

## First titles for Minnehaha Academy, Apple Valley; Southwest Minnesota Christian claims fifth championship; DeLaSalle wins seventh

The 2013 State Boys' Basketball Tournament produced two new champions. Minnehaha Academy of Minneapolis (26-6) claimed its first state championship title after defeating Litchfield 56-54 in the Class AA title game. In the Class AAAA championship game, Apple Valley (31-1) defeated Park Center of Brooklyn Park 74-57 for the school's first title.

The other two champions were Southwest Minnesota Christian of Edgerton (30-1) in Class A and DeLaSalle of Minneapolis (30-1) in Class AAA. Southwest Minnesota Christian won its fifth title after defeating Maranatha Christian Academy of Brooklyn Park 81-73. The Islanders of DeLaSalle went home with their seventh championship trophy after beating Austin 50-33.

### Class A

Southwest Minnesota Christian of Edgerton (30-1) won its fifth championship after defeating Maranatha Christian Academy of Brooklyn Park (31-2) 81-73. The Eagles, who earned runner-up honors in 2012, were making their eighth tournament appearance. In addition to this year, Southwest Minnesota Christian also won four consecutive titles between 1999 and 2002.

Maranatha went on a 12-1 run to open up a 33-30 lead in the first half and senior Isaiah Hanson's put back with one second left on the clock gave the Mustangs a 37-34 halftime lead. The Mustangs continued to dominate in the opening minutes of the second half, stretching their lead to 51-44.

Southwest Minnesota Christian was not about to concede, however, and the Eagles pulled within three points after back-to-back layups from juniors Leighton Sampson and Nate Pfeifle. Senior Dominic Nibbelink completed the comeback for the Eagles; he hit a free throw to tie the score at 58-58 with 8:13 remaining in the game and then followed it with a jumper to give

Southwest Minnesota Christian a 60-58 advantage. The Eagles didn't trail again and Nibbelink helped ice the win by making eight free throws in the final six minutes.

Nibbelink had a game-high 29 points and seven assists for the victorious Eagles, complemented by 22 points and three blocks from Leighton Sampson. Maranatha was led by senior forward Isaiah Hanson with 24 points and a game-high eight rebounds.

Southwest Minnesota Christian began its title run with a 68-38 quarterfinal victory over

the first-time qualifiers from Walker-Hackensack-Akeley. The Eagles took a 40-17 lead into half-time on the strength of the team's 58 percent accuracy from the field and Leighton Sampson's 15 points. Walker-Hackensack-Akeley refused to give up and mounted a 9-2 run early in the second half, but the Eagles' lead was too much for the Wolves to overcome.

Sampson finished with a team- and game-high 17 points on 8-for-12 shooting from the field. Dominic Nibbelink hit 7-of-10 for 16 points and senior Klint Knutson scored 10 more.

In the semifinals, Southwest Minnesota Christian defeated Upsala 71-62. The Eagles led by as much as 16 points in the first half and they dominated in the paint, outscoring Upsala 36 to 16. Leighton Sampson poured in 33 points for the Eagles and also pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds. Klint Knutson added a dozen points plus five assists, and Dominic Nibbelink contributed 10 in the winning effort.

Maranatha Christian Academy defeated Mountain Lake 61-44 in the quarterfinals. Sophomore Grantham Gillard came off the bench to score 15 points, all in the second half. The Mustangs stretched a four-point lead to 13 when he rattled off 13 consecutive points for his team. Four additional players also scored in double figures for the Mustangs: sophomore Jeremiah Hanson (13), senior Garrison Gillard (12), senior Isaiah Hanson (11), and junior Josh Goldschmidt (10). Garrison Gillard also led the Mustangs with eight rebounds.

Maranatha advanced to the semifinals and defeated the perennial qualifiers from Rushford-Peterson 61-46. From the 11:35 mark of the second half, the Mustangs maintained at least a 10-point lead. Again, three starters and one reserve finished with double-digit totals for Maranatha. Isaiah Hanson tallied 18 points, Jeremiah Hanson had 17, and Garrison Gillard had 12. Grantham Gillard came off the bench and added 13 points for the Mustangs. Maranatha Christian Academy also out-rebounded Rushford-Peterson 36-18.

