Procedure for filing a Foreign Judgment with the Civil Actions Branch:

- ➤ A "Request to File Foreign Judgment" form must be completed front and back.
 - Any interest rates, costs or attorney fees must be reflected on the form <u>EXACTLY</u> as they appear on the triple sealed abstract of the judgment. All blanks must be filled in using "0", if applicable.
 - o If the rate of interest on the foreign judgment is not specified numerically you will have to complete or prepare a "Certification of Counsel Regarding Interest Rate" form.
- A copy of all pleadings and attachments must be submitted for all defendants.
- ➤ A \$60.00 filing fee (money order, certified check or D.C. Bar member's check).
- ➤ A TRIPLE SEALED ABSTRACT or EXEMPLIFIED COPY of your judgment.
- ➤ If the Judgment Creditor gives notice by mail to the Judgment Debtor(s) of the filing of the Foreign Judgment, PROOF OF MAILING MUST BE ATTACHED.
- ➤ Attorney(s) must provide a D.C. BAR NUMBER.
