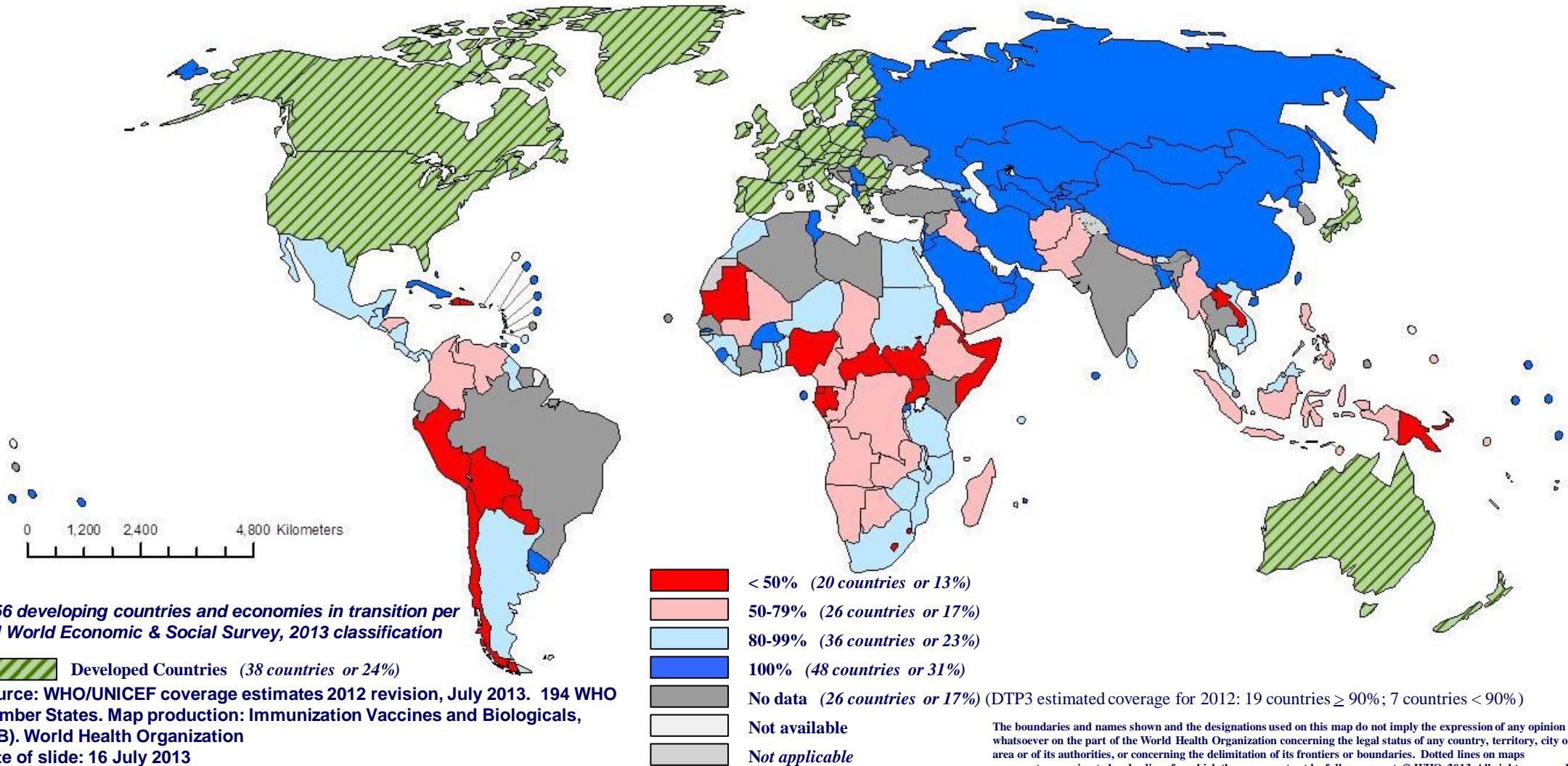

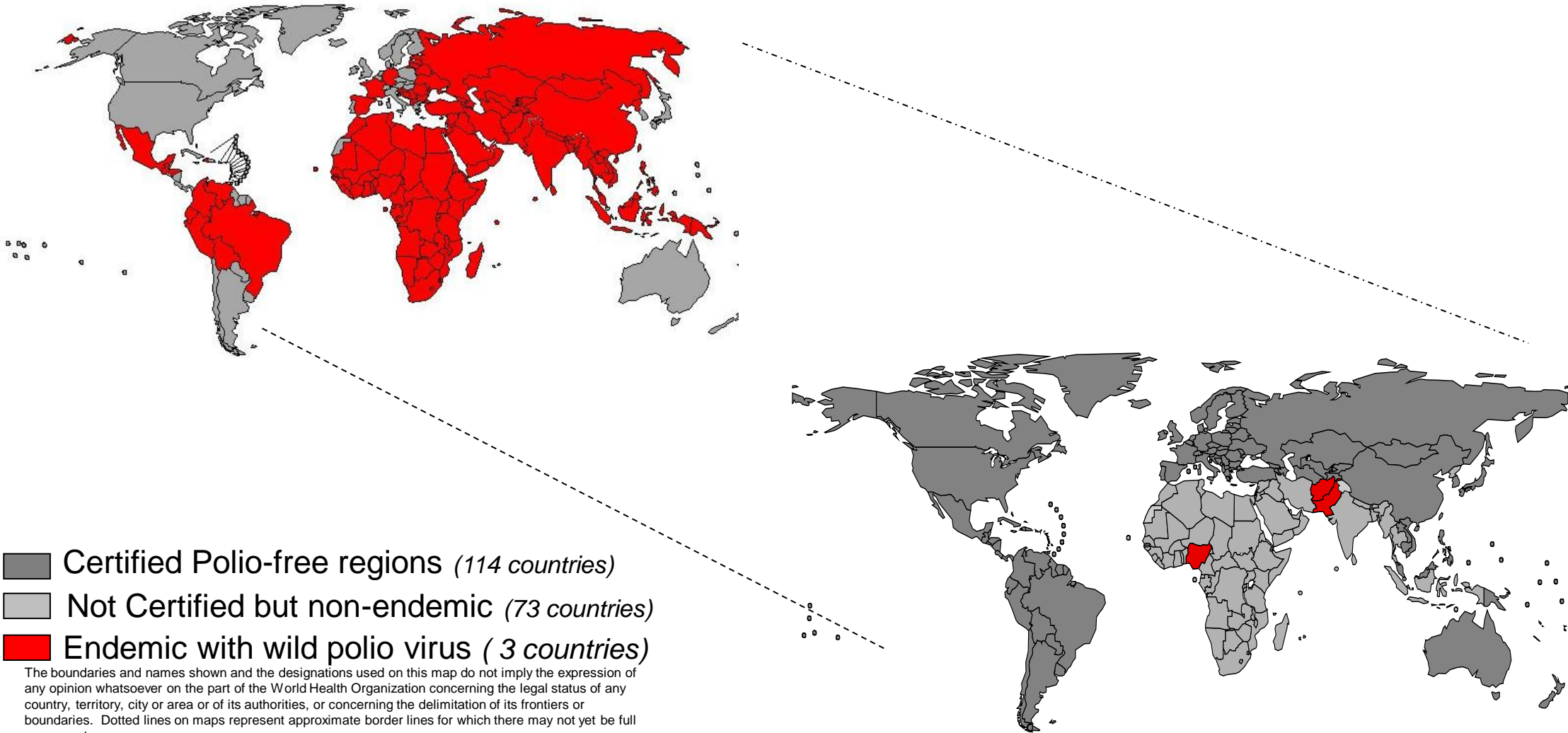
“Developing”* countries with % of districts achieving at least 80% DTP3 coverage, 2012