The Trojans of Rushford-Peterson claimed third-place honors

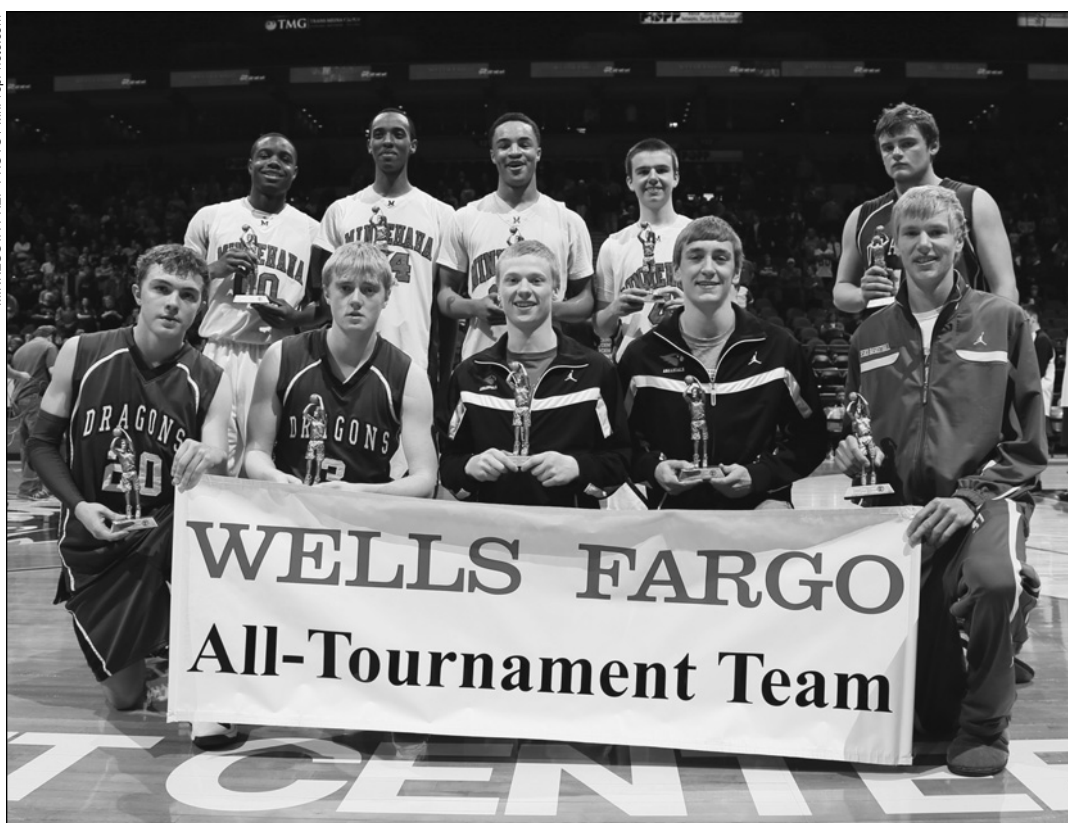

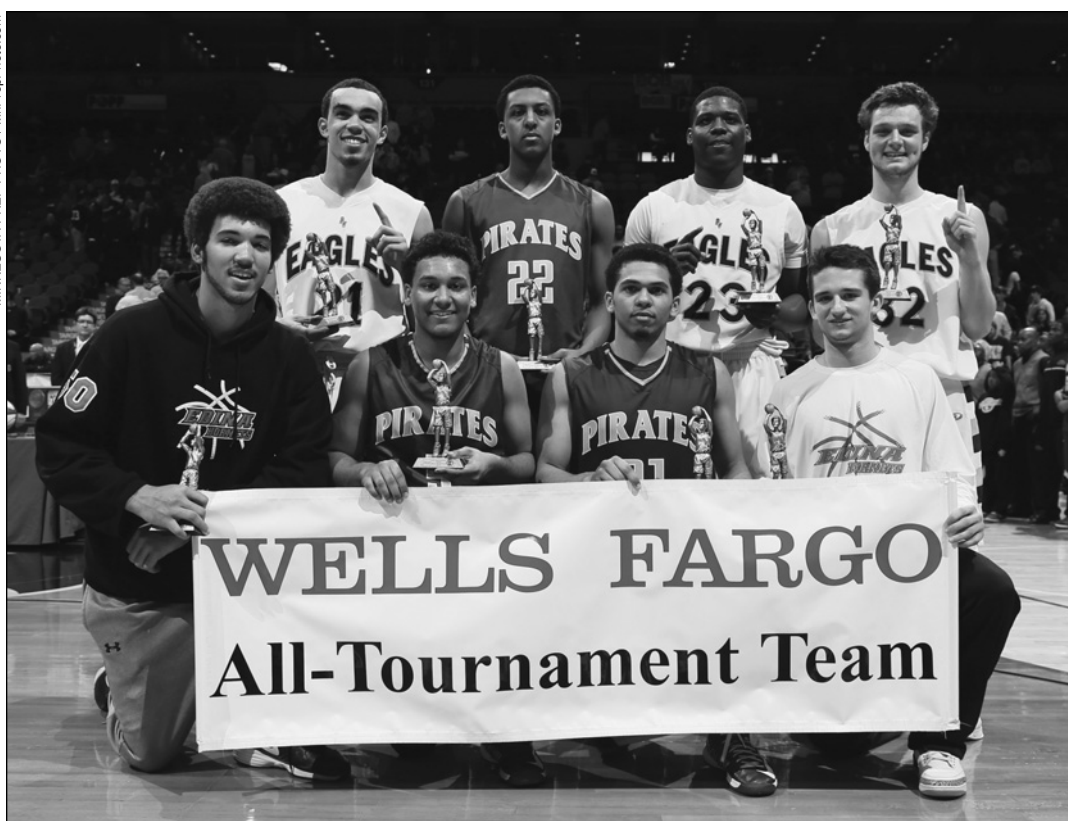

### Class AA

The Redhawks of Minnehaha Academy of Minneapolis (26-6) won their first state championship in their fourth appearance after defeating the Dragons of Litchfield (26-6) 56-54. The loss marked the second consecutive runner-up showing for the Dragons, who fell to Plainview-Elgin-Millville 55-39 in the 2012 title game.

Minnehaha Academy led 30-29 at the break and held an advantage until Litchfield senior Zach Kinny hit a free throw attempt and put the Dragons up 46-45 with 7:33 left in the game. The lead was short-lived, however, as Minnehaha Academy senior John Pryor countered with a three-pointer on the next possession. The Redhawks didn't trail again after that and another three-pointer from Pryor at 3:48 extended Minnehaha Academy's lead to 53-49. Litchfield senior Zach Whitchurch made a last-second attempt to tie the game but he was stymied in the paint by Pryor and senior Kaharri Carter.

Senior Marcellous Hazzard shot a perfect 3-of-3 from behind the arc and led Minnehaha Academy with 14 points. Pryor added 12 points and Carter tallied 11 points and a game-high eight rebounds. Senior Riley Pater was the top

scorer for Litchfield with 16 points. Seniors Dylan Koll and Cameron Sundmark netted nine points apiece and Zach Kinny grabbed seven rebounds.

Minnehaha Academy knocked off Perham 53-41 in the quarterfinals. The Redhawks used three 9-0 runs and a 7-0 stretch in the final minutes to slow down the Yellowjackets. The final surge came when Minnehaha Academy senior Thomas Gedion blocked senior Josh Nordick, corralled the loose ball, and ran down the court to score, giving the Redhawks a 38-32 edge. Senior Jesse Johnson paced Minnehaha Academy with 13 points and Gedion added eight points and a game-high 10 rebounds.

In the semifinals, Minnehaha Academy rolled to a 32-6 first-half lead and went on to defeat Annandale 91-79. The Cardinals were able to score 29 points off the Redhawks' 22 turnovers, but it wasn't enough to overcome the deficit. Kaharri Carter scored a career-high 29 points for Minnehaha Academy and Jesse Johnson added 23 points and three assists. Thomas Gedion also had a stellar game, tallying a double-double with 10 points and 14 rebounds.

