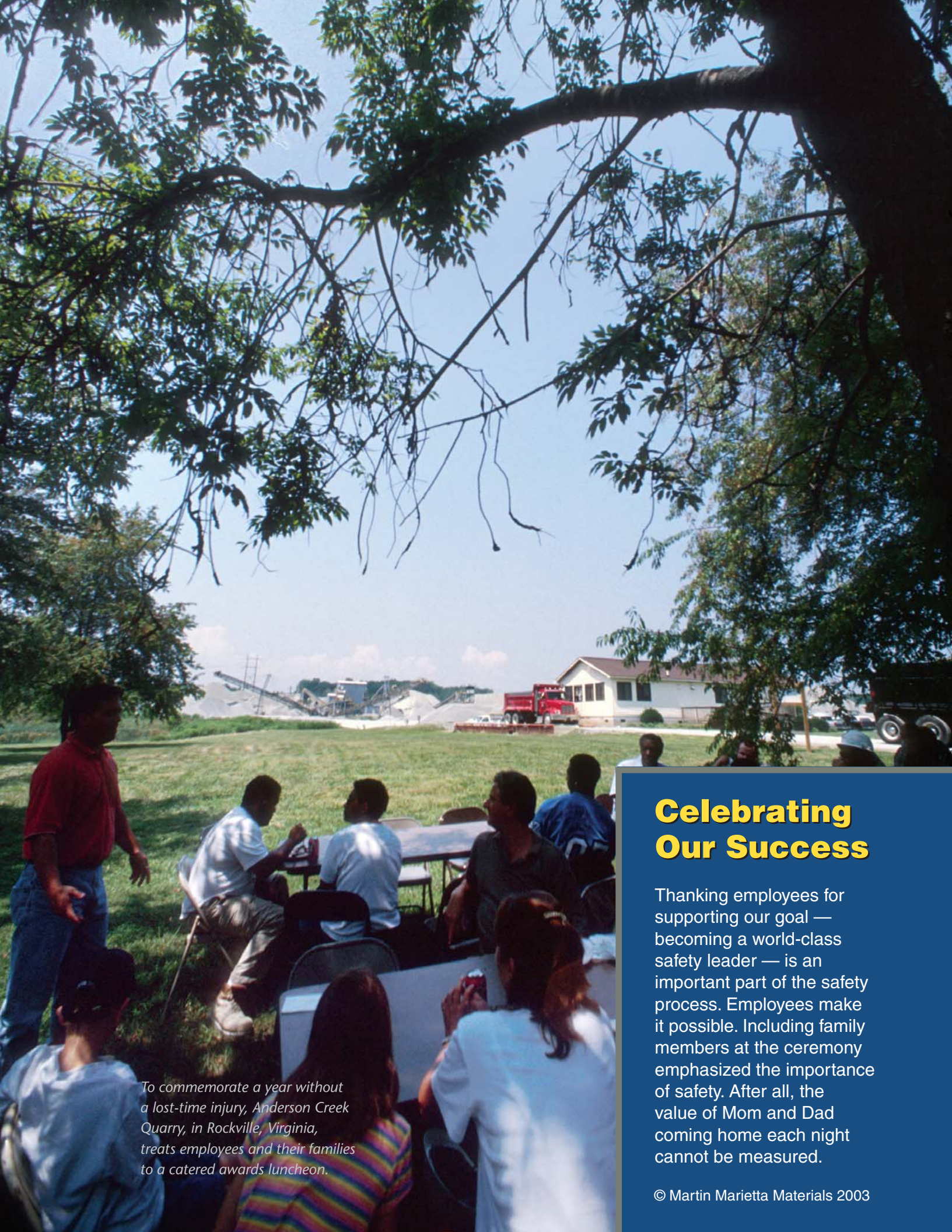
Decision-based safety starts with a simple idea — all injuries are preventable. Embracing this fundamental belief, Martin Marietta set a goal of zero accidents.