Polio Eradication Progress, 1988 – 2012



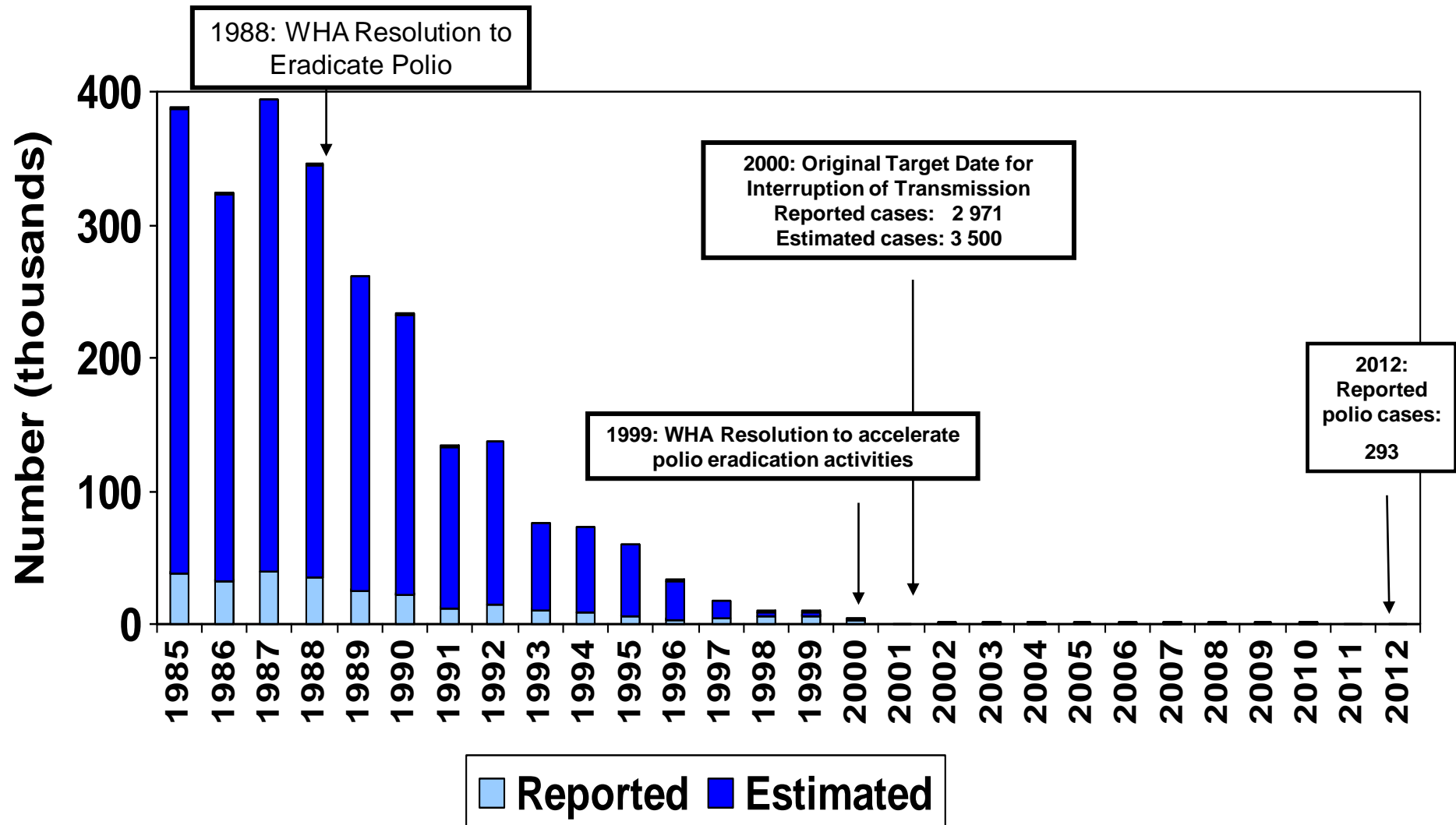

Progress in Polio Eradication, Estimated and Reported Polio Cases, 1985-2012



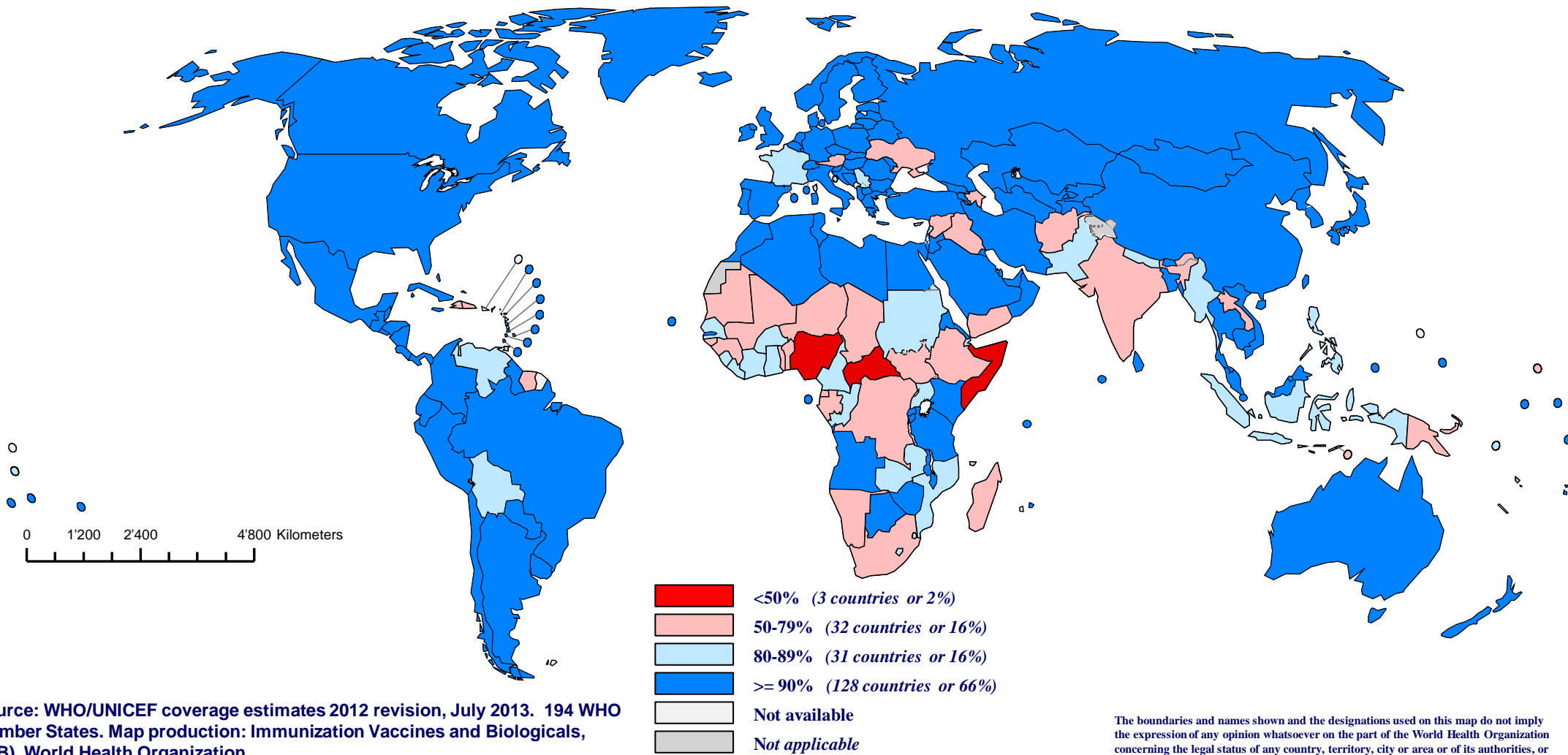

Immunization coverage with measles containing vaccines in infants, 2012

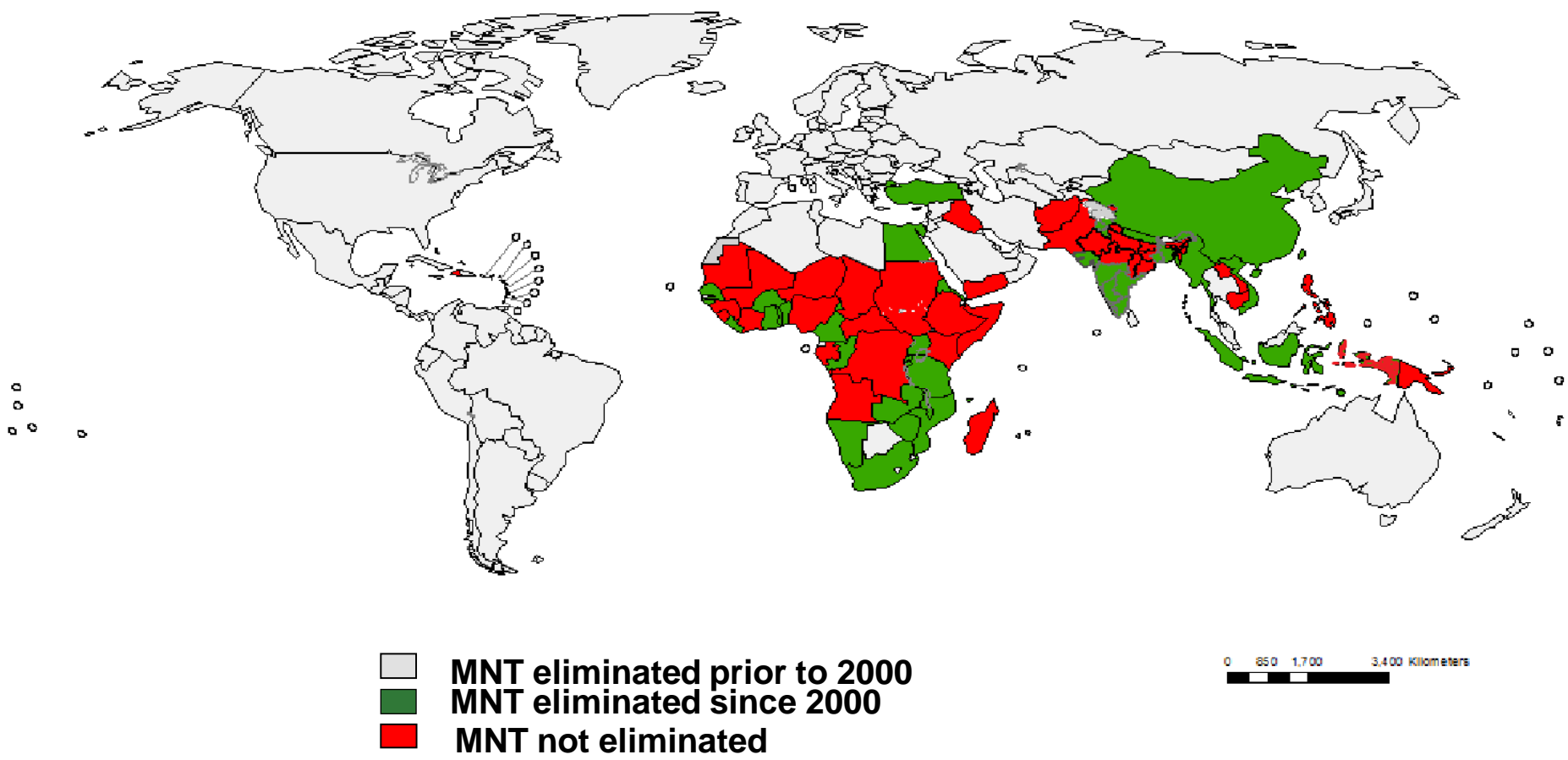

