30-11 in five seasons

Phil Wessels was a chemist at the college when he became the school's first coach. Judging from the record, he knew something about team chemistry as well. His teams were 30-11, the No. 2 winning percentage in school history (.732), tops among coaches serving longer than a year.

He lost only one home game, and his first squad remains the school's only unbeaten team. Wessels gave up coaching when he left the college in 1910. He returned three years later, then took a job on Long Island in 1922.

His football squad scored just 31 points in a 0-7-1 season, salvaging some pride by tying archrival Connecticut 7-7 in the season finale.

Frank Keaney - 1920-48

401-124 in 28 seasons

Frank Keaney, an exalted figure in URI history, stunned the sports world by introducing "racehorse basketball," later known as the fast break. His impact was so profound that he entered the Basketball Hall of Fame in 1960, just its second year of existence. With a 401-124 record in 28 years, Keaney is the winningest Ram coach. His 1928-29 squad (15-1) was the first "point-a-minute" team, averaging 41 a game. His 1945-46 club (21-3) lost to Kentucky 46-45 in the NIT final, then considered the national title game.

Bob "Red" Haire, a former team captain and assistant coach under Frank Keaney, took on the daunting task of replacing the legend and lasted just four years. His teams compiled a 57-42 record (.576) but two winning seasons gave way to two losing ones, the team's first in 29 years. Haire played at URI from 1924-28 and returned as Keaney's assistant in 1946. Two years later he began his reign with three straight losses, the team's longest losing string since his sophomore season 23 years before.
