What Is Muted Group Theory (MGT)

 It is when non-dominant groups are muted to their native language because their life experiences are not well served by their language system-a language system that was devised primarily by well-to-do men to represent their own experiences.



Make up of Muted Groups

- MGT has focused on women as a muted group and men as the dominant group in our culture.
- Other non-dominant groups such as minorities, elderly, homosexuals and lower class groups are also greatly affected by MGT.
- Dominant group- the group that holds the power in a given culture.
- The dominant group in our society is a Euro-American male, heterosexual, able-bodied, youthful, middle and upper class, and Christian.

Origin of MGT

• MGT was orignated with the work of social anthropologists Edwin and Shirley Ardener.





Assumptions of MGT

- Women perceive the world differently than men because of women and men's different experiences and activities rooted in the division of labor.
- Because of their political dominance, men's system of perception is dominant, impeding the free expression of women's alternative models of the world.
- In order to participate in society, women must transform their own models in terms of the received male system of expression.

Gender-Based Differences in Perceptions

 Women perceive the world differently than men because of women and men's different experiences and activities rooted in the division of labor.



Male Dominance

 Because of their political dominance, men's system of perception is dominant, impeding the free expression of women's alternative models of the world.



Women's Translation Processes

 In order to participate in society, women must transform their own models in terms of the received male system of expression.



The Process of Silencing

 Ridicule- Women's speech is trivialized. Men label women's talk as chattering, gossiping, nagging, whining.



 Ritual- Many social rituals have the effect of silencing women or advocating that women are subordinate to men. For ex. Wedding ceremony



 Control- Men control many decisions such as what is placed in mainstream media leaving womens contribution and coverage left out. They also control topic conversations when speaking to women.



 Harassment- Women are affected by street harassment, meaning they do not have free access to public streets because men control public spaces. Also, sexual harassment in the workplace.



Strategies of Resistance

- Naming the strategies of silencing.
- Reclaim, elevate, and celebrate women's discourse.
- Creating new language for uniquely gendered experiences.
