

The Honourable Michael H. Dunkley, J.P, M.P, Minister of Public Safety

Michael H. Dunkley was born on 18 June 1958, to Henry “Bill” Dunkley (deceased) and Marye Lee Dunkley. He attended Saltus Grammar School, Trinity College School, and the University of Richmond where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree and a Scholar Athlete Award.

Before being elected he served on numerous government boards such as the Hospital Insurance Commission, the Board of Agriculture and the Immigration Board. He entered into politics in 1997 and was elected to the House of Assembly. He has held several shadow ministerial portfolios in his Parliamentary career as both an MP and a Senator. On December 17th 2012 the One Bermuda Alliance won the General Election and he was appointed the Deputy Premier and Minister of Public Safety.

Widely recognized throughout the island of Bermuda as a very successful and astute businessman in addition to being a respected politician, Minister Dunkley is extremely dedicated to the Island and its people. He has been often recognized for his work in politics and in 2007 was voted “Most Effective Politician”

As a businessman he is renowned for his work ethic and “never say die” attitude. He serves as the Vice President and Chief Executive Officer of Dunkley’s Dairy, a milk processing plant and one of the largest food importers in Bermuda. He is also the Vice President of Island Properties Ltd, a property management company and is President of Dunkley’s Management Holdings Ltd, a management consultant company. In the community, he served as Past President of the Mid Ocean Club from 1999- 2005 and 2008 – 2011.

An active sportsman whose achievements span from a former first division soccer player to a winner of the club championships at The Mid Ocean Club and also a former premier division cricket player in Bermuda.

Married to Pamela on May 23rd 1981, they have two daughters, Christine and Brooke. They live in Devonshire, Bermuda. Minister Dunkley is a keen family man who is immensely proud of his wife and two daughters.