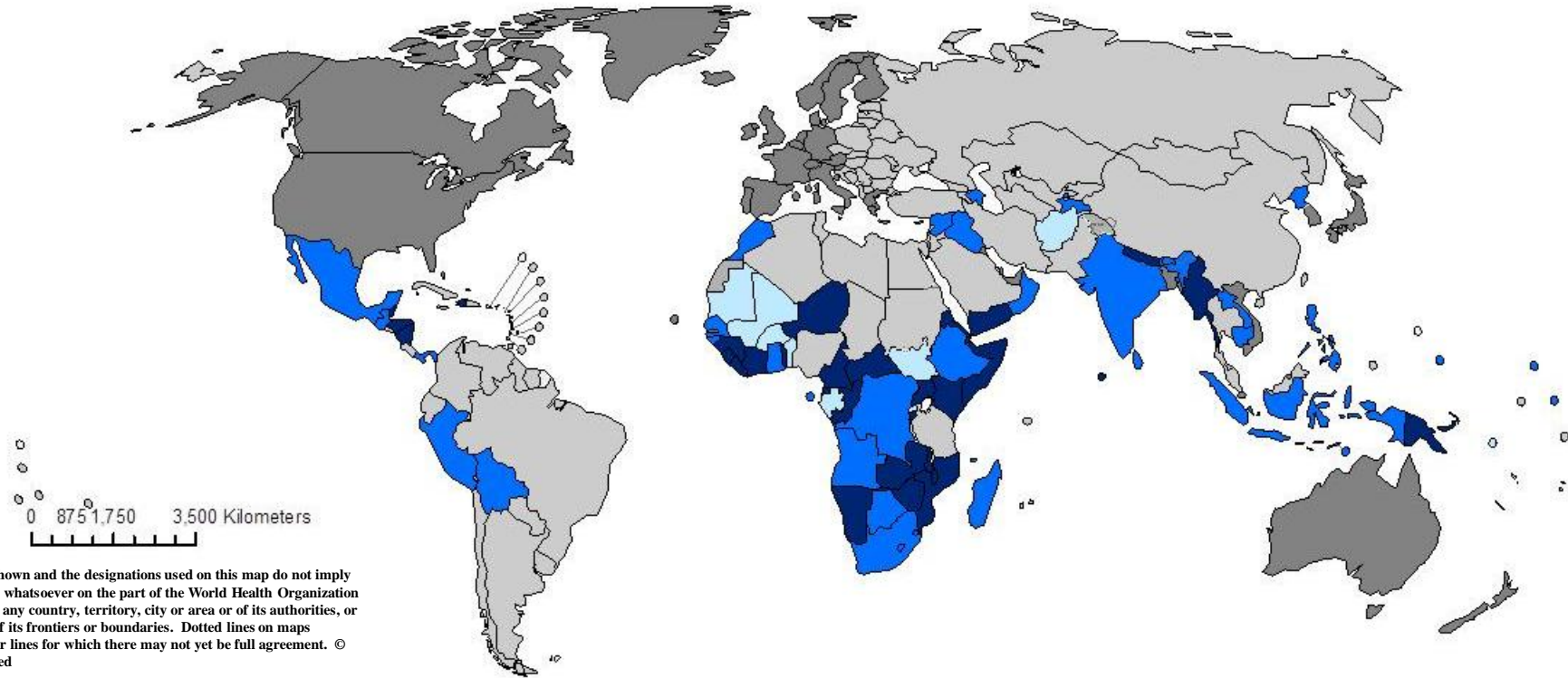

Countries Providing Vitamin A Supplementation, 2012



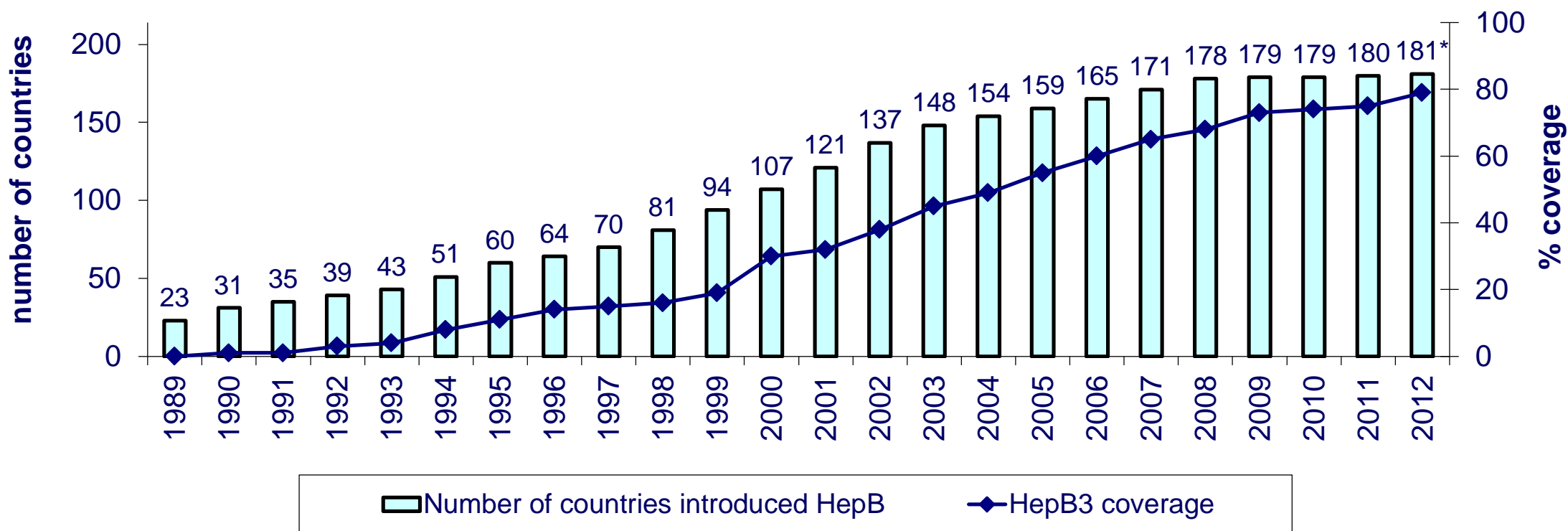
- Vitamin A distributed with routine and supplementary immunization activities (30 countries or 20%)
- Vitamin A distributed only with routine immunization services (36 countries or 24%)
- Vitamin A distributed only with supplementary immunization activities (9 countries or 6%)
- No Vitamin A distribution (78 countries or 51%)
- Not a public health problem (41)

Vitamin A with routine EPI: 66 countries
 Vitamin A with EPI campaigns: 39 countries
 Vitamin A with both (routine & EPI campaigns): 30 countries