On the other side of the bracket, Litchfield needed double-overtime to defeat Redwood Valley of Redwood Falls 64-55 in the quarterfinals. Zach Whitchurch drained a three-pointer for the Dragons to tie the game 49-49 at the end of regulation and Redwood Valley senior Alex Koster countered with a three-pointer to tie the game 54-54 at the end of the first overtime. The Dragons outscored the Cardinals 10-1 in the final overtime period with Dylan Koll and Zach Kinny each converting both ends of a 1-and-1 at the free throw line to seal the win. Kinny finished the game with 18 points and Koll and Riley Pater added 11 apiece. Pater also led the Dragons with nine rebounds.

Litchfield moved on and defeated Esko 72-47 in the semifinals. The Dragons hit 8-of-13 three-

pointers in the first half and they finished 14-of-22 from behind the arc. Zach Whitchurch drained four three-pointers in the first half and went on to lead Litchfield with 22 points. Zach Kinny tallied 19 points for the Dragons and Riley Pater grabbed a team-high six rebounds.

the Islanders extended their lead to 36-19. The Packers pushed back, cutting the lead to 40-30 when junior Zach Wessels converted a jump shot with 6:39 left in the game, but DeLaSalle's defense held steady.

Travis led DeLaSalle with 17 points and 12 rebounds. Scott added 10 points for the Islanders and sophomore Jarvis Johnson tallied six. Senior Tom Aase was the only Austin player to finish in double figures; he scored 14 points and also grabbed a team-high six rebounds.

DeLaSalle opened tournament play with a 70-55 victory over the first-time qualifiers from Sartell-St. Stephen. The Sabres opened the game with a quick 11-4 lead, but Reid Travis soon made his presence known, scoring the first eight points for the Islanders. Travis finished the game with 23 points, 16 rebounds, four blocks, and two steals. Jarvis Johnson and sophomore Sacar Anim added 10 points apiece for the Islanders.

In the semifinals, DeLaSalle defeated St. Paul Johnson 86-59. The Islanders scored 50 points in the paint and with the Governors' defense focused on Travis, Luke Scott was free to score 20 from the perimeter. Travis led both teams with 30 points and 12 rebounds and Scott finished the game with 30 points, four assists, and three steals.

Austin defeated the newcomers from The Blake School of Minneapolis 59-56 in the quarterfinals. The Bears used a 16-5 run over the final 5:52 of the first half to claim a 31-24 edge at the break. Austin slowly chipped away at the lead and finally gained control of the game for good when junior Ajuda Nywesh sank a pair of free throws with 2:28 left to go. Senior Joe Aase was the top scorer for the Packers; he scored 20 points and corralled eight rebounds. Nywesh finished with 15 points and five steals.

The Packers had a harder time in their semifinal game and they needed overtime to dismiss

the Marshall Tigers 68-65. Marshall senior Tanner Bukowski tied the score 56-56 on a spinning jumper with 36.7 seconds remaining in regulation, but Austin took over in the extra period. Ajuda Nywesh's two free throws with 28.8 seconds left in overtime gave Austin the lead for good, and he added two more to seal the victory.

Zach Wessels led Austin with 20 points and Tom Aase added 16 more. Tom Aase and Joe Aase each tallied five rebounds for the Packers.

In the third-place game, Marshall defeated St. Paul Johnson 71-62. The Tigers' largest lead of the game was a 21-point edge, 54-33 with 10:42 to play in the second half. St. Paul Johnson made a huge push in the final few minutes of the game, using a 15-2 run to cut the score to 63-58 with 1:28 remaining. The run contained numerous forced turnovers, three-point shots, and fast break buckets. Marshall

### Class AAAA

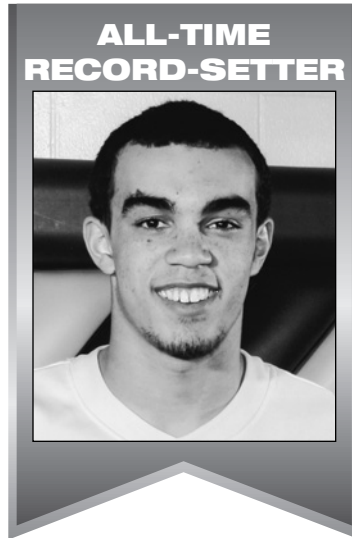
The Apple Valley Eagles (31-1) earned their first championship with a 74-57 victory over Park Center of Brooklyn Park (28-4). This year marked the sixth tournament appearance for the Eagles, but their first since 2009.

