Constitutional Amendments

Amendment No. 1: “Local Option Economic Development Amendment”

To amend the State Constitution to permit the Legislature to authorize the financing of the public portion of economic development projects through the issuance by counties or municipalities of bonds payable from increases in real and personal property taxes, not including taxes from excess levies, bond levies, or other special levies, on the private portion of the economic development projects. Upon payment in full of the bonds, for a term not to exceed 40 years, the increased tax revenues revert to the appropriate levying bodies. No tax revenues of the county or counties or municipality may be pledged to, or used for, the payment of the bonds, except for the increased tax revenues. No bonds may be issued unless the issuance of the bonds is approved by a majority of the voters of the county or if it is the issuing body, or if a municipality is the issuing body, by a majority of the voters in both the municipality and the county in which the municipality is located.

Amendment No.2: “Judicial Reform Amendment”

To amend the Constitution of West Virginia to authorize the Legislature to create additional courts of original and appellate jurisdiction.”
