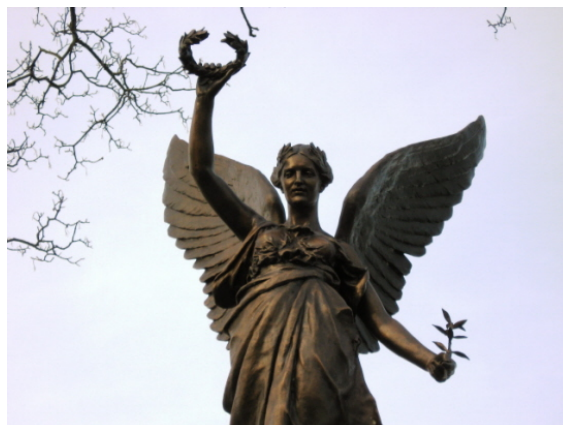

Description Bronze angel holding laurel wreath on stone (granite) column on square base bearing inscriptions ERECTED/ IN HONOUR AND MEMORY/ OF ALL THOSE/ MEN AND WOMEN OF/ UXBRIDGE/ WHO SERVED OR FELL/ IN THE GREAT WAR/ 1914-1918/ AN EXPRESSION OF GRATITUDE FROM/ THEIR FELLOW TOWNSMEN and IN MEMORIAM/ 1939-1945.

Moved from original location at junction of Park Road and High Street in early 70's

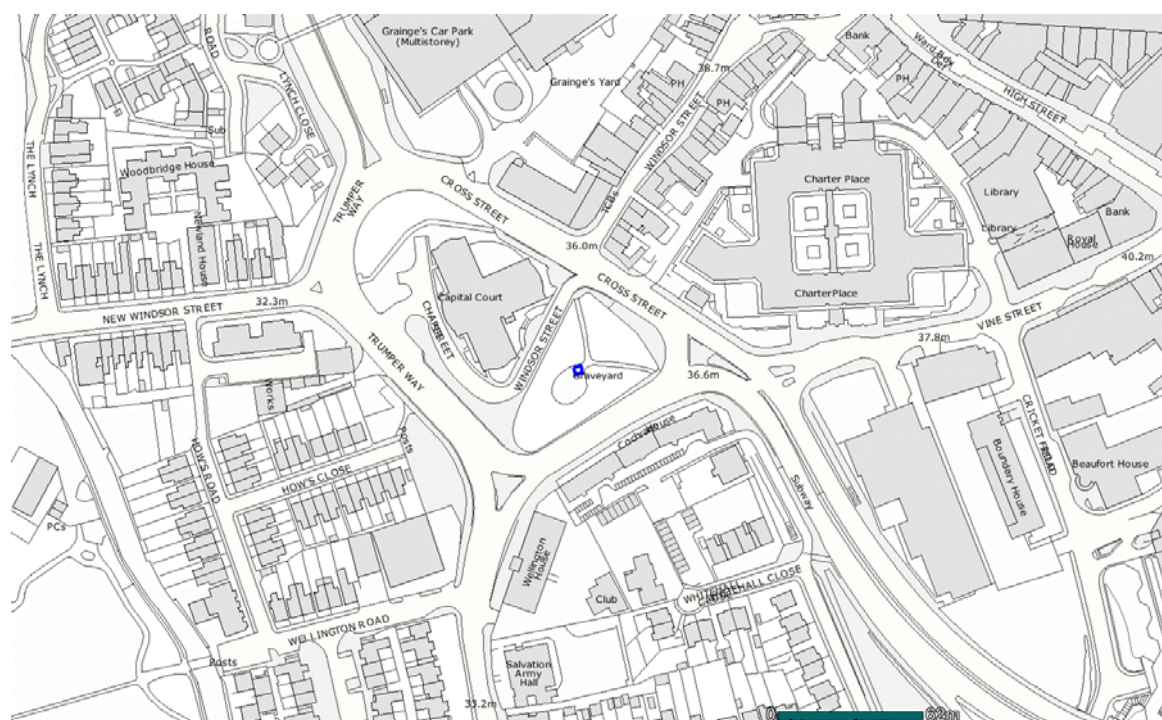