The title game was sweet revenge for Apple Valley; Park Center was the only team to beat the Eagles this year, posting a 72-70 victory early in the season. The tables were turned on the big stage, however, where Apple Valley controlled the game with defense and discipline. Junior standout Tyus Jones didn't score for the Eagles until 13 minutes into the game, but his teammates built a double-digit that held up for most of the game.

Once Jones got warmed up, he proved why he is one of the top recruits in the country. He finished with a game-high 28 points and he also posted 11 rebounds, five assists, one block, and one steal. He also went 18-of-18 at the free throw line, which tied a state tournament record for best free throw percentage. Jones' supporting cast also put up stellar numbers; junior Dennis Austin posted a double-double with 15 points and 15 rebounds, and senior Dennis Frank added 14 points.

Senior Quinton Hooker paced Park Center with 18 points and nine rebounds. Seniors Devin Buckley and Treyton Daniels added 15 and 10 points, respectively, for the Pirates.

In the quarterfinals, Apple Valley defeated Brainerd 81-67. The score was tied 56-56 with 9:06 remaining, but Tyus Jones scored five of the Eagles' next 13 points and dished off two assists to help Apple Valley pull away. Jones and Dennis Austin both finished the game with 19

points and ninth-grader Brock Bertram added a team-high eight rebounds and three blocks.

Jones' late-game theatrics also proved critical in the semifinal game as Apple Valley overpowered Eden Prairie 62-55. With 2:14 left on the clock and Eden Prairie trailing 53-51, Jones made his way down the floor and managed an acrobatic layup that restored Apple Valley's lead to four. From there, he added four free throws down the stretch to keep Eden Prairie from rallying any closer than five points. Jones led his squad with 23 points, five assists, and six steals. Dennis Austin tallied an additional 15 points and Brock Bertram grabbed 13 rebounds.

Park Center opened tournament play with a 74-72 overtime victory over Lakeville North. The Pirates led by as many as 19 points in the first half, but the Panthers stormed back,

outscored Park Center 40-24 in the second. Lakeville North senior Kyrell Newell tied the game at 67-67 with 50 seconds left in regulation to send the game into overtime. Junior Isaac Matthews was the key to the Pirates' victory; he grabbed a rebound off a shot from Quinton Hooker and put it in as time expired. Three Park Center players had double-doubles in the victory: Hooker had 29 points and 10 rebounds; Treyton Daniels notched 16 points and 10 rebounds; and Devin Buckley tallied 10 points and 11 rebounds.

In the semifinals, Park Center defeated Edina 66-44. The Pirates built a 37-22 halftime lead and added to it in the second half. Junior Isaiah McKay scored 14 of his 16 points in the first half and he was one of four Park Center starters in double figures. Quinton Hooker added 14 points to the winning effort and Devin Buckley had a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

The Edina Hornets earned third-place honors after defeating Eden Prairie 84-49. Edina senior Graham Woodward nailed a three-point shot to put his team up 9-6 at the 15:18 mark of the first half and the Hornets never trailed after that. Both teams controlled the ball well and had minimal turnovers. The difference in the game came from field goal efficiency and Edina's 37-28 rebounding edge.

Woodward shined for Edina, shooting 11-of-20 from the field to lead all players with 29 points. He also had six rebounds and eight assists. Senior Reggie Lynch added 22 points to the Edina cause and topped all players with 10 rebounds.

The 2013 State Boys' Basketball Tournament quarterfinals were played March 20 and 21 at Williams Arena on the University of Minnesota campus in Minneapolis and at Target Center in Minneapolis. All semifinal and championship games were played at Target Center on March 22 and 23. The third-place games were played at Gangelhoff Center on the Concordia University campus in St. Paul on March 24. Total paid attendance was 62,133.