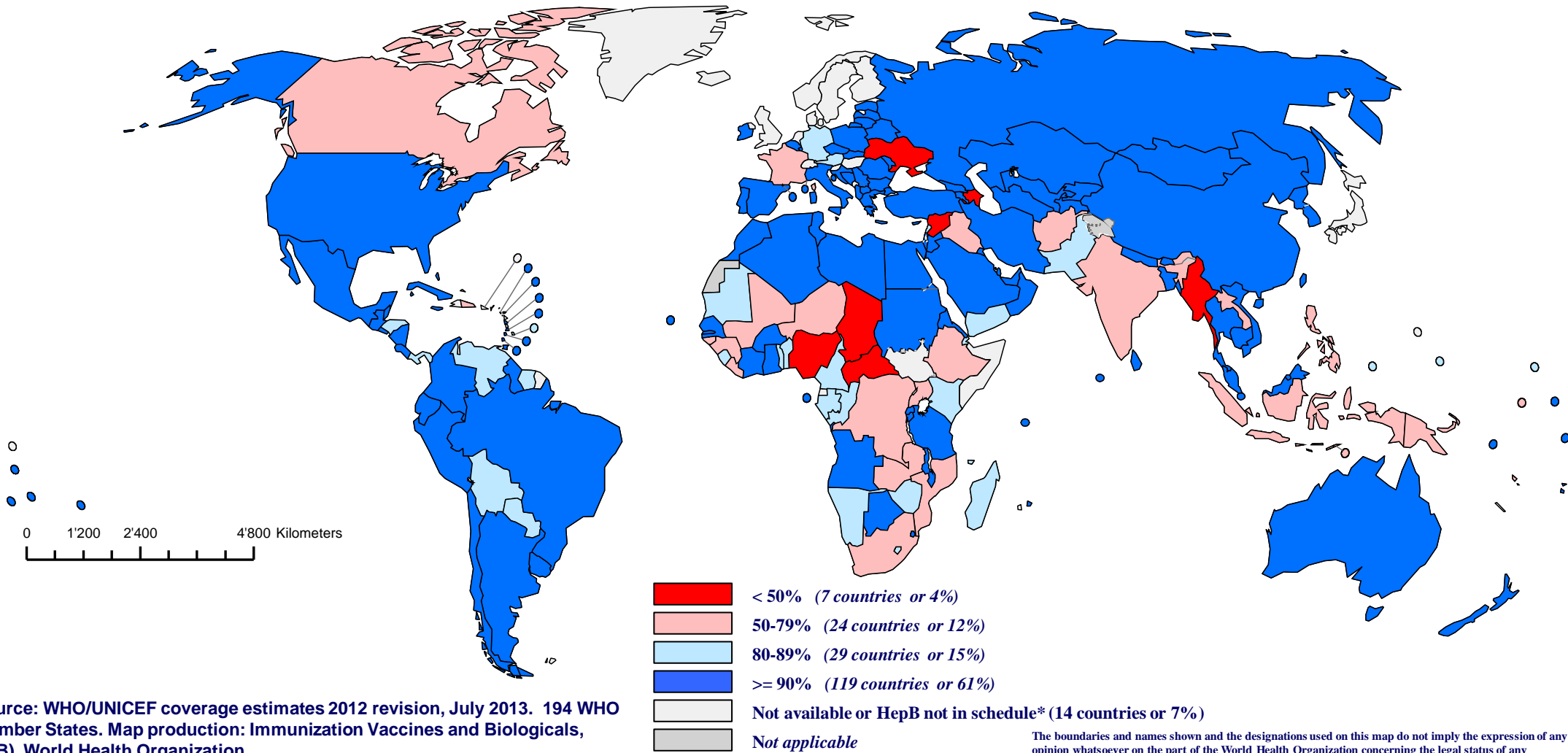
Number of countries having introduced HepB vaccine* and global infant HepB3 coverage, 1989-2012

