

4A NEIGHBOURHOOD PARKS

The major park for the neighbourhood because of its size, location and/or range of facilities.



Northumberland Street Reserve, Bonnyrigg Heights

Facilities can include:

- Playground with a variety of equipment, park bench and/or picnic table
- Pedestrian/cycle path and circuit path
- Signage (eg park name) and interpretation
- Trees – planted or re-growth
- Open area for casual games or a sports court

Or the park is of sufficient size to accommodate the above facilities but they have yet to be developed.

- There are 27 4a Neighbourhood Parks covering approx 35 hectares.

4B LOCAL PARKS

Local (or “Pocket”) parks are smaller in size and have limited facilities and infrastructure compared to 4a - neighbourhood parks.



Falklands Avenue Reserve, Bossley Park

Facilities may include:

- Small or limited infrastructure playground with carers seat
- Pedestrian path
- Signage (park name)
- Trees – often planted or re-growth indigenous trees

Or the park could accommodate the above facilities and infrastructure but they have yet to be developed.

There are 81 4b Local Parks covering approx 40 hectares.

CREEK LINE PARKS

Park areas located on a creek line (Natural area – Watercourse). Some are large areas and have the potential to be developed into 4a parks.



Heiden Park, Carramar

Current infrastructure and facilities may include or have the potential to include:

- Playground and seats
- Pedestrian/cycle path linking areas of open space along the creek and/or circuit paths and bridges
- Areas for casual sports and/or sports courts ie relatively large level open areas
- Planting and/or remnant indigenous vegetation
- Signage and interpretation
- Fauna habitat

WETLAND PARK

Parks that include a wetland area that may be constructed or semi-natural (Natural area – Wetland).



De Freitas Wetland, Fairfield

Facilities may include:

- Playground and seating
- Interpretation and signage
- Pedestrian/cycle paths, circuit paths, viewing platforms, boardwalks, creek crossings (bridges)
- Indigenous vegetation (planted or re-growth)
- Fauna habitat

Total 5 areas – approx 10 hectares

COMMUNITY PARK

Parks (on community land) with community halls (areas categorised General Community Use).

FORESHORE PARK

Parks on the foreshores of Chipping Norton Lake that are not used as Sportsgrounds.



Bradbury Wharf, Hoy Park, Lansvale

10 separately named areas less than 10 hectares.
