Magellan Strategies are pleased to present the topline results for a 719n autodial survey of likely Republican primary runoff election voters in Georgia Congressional District 11. The interviews were conducted July 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>, 2014. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.65% at the 95 percent confidence interval. This survey was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics.

## **Survey Methodology**

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touchtone technology. The sample used for this survey was randomly drawn from a Georgia CD11 voter file. The survey response data was weighted based upon past Republican primary election voting demographics. The interviews were conducted on July  $7^{th} - 8^{th}$ , 2014. Three attempts were made to interview each household in the sample. This survey has a margin of error of 3.65% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
