



300 NORTH MERIDIAN

DESCRIPTION

Constructed in 1988, this twenty-eight story commercial office building, located on Meridian Street in downtown Indianapolis, consists of 510,000 square feet and 300 parking spaces. This project is on the premier downtown office corridor directly across from University Park and is home to one of the top law firms in Indiana, Baker and Daniels. 300 North Meridian continues to be considered one of the best designed high-rises in downtown Indianapolis.

CHALLENGES

The tight downtown site required special night-time scheduling for material deliveries and installation including a continuous 18-hour concrete pour for the building's foundation system. Due to the proximity of the project to existing buildings, special shoring and underpinning operations were required.
