





ELEGANT WRAP

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 19 x 42 ins [48 x 106.5 cm].

MATERIALS

Patons Brilliant (50 g/1.75 oz) **Main Color (MC)** (03143 Blue Shimmer) or (03008 Crystal Cream) **2 balls**

Patons Divine (100 g/3.5 oz) **Contrast A** (06106 Halo Blue) or (06011 Soft Earth) **2 balls**

Sizes 9 mm (U.S. 13) and 12 mm (U.S. 17) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.**

TENSION: 8 sts and 9 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needles and 1 strand each of MC and A tog in stocking st.

STITCH GLOSSARY

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit.$

 $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}.$

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together.

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over next stitch.

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise.

St(s) = Stitch(es).

Yfwd = Yarn forward.

Yrn = Yarn round needle.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needles and A, cast on 40 sts. **1st row: (WS). Sl1. Knit to end of row. Rep last row twice more.**

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows: **Next row:** (RS). With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, K36. With MC, K2.

Proceed in Lace Pat as follows:

1st and alt rows: (WS). With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, *P2tog. yrn. P6. Rep from * to last 6 sts. P2tog. yrn. P2. With MC, K2.

2nd row: With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. *yfwd. Sl1. K1. psso. K2. Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. With MC, K2.

4th row: With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. *K1. yfwd. Sl1. K1. psso. K1. Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. With MC, K2.

6th row: With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. *K2. yfwd. (Sl1. K1. psso) twice. yfwd. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. With MC, K2.

8th row: With MC, Sl1. K1. With MC and A tog, Sl1. K1. psso. yfwd. K2. *K3. yfwd. Sl1. K2tog. psso. yfwd. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. With MC, K2.

Last 8 rows form Lace Pat.

Cont in Lace pat until work from beg measures approx 40 ins [101.5 cm], ending with 8th row of pat. Break MC.

Change to smaller needles and with A, work from ** to **. Cast off knitwise (WS).
