# ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY OF SASKATCHEWAN

## Where great minds meet

The Act establishing the University of Saskatchewan was passed by the Legislative Assembly on April 3, 1907. The U of S celebrated its 100th birthday in 2007. The first classes in Arts & Science began in 1909 with a registration of 70 students. The classes were in the Drinkle Building downtown. On Oct. 12, 1912 the first building on campus, the College Building, opened for student admissions. It was declared a provincial (1982) and federal (2000) heritage building.

## Colleges and schools

The university offers 58 degrees, diplomas and certificates in more than 100 areas and disciplines. Enrolment in 2011-12 was 20,495.

## Faculty and staff

The U of S prides itself on its faculty and staff that number about 7,000. The university, with associated organizations such as Innovation Place and the Royal University Hospital, is the City of Saskatoon's second largest employer, making up about eight per cent of the city's work force.

## Historical highlights

The U of S student newspaper The Sheaf has been in publication since 1912. In the 1940s and 1950s, the U of S pioneered the use of radiation for cancer treatment. Canada's first department of drama was established at the U of S in 1945. Since 1971, the university's Crop Development Centre has bred and released more than 200 new field crop varieties. Canada's first Native Law Centre was established at the University of Saskatchewan.

## WHY HUSKIES? WHY GREEN & WHITE?

The name Huskies was included in an article in the Sept. 20, 1932 Star-Phoenix: "The Varsity Stadium yesterday morning saw the advance guard of over twenty gridiron Huskies swing into action." One of the earliest pictures of players wearing sweaters with 'Huskies' on them was the 1932-33 Greystone yearbook, which showed the men's hockey team in uniforms with the new name.

The colours green and white were chosen in 1910 by Reginald Bateman, a native of Ireland and the first English professor at the University of Saskatchewan. Bateman was at a college meeting which displayed pennants and colour suggestions made

by professor Alexander Greig. "There was a moment's silence, and then professor Bateman stepped forward and touched the green and white," wrote historian Arthur Morton. Said U of S president Walter Murray: "The Irishman has spoken. So be it."

## Vanier Cup in Saskatoon

For the first time since the Vanier Cup started in 1965, the championship was played in Western Canada in 2006. 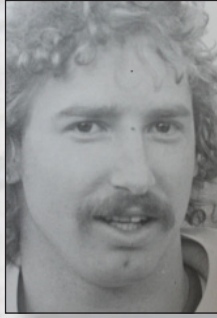
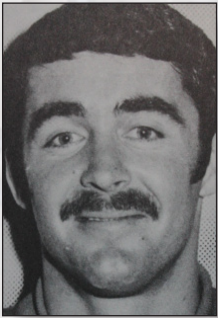

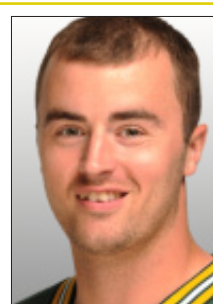

# HUSKIES' HEAD COACHES

## First title

The Huskies won their first Hardy Cup in 1930 as the best football team in the West.

Playing before a crowd of 2,500 at Cairns Field, Saskatchewan defeated UBC 18-3.

Mickey McNab recovered a fumble on a kickoff in the third quarter and scored the only TD. Harry Dempster kicked three field goals and a single.

Saskatchewan coach Kent Phillips had 22 players on the team.

**Harold (Bud) Weaver**, a graduate of Bedford Road Collegiate, enrolled at the U of S in 1935. He played halfback and fullback on the Huskies for four years. Bud went on to play for the Calgary Bronks, a forerunner of the Calgary Stampeders.

Weaver enlisted in the RCAF and was killed in action in September 1941.

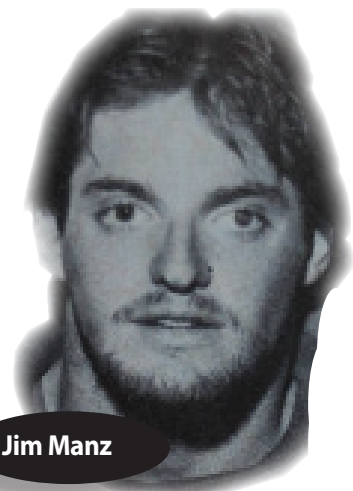

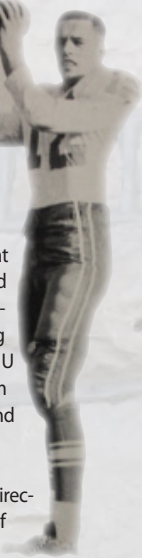
## Catching up with Huskies

**Don Clark**, who was born in Whitewood and went to high school in Kipling, played offensive guard with the Huskies for five years in the 1960s. He was inducted into the Saskatchewan Sports Hall of Fame this year for his impact on wrestling. Clark was a founding member of Sask Sport in 1972.

**Ron Graham** of Moose Jaw was a quarterback for the Huskies in 1959 and '61. He runs Graham Construction and Engineering. The Huskies' clubhouse at Griffiths Stadium and the refurbished clubhouse for the visiting team are gifts to the U of S football program from Ron Graham and his wife Jane.

Huskies athletic director **Basil Hughton** of Moose Jaw was a linebacker with the U of S in 1973 and '74. His teammates included lineman **Brian Towriss** and running back **Mike Harrington**, who are now coaches with the Huskies. Hughton is part of a Huskies football connection at the PAC. Former Huskies QB **Jon Farthing** is an associate professor in the College of Kinesiology, former lineman and current offensive line coach **Bart Arnold** is a lecturer in the college, former receiver **Paul Rogal** is the director of the college's community programs and former safety **Jason Weber** is co-ordinator of the PAC's human performance centre.

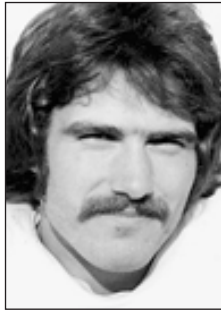
