For *One Piece, Toei* closed a DVD deal with TELEVISORA NICARAGUENSE in Nicaragua (episodes 1-104); For *Pretty Cure* Toei signed EN PANTALLA in Mexico (episodes 1-26); and For *Sailor Moon,* Toei finalized DVD agreements with TOWERS ENTERTAINTMENT in Mexico for the entire series and with CD & DVD Factory in Brazil (episodes 90-110).

"Home entertainment continues to serve as a powerful platform for Toei's animated brands in Latin America. We are delighted to forge distribution associations with the top DVD suppliers throughout the region," said Lucio.
