

MOHAIR TUNIC SWEATER USING DI.VE MOHAIR KISS

Mohair Kiss Tunic Sweater

Materials: Dive Mohair Kiss Ombre: 8,9,10 skeins (Color A)

Dive Mohair Unito 1,1,1 skein (Color B)

Knitting needles size 7 & 8

Gauge: 20 sts = 4"; 7 rows = 1"

Finished Measurements: approx. 34-36", 38-40", 42-44"

Back

With smaller needle and Color B: cast on 67,73,81 sts. Work in rib (k1, p1) one row. Switch to Color A and continue (k1, p1) rib for 13 rows of rib. Next row, switch to Color B, rib one row, second row increase as follows: work 8,7,8 (inc 1 in next st, work 7,6,7, inc 1 in next st, work 8,7,8) 3x. (inc 1 in next st, work 6) 3x, 1x, 3x. (inc 1 in next st, work 7,7,7) 1x,3x,7x. (74,82,90) sts.

Switch to larger needles, work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 18.5". 19", 19.5".

Armhole Shaping

Bind off 5,7,8 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 stitch each side, every other row 5x, 6x, 7x. Cont in pattern until piece measures 26.5", 27.5", 28.5".

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 4,5,5 beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 5,6,5 sts beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 5,5,6 sts beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 26,26,28 back of neck sts.

Front

Work as for back, including all shaping.

And at the same time

When piece meas 25.5", 26.5", 27.5"

Begin Neck Shaping

Work to center 16,16,17 sts, place 16,16,17 sts on holder, attach a new ball of yarn. Complete row. Work both sides at once. Dec 1 st at each neck edge. Every other row 5x. Cont in pattern until piece measures 26.5",27.5",28.5" from start.

Shape Shoulers

Work shoulder shaping (at shoulder edge) to correspond with back.

<u>Sleeves</u>

Size 34"- 36"

With smaller needles, cast on 31 sts. Work same as body rib. On last row of rib, increase as follows: (work 7, inc 1 in next st) 3x. work 7.

Size 38"- 40"

With smaller needles, cast 31 sts. Work same as body rib. On last row of rib, increase as follows: work 5 (inc 1 in next st, work 4, inc 1 in next st, work 5) 1x. (inc 1 in next st, work 4) 3x.

Size 42"-"44

With smaller needles, cast on 33 sts. Work same as body rib. On last row of rib, increase as follows: work 5 (inc 1 in next st, work 4, inc 1 in next st, work 5) 2x (inc 1 in next st, work 5) 1x.

SleeveShaping

Using larger needles, work on row RS row. Begin sleeve shaping. Inc 1 st on each sideevery $6^{th}(6^{th},6^{th}\text{row})$ 13x(14x,17x), then every $8^{th}(8^{th},0 \text{ row})$ 2x(2x,0x). Cont in pat st until piece meas $16.5^{\circ}(17.5^{\circ},18^{\circ})$.

Cap Shaping

Bind off 5(7) sts each side.

Dec 1 st each side, every other row 5(6x)

Size 34"- 36" and Size 38"- 40"

Dec 1 st each side every other row 10x(6x). Dec 1 st each side every 2^{nd} row 3x(5x).

Bind off 2 sts at the beg of next 4(4) rows. Bind off rem 10(12) sts.

Size 42"-"44

Bind off 6 sts each side.

Dec 1 st each side, every other row 7x. Dec 1 st each side every 2^{nd} row 8x.

Dec 1 st each side every 4th row 1x.

Bind off 3 sts at the beg of next 4 rows. Bind off rem 12 sts.

Join Seams

Weave in all ends. Seam each shoulder and sleeves.

Mock Neck Finishing

With smaller needles and RS facing using Color B, pick up 13(15,13) sts from sts from right neck edge, work 16(15,17) front neck sts from holder, pick up 13(15,13) sts from left neck edge, pick up 26(26,28) back neck sts, place marker, join in the round. Work one round Color B.

Change to Color A and work in rib for 3" or desired length. Bind off loosely.
