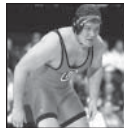

## OREGON STATE WRESTLING HISTORY

Since 1909, Oregon State's wrestling program has made a habit of being on top - both on the mat and in the standings.

In over half of OSU's 84 wrestling seasons, the Beavers have been conference champions - that's 44 team titles in the Northwest, Pacific Coast, Pacific-8 and Pacific-10 conferences. Oregon State was NCAA runner-up in 1973 and 1995.

OSU was known as Oregon Agricultural College when the school began a wrestling team in 1909. The Beavers won their first conference title that season and went on to win 12 straight from 1915-26. During that time, OAC produced an Olympic gold medalist in Robin Reed and a silver medalist in Chet Newton; under Reed, the Beavers won the Amateur Athletic Union national title in Corvallis in 1926.

After 1926, Pacific Coast schools removed wrestling from the list of major sports and competition was limited to intramurals. It resumed on a limited intercollegiate basis in 1934 but World War II halted wrestling again.

The Beavers' dynasty resumed in 1957 with the arrival of coach Dale Thomas. In the 34 seasons Thomas spent at Oregon State, the Beavers had a 616-168-13 record, 22 conference team titles, 14 top-10 finishes at the NCAA Championships, and 60 All-Americans.

Thomas was the NCAA Coach of the Year in 1961 and 1970 and remains the NCAA's all-time winningest coach. His teams regularly attracted crowds in the 5,000-6,000 range for meets and Thomas was instrumental in bringing the 1961 and 1980 NCAA Championship meets to Gill Coliseum.

The 1990s brought another wrestling revival to OSU. Mark Johnson guided the Beavers to a Pacific-10 title in 1992; Joe Wells led Oregon State to the 1994 Pacific-10 title and four Top 10 finishes at the NCAA Championships in five years from 1994-98.

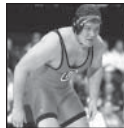

## DALE THOMAS

Of all the marks in Oregon State's wrestling record book, the toughest to break belongs to former coach Dale Thomas. In his 34 seasons at OSU, Thomas' teams won 616 dual meets.

Thomas, who coached at OSU from 1957-90, compiled a 616-168-13 record. His teams won or tied for 22 conference championships, placed in the NCAA's Top 10 on 14 occasions and were in the Top Five seven times, including a runner-up finish in 1973. OSU had 60 All-Americans during Thomas' tenure.

Thomas also helped bring numerous important meets and tournaments to Gill Coliseum, including the National Wrestling Coaches Association East-West All-Star Meet. Thomas' efforts also landed OSU the privilege of hosting the NCAA National Championships in 1961 and 1980; those meets helped make collegiate wrestling a national sport.

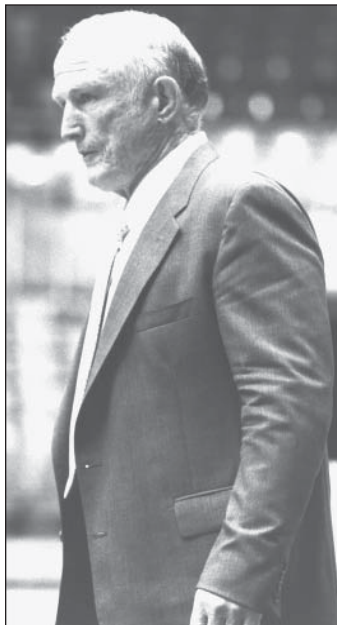
Thomas was named the NCAA Coach of the Year in 1961 and 1970 and was Pacific-10 Coach of the Year four times. He remains the winningest coach in NCAA history.

Thomas' biographical sketch at the National Wrestling Hall of Fame - which inducted him in 1980 - begins, "Perhaps no man has left his mark on wrestling in as many ways as Dale Thomas - as wrestler, coach, official, teacher and innovator."

"There's no doubt that he had the most influence on one state of anybody we've ever had in wrestling," said Myron Roderick, the former Oklahoma State coach who is now president of the Hall of Fame.

Among Thomas' other accomplishments:

- Elected to the National Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1980; the State of Iowa Hall of Fame in 1982; and the Cornell (Iowa) Sports Hall of Fame in 1970.
- Helped bring the United States vs. Soviet Union World Cup meet to Corvallis.
- Officiated in the 1960 and 1964 Olympic Games and several

World Championships.

- Coached the United States' Greco-Roman teams in international competition in 1961 and 1966.

- Initiated the Oregon high school freestyle tournament in 1962; a state tournament was later added for the Greco-Roman style.

- Organized and directed the Wrestling Cultural Exchange program between Oregon high schools and locales including Japan, Europe, Mexico, New Zealand and South Africa.

- Started and developed the Kid Wrestling program for young athletes in Oregon. The program later became nationwide.

- Began and ran the Double D Wrestling Ranch in the Coast Mountains west of Corvallis.

Thomas wrestled for Cornell College (Iowa) in the late 1940s and was captain of the school's 1947 NCAA championship team. He won nine national titles in collegiate, freestyle and Greco-Roman competitions and was a member of United States Olympic teams in 1952 and 1956.

Thomas earned his bachelor's degree from Cornell in 1947, his master's degree from Purdue in 1948 and his doctorate from Iowa in 1956.

## OREGON STATE OLYMPIANS



Robin Reed (top)

For over 80 years, Oregon State has been providing wrestlers for United States Olympic teams.

The most successful was Robin Reed, a 1924 gold medalist. Reed wrestled for the Beavers when the school was known as Oregon Agricultural College.

Reed came to OAC from Portland's Franklin High. Though his actual weight was close to 140 pounds, Reed often wrestled at 170 pounds.

Reed won the gold at 135 pounds in Paris, pinning all his foes, including OAC teammate Chet Newton in the final. Legend has it that Reed wrestled against each of his United States team-

mates while sailing to Europe for the Olympics; he won every match and pinned all but the heavyweight. Reed also won two national amateur titles. Later, Reed coached the Beavers for two seasons; his teams dominated Pacific Coast competition and won the 1926 Amateur Athletic Union national championship in a meet held in Corvallis.