Immunization coverage with 3rd dose of HepB vaccines in infants, 2012

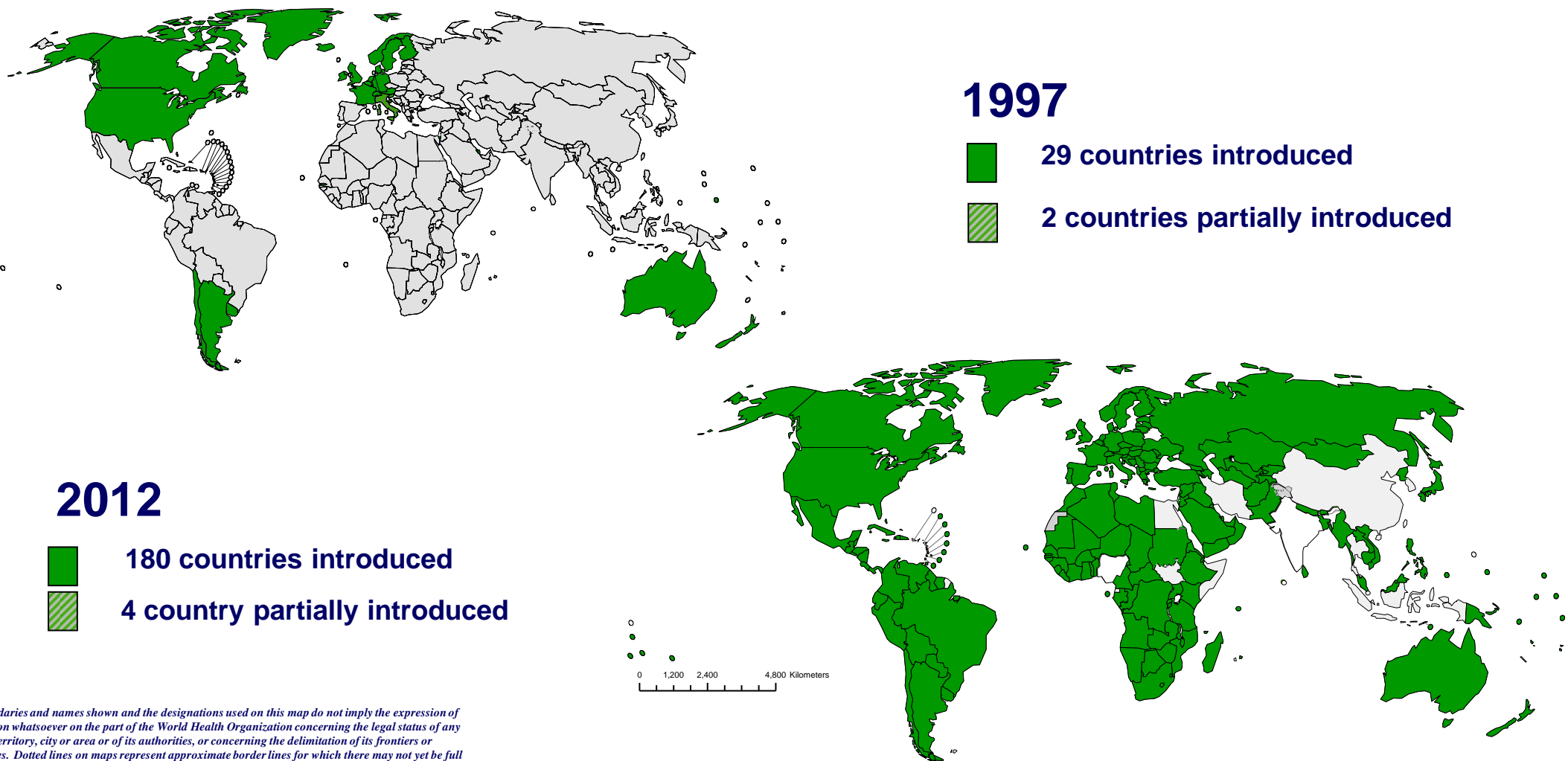

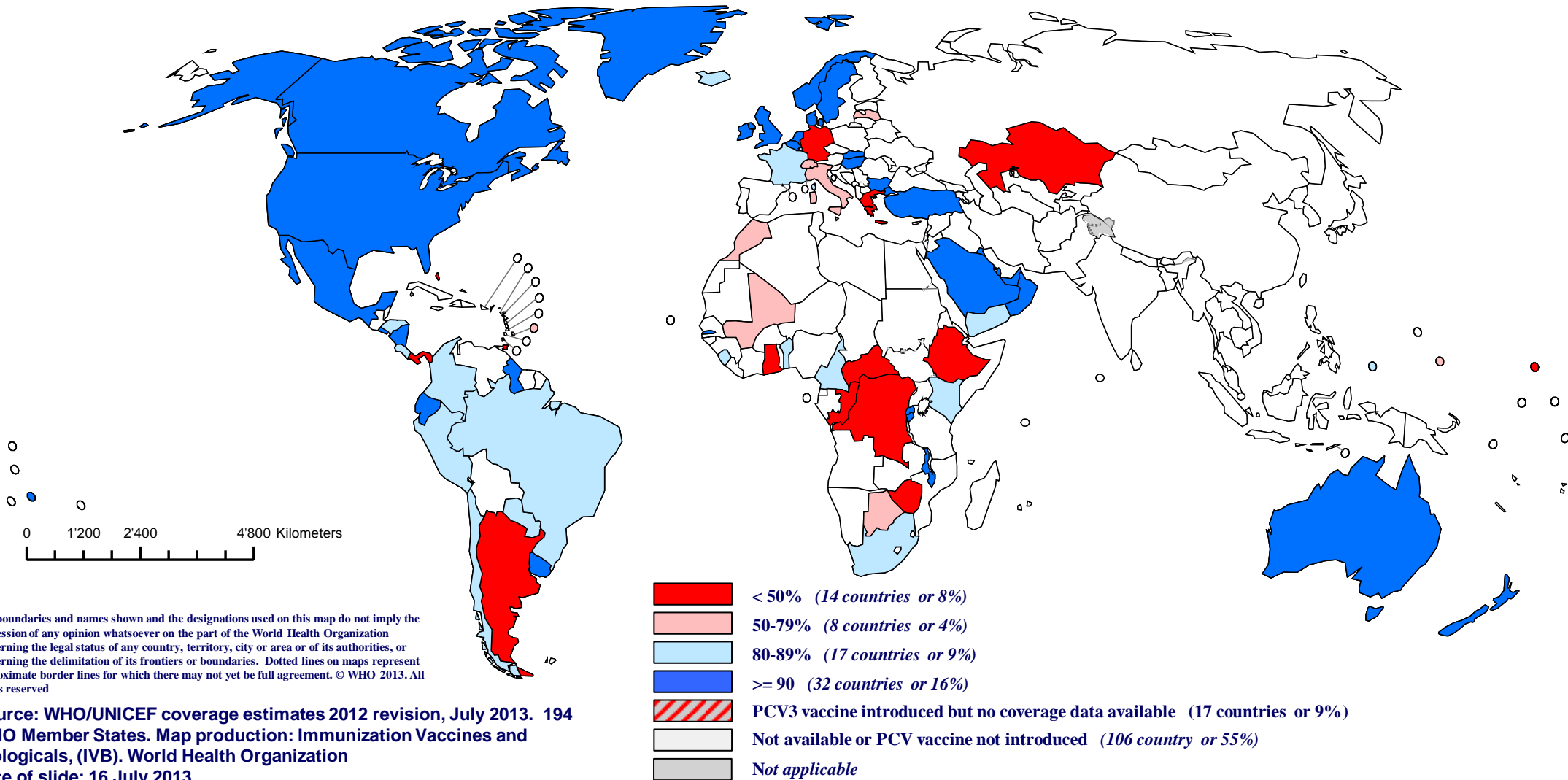

