Allocation Statement for Redland Green School - September 2014

As Redland Green School is oversubscribed, the criteria stated in the booklet 'A guide for parents and carers on applying for a secondary school place for the school year 2014-2015' have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

650 on-time applications (264 first preferences, 244 second preferences and 142 third preferences) have been received for Redland Green School which has an admission number of 189.

3 places are required for children with the school named in their Statement of Special Educational Need.

This left 186 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the Initial Allocation of Places was made

The 186 places have been offered to the following children:

- 1. Those children who are defined as 'Children in Care'; or children who were previously in care, but immediately after being in care became subject to an adoption, residence, or special guardianship order. (2 places).
- 2. Those children living within the area of first or joint priority for Redland Green School, with siblings of statutory school age attending the school, who will still be on roll in September 2014. (75 places)
- 3. Children who live within the area of first priority for Redland Green School, who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the home address to the school (109 places).

The furthest distance offered a place in this category was 1.137 km.
