4. Qualification System

4.1 ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

● To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must be born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 1999.

4.2 QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

- For each qualifying event, the qualification places obtained for the Youth Olympic Games will be allocated to NOCs.
- Each Continental Confederation will enter six teams per gender.
- For the Continental Confederations that will organize a Youth Continental Championships (or a Youth Continental Tour) between 1 April 2013 and 8 June 2014, the six best ranked teams from that continent will qualify their NOC. Should an NOC have more than one team in the top six, the next best ranked team from that continent not yet qualified will grant a qualification place to its NOC.
- Should a Continental Confederation not organize a Youth Continental Championships (or a Youth Continental Tour) between 1 April 2013



and 8 June 2014, then the FIVB will allocate the qualification places to team(s) not yet qualified as defined in the FIVB criteria below (in priority from top to bottom) regardless of the Continental Confederation.

FIVB CRITFRIA:

- a) The best ranked team(s), if not yet qualified, of the 2014 FIVB Beach Volleyball Youth World Championships will qualify their NOCs; or of the 2013 FIVB Beach Volleyball Youth World Championships (should the 2014 FIVB YWCHs not be organised before 8 June 2014). Should an NOC have more than one team in the top six, the next best ranked team not yet qualified will grant a qualification place to its NOC.
- b) The NOCs with the best ranked players featured in the FIVB World Ranking by 8 June 2014;
- c) National Federations hosting 2013 FIVB Senior World Championships and 2014 FIVB World Tour events (in priority Grand Slam and then Open);
- d) National Federations hosting Challenger and/or Satellite events and/or Continental Cups in 2014;
- e) National Federations promoting continental events at grass roots activities.

4.3 HOST COUNTRY REPRESENTATION

China, as the host country, has the right to enter one (1) team per gender.

4.4 UNIVERSALITY PLACES

- To be eligible to receive Universality Places, athletes must comply with the Eligibility Criteria as defined under 4.1 of this document.
- 5 men's teams and 5 women's teams will be allocated Universality Places by the YOG Tripartite Commission in collaboration with FIVB, as long as the technical level of the athletes allows it.

6. Competition Format

The total number of matches will be 228, comprising of 114 men's and 114 women's matches. The Youth Olympic Beach Volleyball competition will consist of a Preliminary Round and a Single Elimination Phase, for both genders.

6.1 Drawing of Lots

Upon definition of the Youth Olympic Ranking, a drawing of lots may be organized by FIVB or/and NYOGOC in accordance with the FIVB regulations, to establish the seeding of the 36 qualified men's and 36 qualified women's teams.

An additional drawing of lots will be organized by FIVB and NYOGOC at the Olympic venue, which is the Nanjing Sports Park Complex Beach Volleyball Venue, after completion of the preliminary phase, in order to determine the seeding of the teams in the Round of 24, in accordance with the FIVB regulations.



6.2 Competition System

6.2.1 Preliminary phase

- Six (6) pools of six (6) teams (in a round robin format) will be formed in the Preliminary Round. Every team will play the five other teams in their pool.
- Allocation of teams in each pool will be in accordance with the FIVB regulations.
- At the completion of each match during pool play, 2 points will be awarded to the winner, 1 point will be awarded to the loser, 0 points will be awarded to the forfeited team. The ranking of teams within their pools will be determined by the total number of match points.
- A total of 90 matches will be played for each of the men's and women's competition in order to determine the pool ranking.
- The first four (4) ranked teams from each pool advance to the round of 24 in the Single Elimination Phase, for both genders.

6.2.2 Ranking in Pools

Ranking in pools will be determined by the total number of points. If a tie should occur during the team ranking process, the following processes will be followed:

During the Preliminary Phase:

- If the teams are tied in the match points, then the ties will be broken by the rally points ratio of all played matches in the pool.
- If a tie still exists then the teams have the same position in the ranking. At the end of the Preliminary Phase:

Between two (2) teams:

The winner of the head to head match is ranked higher.

For more than two (2) teams:

- If the teams are tied in the overall match points, then the ties will be broken by the match points in the matches between the tied teams.
- If the teams are still tied, the ties will be broken by the rally points



ratios in the matches between the tied teams.

- If the teams are still tied, the ties will be broken by the rally points ratios in all matches in the pool.
- If a tie still exists then the teams ranking is determined by the draw.

6.2.3 Single Elimination Phase–Round of 24

Seeding of the teams after the Preliminary Round will be in accordance with the FIVB regulations and will be established in the 2nd Drawing of lots after the completion of the Preliminary Phase.