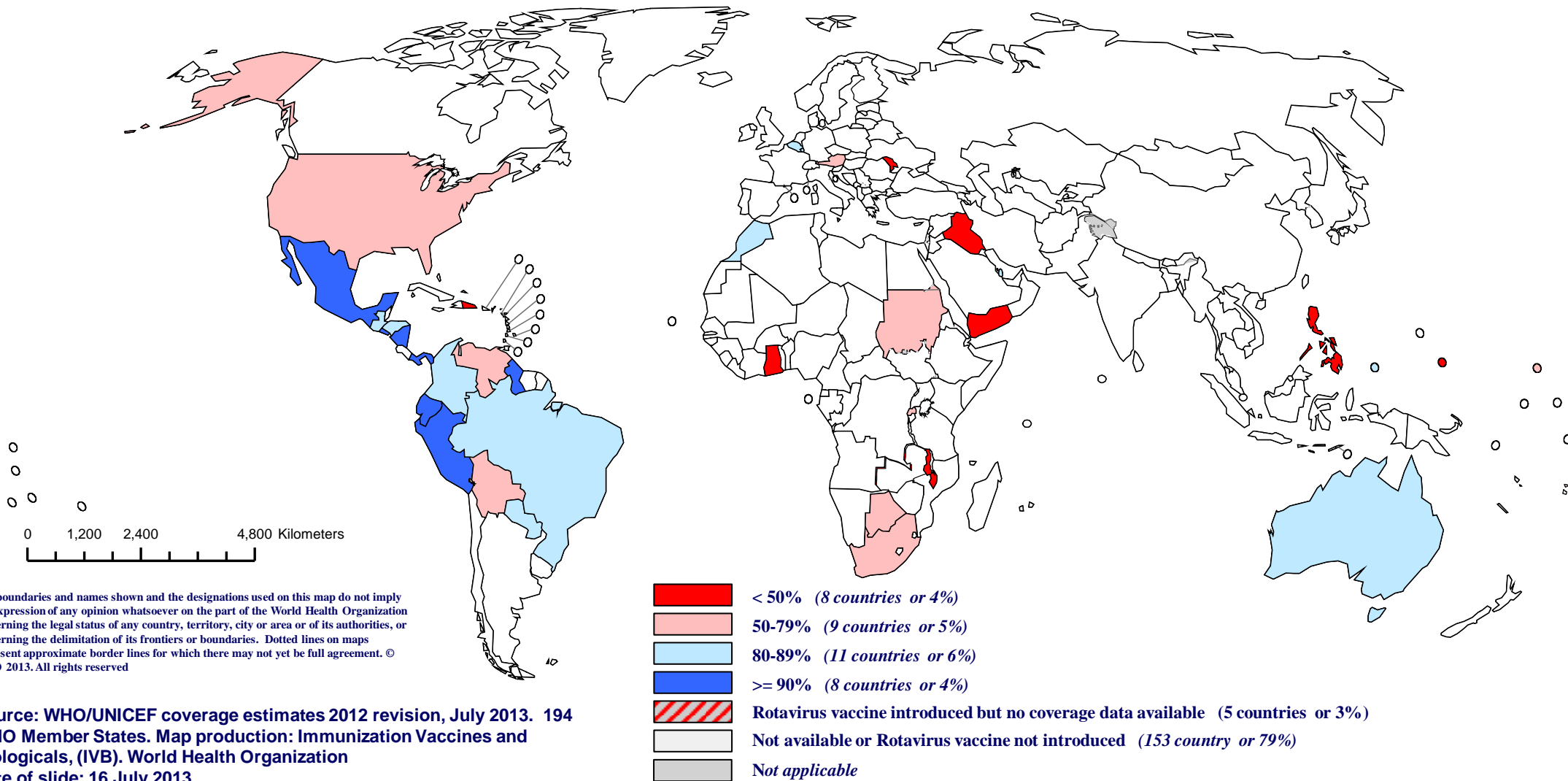

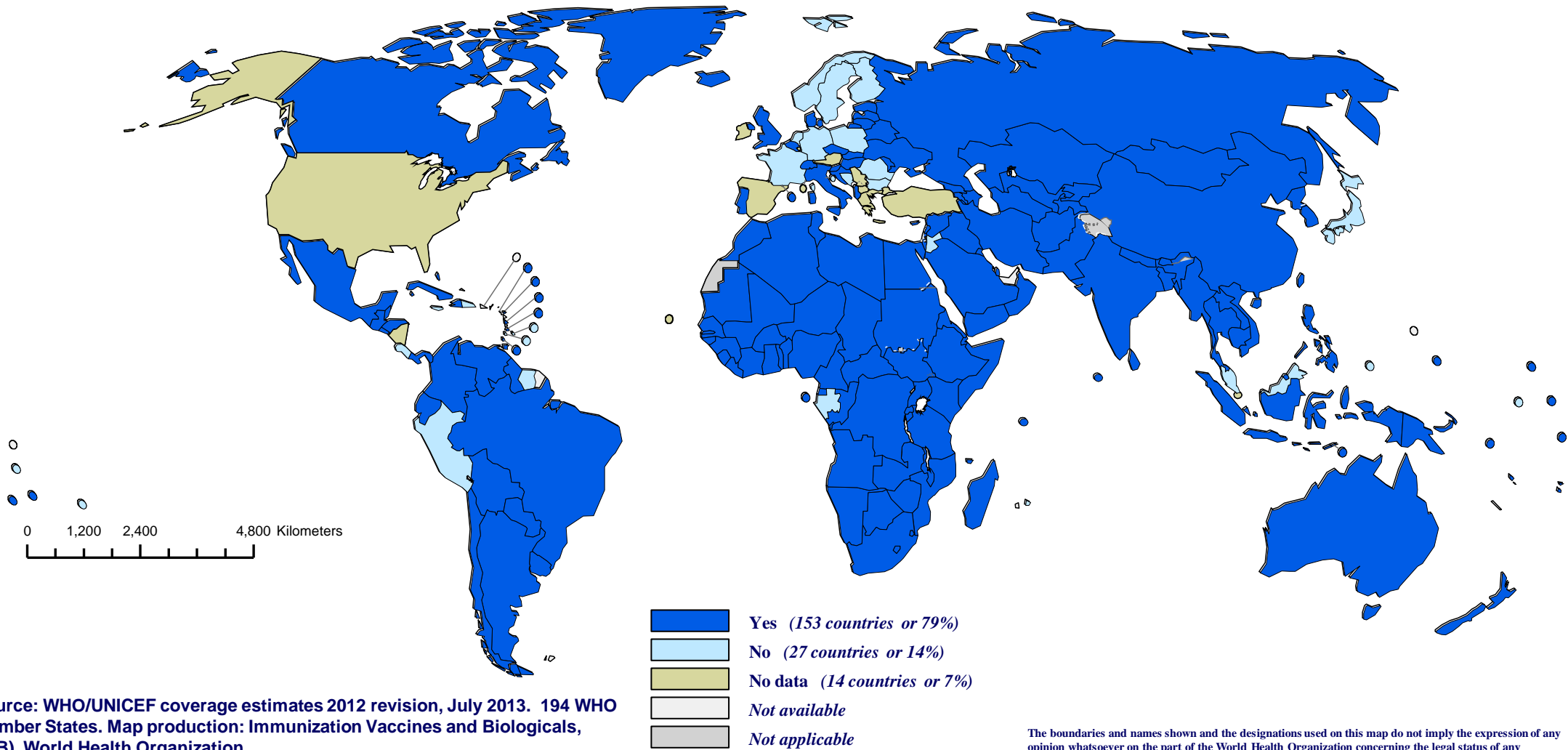
Immunization coverage with PCV3 containing vaccines in infants, 2012



