

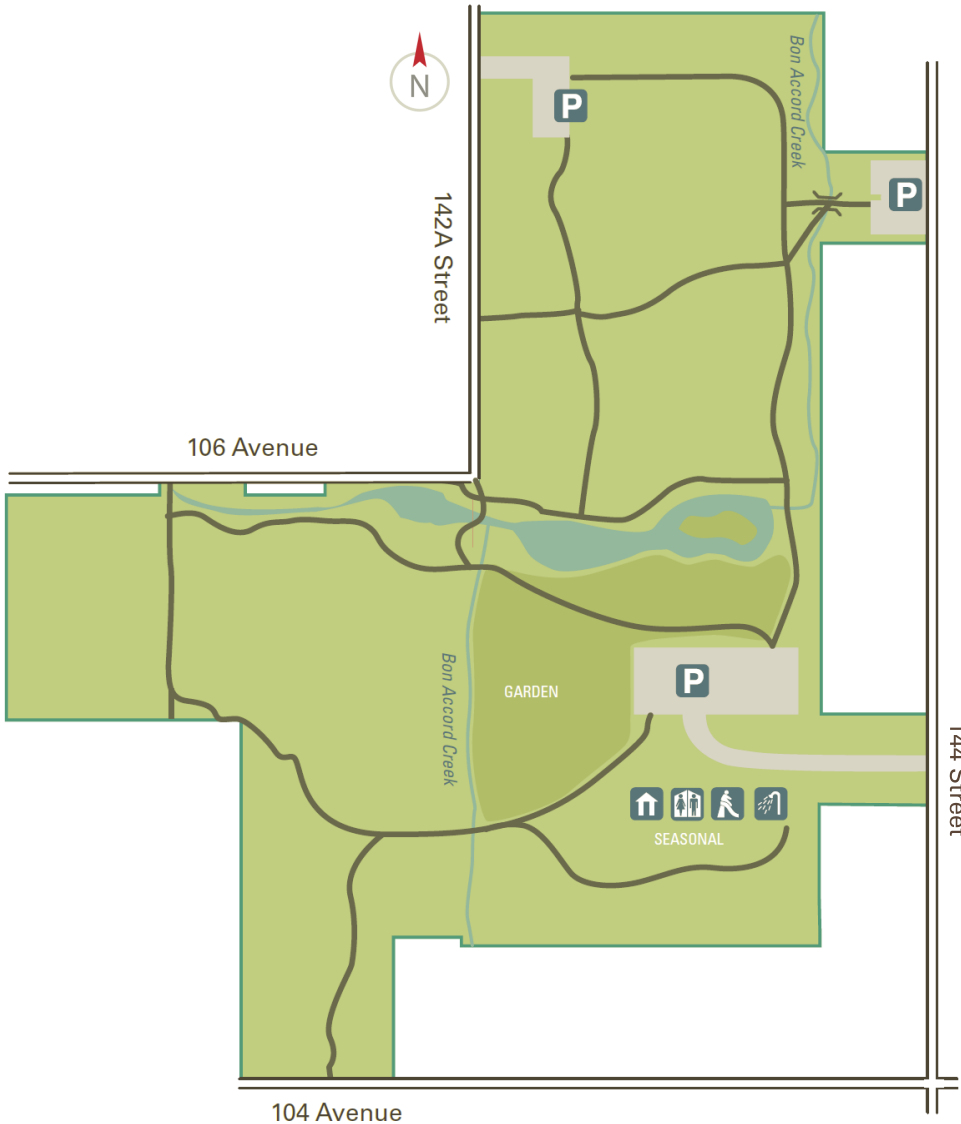
# Nature Trails

OF SURREY

## Hawthorne Park

10503 - 144 ST

The trails at Hawthorne Park will take you over bridges, past ponds, and through a mainly deciduous forest (trees that lose their leaves in the fall). Look for large stumps on the sides of the trails that are a reminder of Surrey's early settlers. The combination of pond, stream, forest and open field means that if you visit near dusk you should look up – you might see bats overhead hunting for insects.
