
Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter and am very glad you intend playing your match on our course.

The date is alright. I myself should prefer a Saturday, as our members would be sure to be all there, which will not be possible on a Wednesday. But there is one other objection and it is the following I wrote to Mr. Del Court, Hon. Secretary of the Ned. Golf Comité and he is with me of the opinion that if an official championship is played, this ought to be governed by the Nederlandsche Golf Comité and it is doubtful whether this Comité would accept all the conditions and the fact that the Championshipsprice is offered by a firm manufacturing golf balls. Of course there is no objection whatever against the playing of the match, but only against the official title of All Holland Prof-Champion. Most likely the Nederlandsche Golf Comité, if a meeting could be held before, should grant permission and I think that the Nederlandsche Golf Comité would like to present the Championships Cup for it, but there is not the time to decide this now.

I have written again to Mr. Del Court and hope I will get a favourable reply that some arrangement can be made. Meanwhile I should like you to let me know more particulars about the regulations of this match.
