DID YOU KNOW?

In the early 1900's, German immigrants arrived at the creek, settling at 'Wartburg' - meaning 'The Waiting Place.'

The area has many historical features, including St Paul's Lutheran Church.

Baffle Creek was home to the Baffle Creek Sugar Mill on Wartburg Hill, the most northerly mill in the Bundaberg Region and the second last privately owned mill in Queensland.

The area has several macadamia nut farms—the oldest in the southern hemisphere.

Baffle Creek remains one of Queensland's few relatively pristine river systems, offering amazing mangrove stands and wildlife shows – and is renowned for its fishing!

Fishing

Grab a line, bait and tackle and fish to your hearts content in Baffle Creek's major river estuary and Rules Beach providing many opportunities for fishing, crabbing and boating. Several boat ramps are available and bait and gear is obtainable from the local caravan park shops and in the small business centre.

4WD Adventures

There are excellent opportunities for those 4WD enthusiasts, with Deepwater National Park just a few kilometres up the road. On an unspoilt coastline, Deepwater National Park features beautiful freshwater wetlands, beaches and high sand dunes and is backed with open forest. Perfect for beach walking, canoeing, birdwatching, fishing and of course – four-wheel driving! Camp at Wreck Rock, Middle Rock or visit Flat Rock for the day. Broadwater Conservation Park is at the northern end of Rules Beach.