Immunization coverage with Rota containing vaccines in infants, 2012



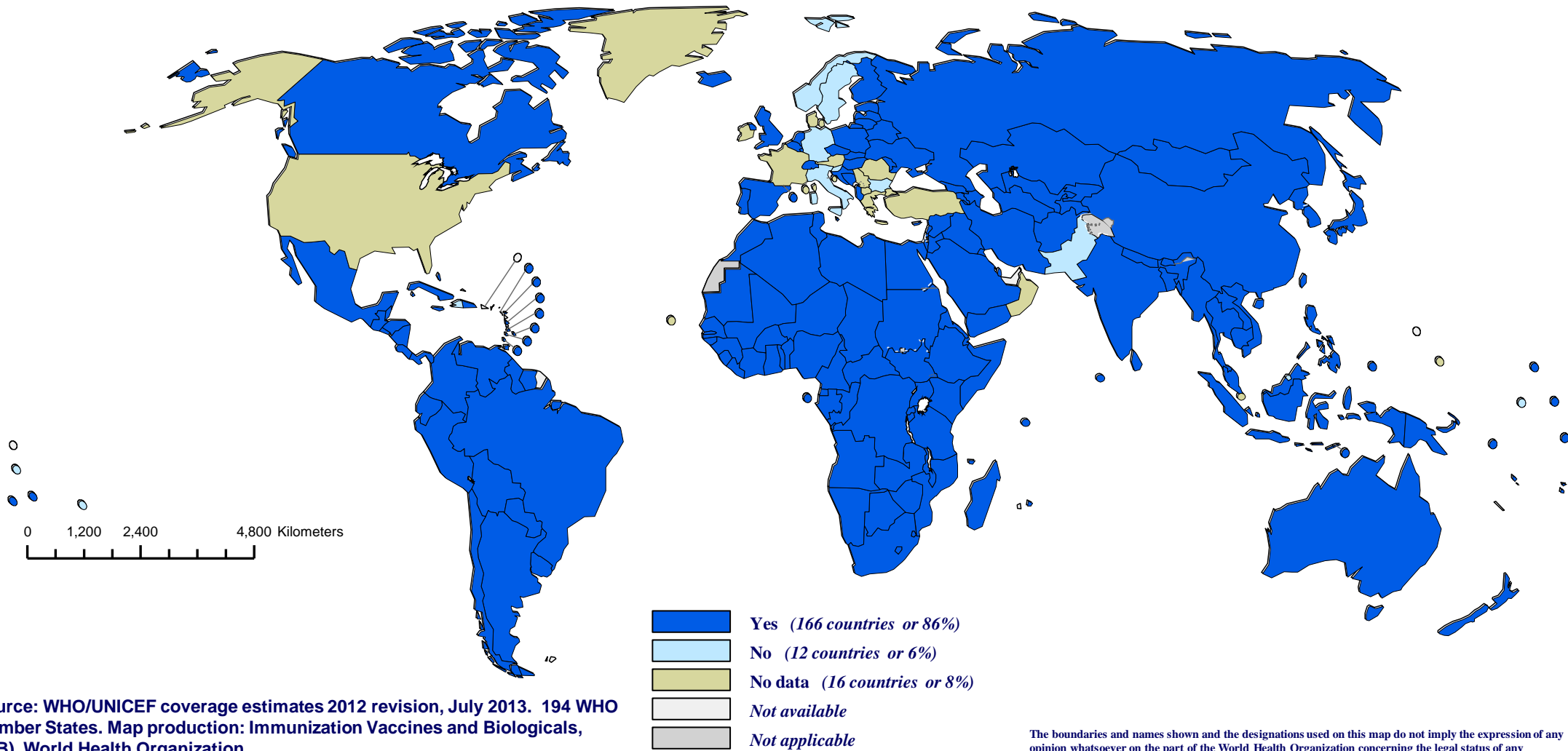
Countries with a 3-5 year strategic plan for the national immunization system, 2012

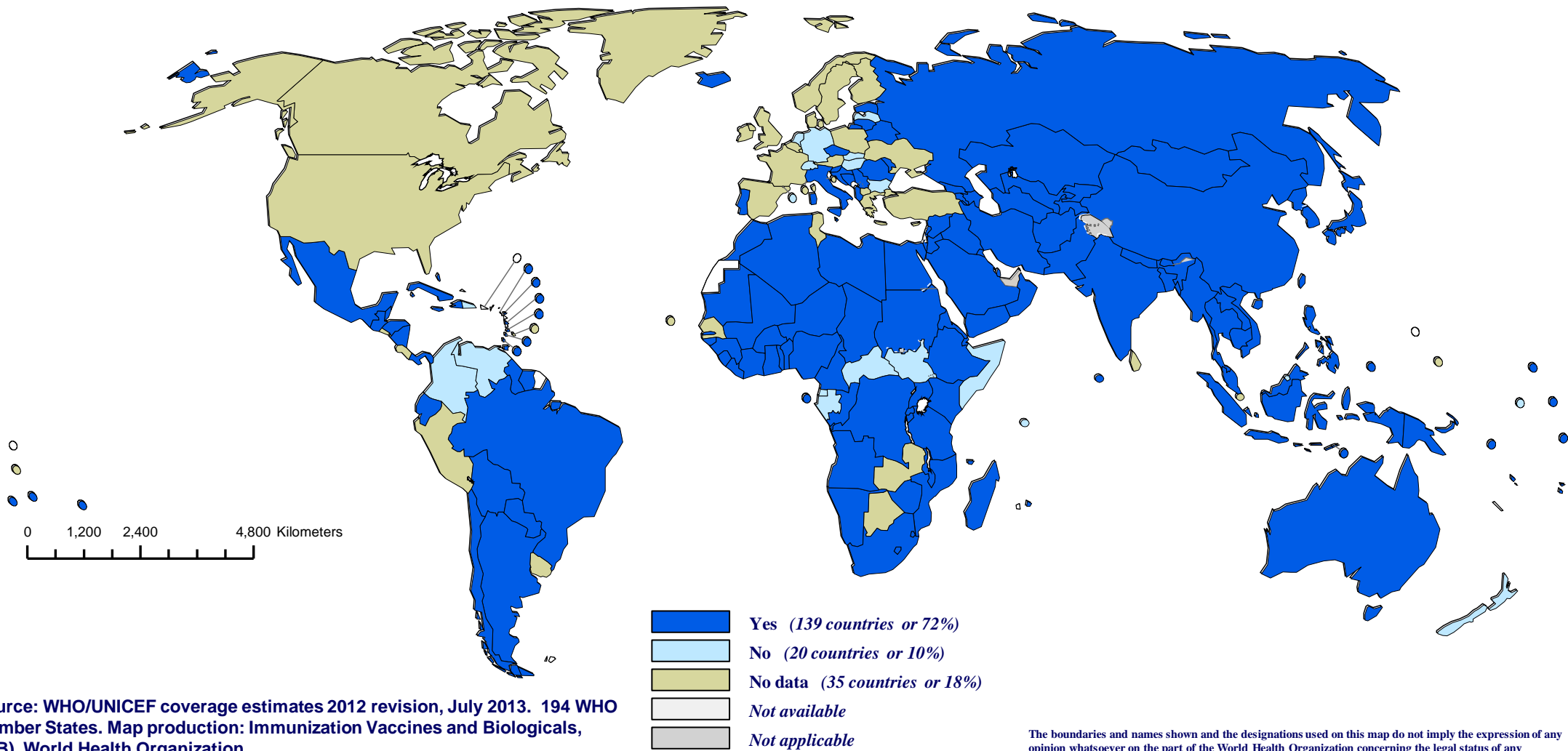
Countries with a national annual work plan for immunization services, 2012