The Round of 24 will be played in a single elimination format, to qualify sixteen (16) winning teams for the Round of 16.

6.2.4 Single Elimination Phase-Round of 16

● The Round of 16 will be played in a single elimination format, to qualify eight (8) winning teams for the quarterfinals.

6.2.5 Single Elimination Phase–Quarterfinals

The four (4) winners of the quarter-finals will then advance to the semi-finals by single elimination format.

6.2.6 Finals

Two (2) losers of the semi-finals will play the bronze medal match to determine the bronze medal and the fourth place.

Two (2) winners of the semi-finals will play the gold medal match to determine the gold and silver medals.

6.3 Meetings

The Preliminary Inquiry will take place at the 13th-14th, August, 2014 (time and location to be announced later).

The General Technical Meeting will take place at the 15th, August, 2014 (time and location to be announced later).

An NOC representative and both players of each team must be



present at the Preliminary Inquiry and the General Technical Meeting. The Preliminary Inquiry and the General Technical Meeting will be carried out in accordance with the FIVB regulations.

7. Competition Rules

The Beach Volleyball competition at the Nanjing 2014 Youth Olympic Games will be held in accordance with the FIVB Beach Volleyball Official Rules, 2013–2014 (and its revision) and the Olympic Charter, in force at the time of the Nanjing 2014 Youth Olympic Games.

In case of disagreement on the interpretation of these regulations, the English Version shall prevail.

8. Equipment & Clothing

Equipment used or clothing worn by athletes and other participants at the Youth Olympic Games Beach Volleyball Competition must comply with the FIVB Regulations and Technical Rules and with the Bye-Law to Rule 50 of the Olympic Charter.

Each NOC is responsible for providing FIVB homologated uniforms to their respective players. Beach Volleyball competitors will be numbered either 1 or 2 and must use the same number throughout the tournament.

The official men and women's uniforms for the Youth Olympic Beach Volleyball competitions will be in accordance with the FIVB Beach Volleyball Official Rules and FIVB Regulations for Youth Olympic Games.

9. Doping Control

The Nanjing 2014 Anti-doping team will plan and implement the YOG Doping Control Programme in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code, IOC Anti-Doping Rules and other related international standards.



The Doping Control Programme will specify the anti-doping activities to be conducted during the Games-time, including notification procedures, sample collection, storage and transport to the laboratory of China Anti-Doping Agency accredited by WADA.

The Programme is aimed at maintaining the dignity of the Olympic Movement and protecting athletes' fundamental right to participate in clean sports, so as to promote the health, justice and equality of athletes in sports events.

The test biological specimens, including urine and blood samples, will be collected from selected athletes from the date of YOV official opening to the date of the Closing Ceremony of Nanjing 2014 (12 August to 28 August 2014). All samples will be sent to the laboratory of China Anti–Doping Agency for analysis.

12.2 TRAINING POLICIES

Training facilities will be provided for all athletes from the opening of the Youth Olympic Village (YOV) (12 August 2014) to the end of Beach Volleyball competition of Nanjing 2014 (27 August 2014).

All training before the games time will be assigned under the supervision of the training court supervisor. All training during the games-time will be assigned under the supervision of the FIVB Control Committee.

The booking service for practice courts is located at Event Information



Centre of YOV and SID of the venue.

Familiarization training in the Center court will be assigned by FIVB and its Control Committee member starting from 4 days prior to the start of the Beach Volleyball competition.

13. Medals

The medals and diplomas for the Beach Volleyball competition will be awarded in accordance with the Olympic Charter.

First Place

First prize will be a silver gilt medal and a diploma.

Second Place

Second prize will be a silver medal and a diploma.

Third Place

Third prize will be a bronze medal and a diploma.

Fourth to Fifth Places

Competitors placing fourth and fifth (4 places) will receive their diplomas.

14. Victory Ceremonies

Victory Ceremonies will be held in accordance with the requirements of the YOG Event Manual of the IOC.

The Victory Ceremonies will be held following the completion of each event final on the Field of Play (FOP). Medallists will be invited onto a podium to receive the medals and the mascots in the sequence of the bronze, silver, and gold medallists. At the Ceremony, the anthem of the NOC of the gold medallist will be played; and meanwhile the flags of the NOC of the medallists will be raised. The Olympic flag and anthem will be used for the mixed NOC team events.
