GENERAL INFORMATION



BEAUMONT, TEXAS

Population 118,548 (Beaumont)

Elevation 21 feet above sea level (Beaumont)

Climate Beaumont's climate reflects its location near the Gulf of Mexico: There are mild winters and hot, humid summers. Temperatures rarely go below freezing. Spring is warm and slightly humid, but comfortable for most people. It starts early, giving flowers an extra-long blooming season.

Beaumont is located in the flat Coastal Plains, about 85 miles from Houston, 15 miles from the Gulf of Mexico and about 60 miles from Galveston Bay. The climate is predominantly semi-tropical, which draws residents and visitors year-round for birding, fishing, hunting, boating, swimming, camping and other outdoor recreation. The terrain includes numerous small streams and bayous, which together with the nearness to Galveston Bay favor the development of fog. Prevailing winds are from the southeast and south, except in January, when frequent passages of high-pressure areas bring invasions of polar air and prevailing northerly winds.

Temperatures are moderated by the influence of winds from the Gulf, which results in mild winters and, on the whole, relatively cool summer nights. Another effect of the nearness of the Gulf is abundant rainfall. Polar air penetrates the area frequently enough to provide stimulating variability in the weather.

The average number of days with minimum temperatures of 32 degrees or lower is only 7 per year at the City Office. Most freezing temperatures last only a few hours since they are usually accompanied by clear skies. The extreme persistence of freezing temperatures was in January-February 1951, when the temperature remained 32 degrees or below for 123 consecutive hours.

Monthly rainfall is evenly distributed throughout the year. Annual rainfall has varied from 72.86 inches in 1900 to 17.66 in 1917. About 75 percent of the years have total precipitation between 30 and 60 inches.

Records of sky cover for daylight hours indicate about one-fourth of the days per year are clear, with a maximum of clear days in October and November. Cloudy days are relatively frequent from December to May and partly cloudy days are the more frequent for June through September. Heavy fog occurs on an average of 16 days a year, and light fog occurs about 62 days a year in the city.

Driving Directions to Lamar University

From the Southeast Texas Regional Airport: Exit the airport, pass under Highway 69 and turn left onto the access road. Enter Highway 69N; Take the TX-380/Martin Luther King Pkwy exit and merge onto Martin Luther King; Take the Lamar University exit off Martin Luther King.

From Houston area: Take Interstate 10 east to Beaumont. Exit Highway 69S (exit #849 towards Port Arthur). Take exit towards TX-380/Martin Luther King Pkwy; Turn left on TX-380, drive 1 mile. Take the Lamar University exit off Martin Luther King.

From Louisiana: Take Interstate 10 west to Beaumont. Take the TX-380/Martin Luther King Pkwy exit (exit #854). Turn left onto TX-380/Martin Luther King Pkwy; Continue down Martin Luther King Pkwy and take the Lamar University exit, just past Washington Blvd.

From Woodville/Lufkin area: Take Highway 69 or Highway 96 south to Beaumont. Exit Interstate 10 East (to Orange) Take the Martin Luther King Pkwy exit. Turn right on Martin Luther King, and continue down Martin Luther King, exiting at the Lamar University exit, just past Washington Blvd.

From Galveston: Take Interstate 45N to TX-146 N; Go straight on TX-146 to Interstate 10 east to Beaumont. Exit Highway 69S (exit #849); Take exit towards TX-380/Martin Luther King Pkwy; Turn left on TX-380, drive 1 mile. Take the Lamar University exit off Martin Luther King.

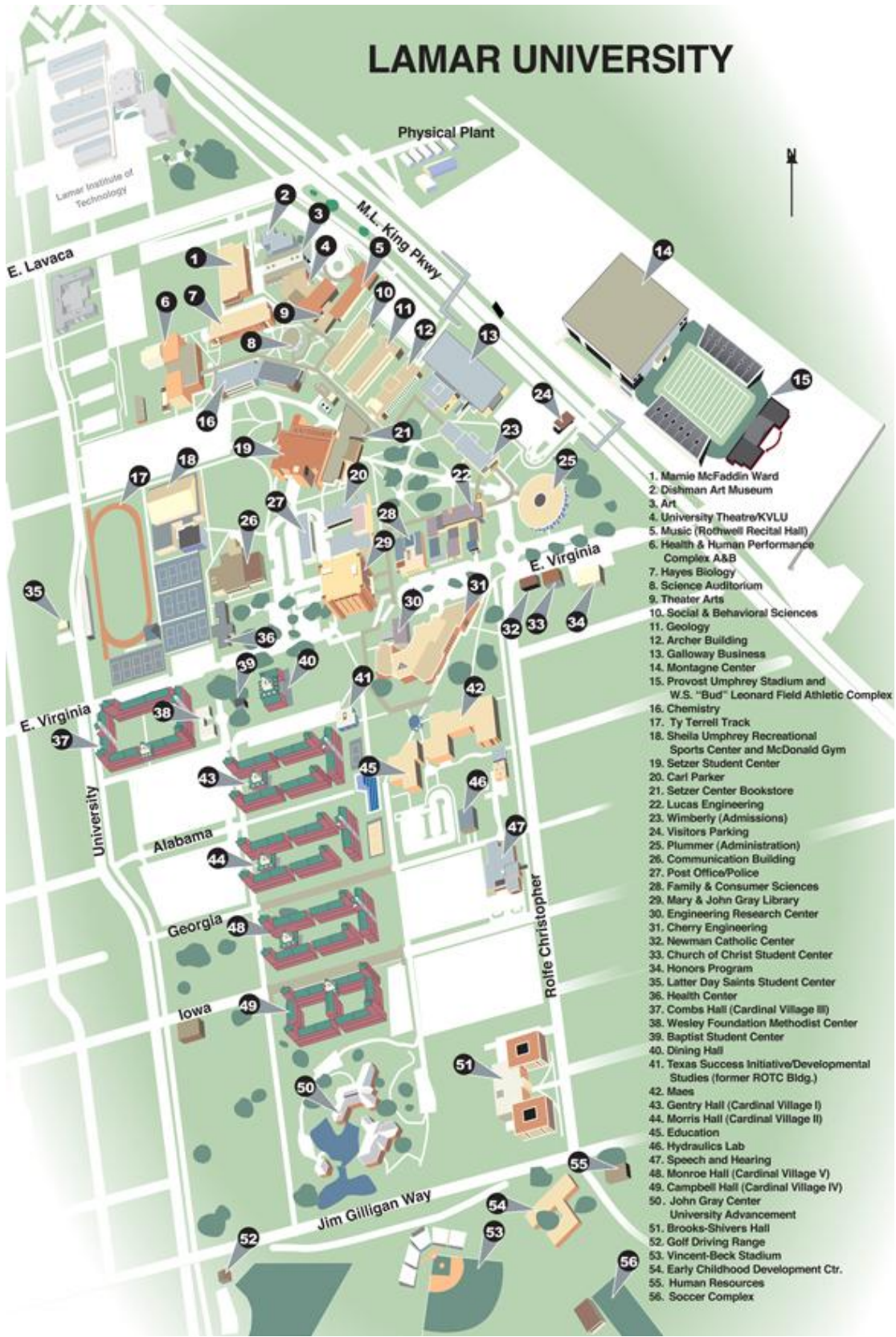
