

Warning School

- A <u>warning school means</u> that the school fell short of the AYP targets but has another year to achieve them
- These schools are <u>not subject to consequences</u>
- <u>Rather</u>, they should examine, and where necessary modify, their improvement strategies so they will meet targets next year

Safe Harbor

- A 10% reduction in % of students NOT proficient
- Safe Harbor status allows a school or district to achieve AYP without meeting the standard achievement targets (81% in reading; 78% in mathematics)
- These schools qualify under the NCLB "Safe Harbor" provision. If a school or subgroup does not meet the performance targets <u>but does reduce the percentage of</u> <u>below-proficient students by 10% or more</u>, it will be considered to have met AYP
- These schools are recognized as having met AYP because such improvement is significant

Confidence Interval

- Confidence Intervals are calculated for <u>both</u> <u>current year and average of current year and</u> <u>previous year</u>
- Thus, two years of data are analyzed
- Takes into account the fact that the students tested in any particular year might not be representative of students in that school across the years

Growth Model

- The Growth Model recognizes the efforts of schools whose students have not achieved proficiency but are on trajectories towards proficiency on future PSSA exams
- The Growth Model will be calculated for all AYP Performance Targets (i.e., the all student group and up to nine subgroups). Projected scores are *calculated* for all students including students who are proficient. If a projected score cannot be calculated for a particular student, the student's actual score is used. The Growth Model will be *applied* to an AYP Performance Target **only** if the target cohort has not made AYP performance by any of the existing six (6) provisions. Actual, not projected, PASA scores, 3rd grade scores, and 11th grade scores are always used, as well as the scores for any students with insufficient data points to make a projection

- Schools that continually fail are subject to state imposed sanctions.

Consequences for Failing to Make AYP

School Improvement I – AYP failure for 2 consecutive years

If a school does not meet its AYP for two years in a row, students will be eligible for school choice, school officials will develop an improvement plan to turn around the school, and the school will receive technical assistance to help it get back on the right track. The school choice provision means that the school/district is required to offer parents the option of sending their child to another public school (including charter schools) within the school district. If no other school within the district is available, a district must, to the extent practical, enter into a cooperative agreement with another district that will allow students to transfer.

School Improvement II - AYP failure for 3 consecutive years

If a school or district does not meet its AYP for three years in a row, it must continue to offer public school choice and plan improvements. Additionally, the school or district will need to offer supplemental education services such as tutoring, after-school, or summer school support. The district will be responsible for paying for these additional services.

Corrective Action I - AYP failure for 4 consecutive years

A school or district is categorized in Corrective Action I when it does not meet its AYP for four consecutive years. At this level, schools are eligible for various levels of technical assistance and are subject to escalating consequences (e.g., changes in curriculum, leadership, professional development).

Corrective Action II - AYP failure for 5 consecutive years

If a school or district does not meet its AYP for five years in a row, it is subject to governance changes such as reconstitution, chartering, and privatization. In the meantime, improvement plans, school choice, and supplemental education services are still required.

JUST THE FACTS

- 9 out of 12 Cyber Schools DID NOT Make AYP
 - 1 of the 3 made AYP this year but it is still in "Corrective Action II"
- 195 out of the state's 499 Public School Districts <u>DID</u> <u>NOT</u> make AYP (39.1%)
- 1493 out of 2,898 Public Schools <u>DID NOT</u> make AYP (49.7%)
- Last year
 - 467 of 499 Public School Districts made AYP (93.5%)
 - 2,326 of 3,096 Public Schools <u>made AYP</u> (75.1%)

Statewide Proficiency Percentage

- Math-required 78%
 - Dropped from 77.1% last year to 75.7% this year
- Reading-required 81%
 - Dropped from 73.5% last year to 71.9% this year
- Neither of those rates meet the required proficiency
